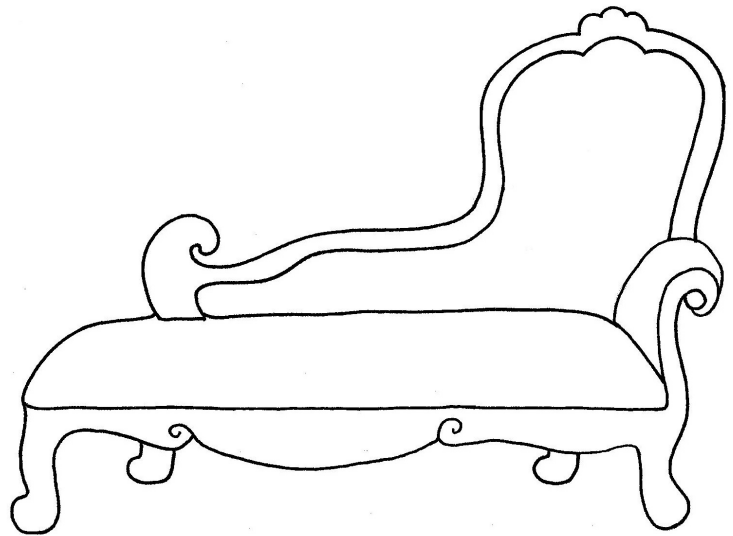
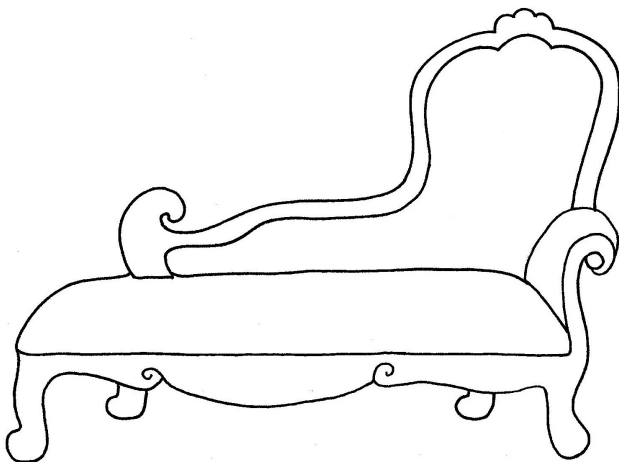


Large Square Size

Print off the template sheet. Decide which template size you would like to use on your project and cut it out from the sheet. Draw around the template onto a white piece of card then cut it out. Next take the template and cut out the cushion area of the template. Cut the cushion sections apart and draw around each section onto patterned paper then cut them out. The pattern will be naturally broken up more so it will make your finished embellishment appear more three dimensional. Glue the cushion pieces on top of your white shape using the remaining cut out bits of template as a guide for the placement. Draw on the detail on the frame copying it from the template sheet. Add a little shading to your embellishment or extra colour using marker pens or pencils. When you've finished your embellishment add it to your card.



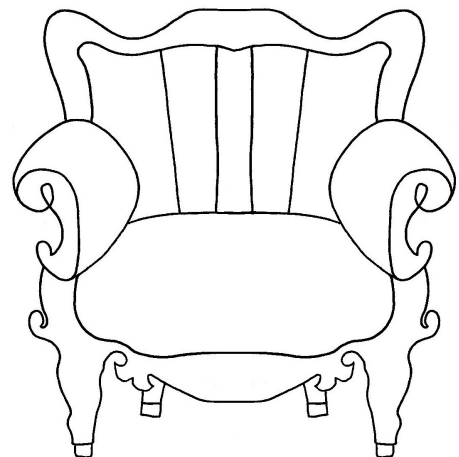
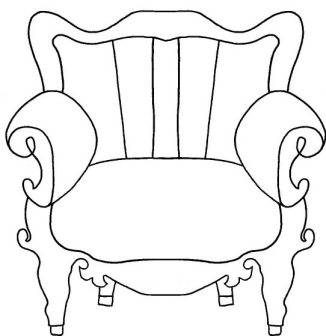
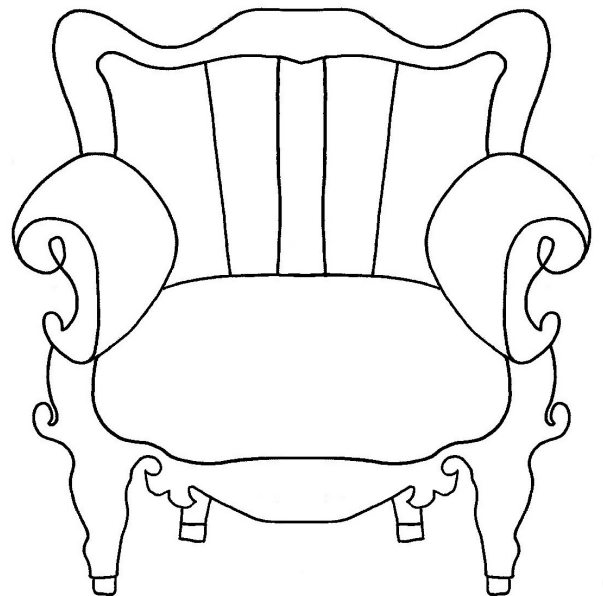
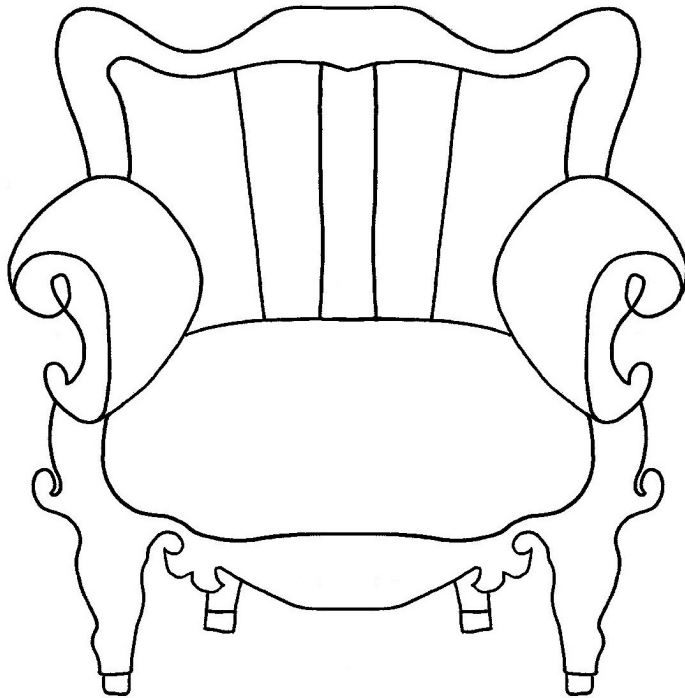
In the card sample below a square of paper has been added to a card blank then smaller strips of paper have been added along the bottom half along with a piece of ribbon with one end tied in a bow. The embellishment was then added on top and the message added with stickers to the top left corner.

Different sizes to suit your choice of project

Print off the template sheet and decide which size template you would like to use. Take a piece of white or coloured card and cut out a rough square that fits over the top of the template you are using. Hold it in place with a couple of pieces of masking tape, make sure it's well stuck down. Pop the sheet back into your printer and print the same sheet again so it prints over the top of the piece of card. Peel off the piece of card and cut out the template from the card leaving a small boarder. Do the same again but this time use a piece of patterned paper fixing it in place over the top of the same template and printing the sheet again. This time cut out the cushion bit of the chair from the patterned paper piece. If you wanted to you can add colour with marker pens to the chair frame then glue the cushion piece on top to complete your embellishment.



In the card sample bellow a piece of paper with the top and bottom punched with a boarder punch was added to the card blank with strips of paper added over the top and a journalling card added with the message on top of it. The embellishment was then added on top to finish.
