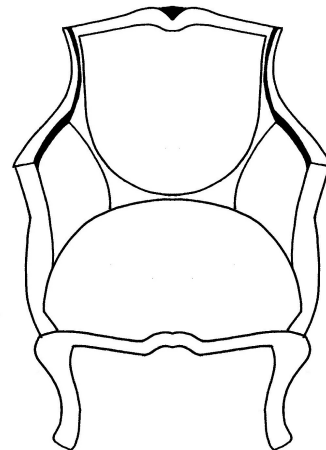
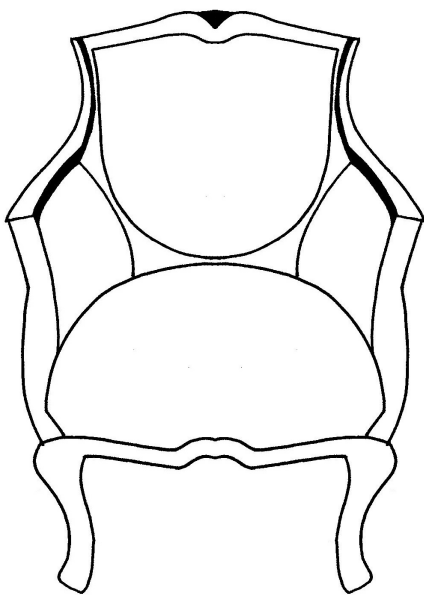
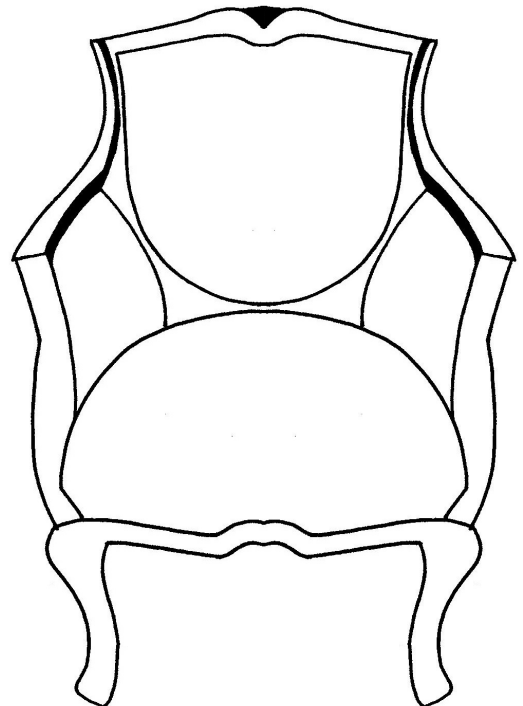
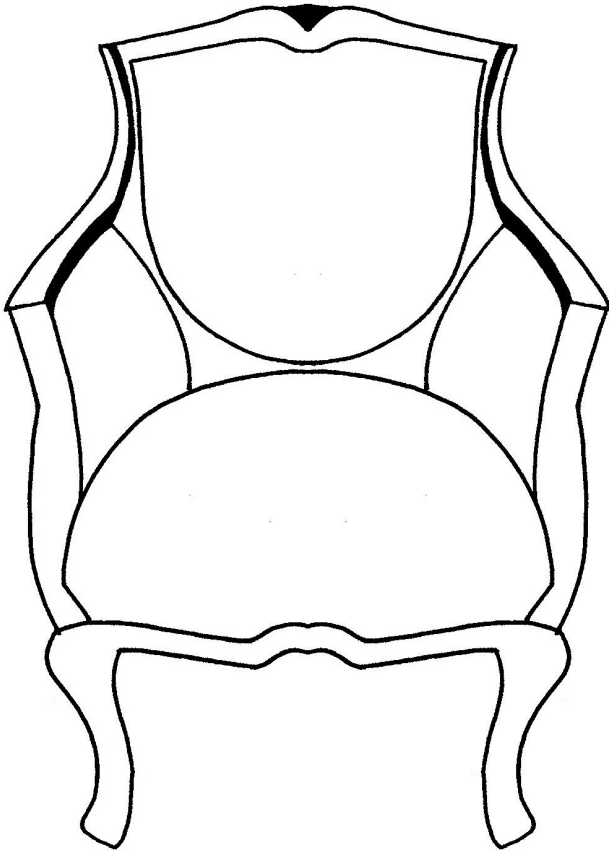


Different sizes to suit your choice of project

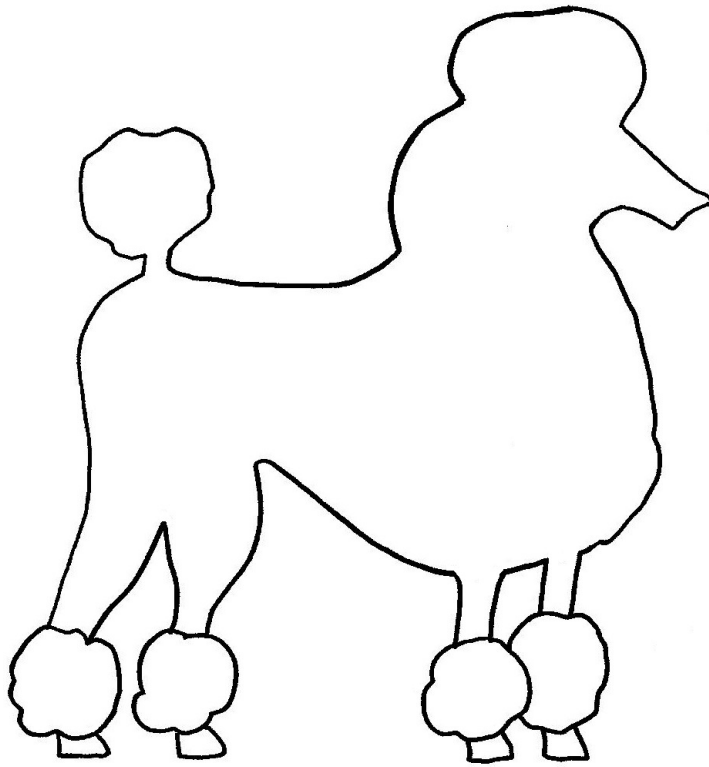


Print off the template sheet and pick out the template size that best fits your project. Cut out the template and draw around it on to a plain coloured cardstock then cut out the shape. Draw on the details of the template copying them from the template drawing. Take the template again and cut out the cushion parts of the template. Draw around them on to patterned paper and cut them out. Glue the cushion pieces on top of you cut out chair piece and draw around the edges of the cushion shapes in the same pen you used for the details earlier. Add the finished embellishment to your project.

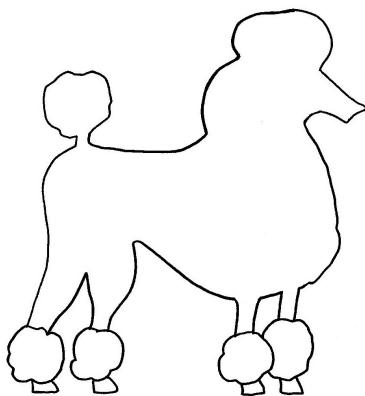
To make the card below a piece of patterned paper has been added to the card blank. Another layer of paper with the top and bottom edges punched with a boarder punch was then added. A third layer of paper with the corners rounded was then added on top. A strip of patterned paper and a strip of fabric tape was added across the middle of the card. A journalling tag was then added with the message on in stickers and the embellishment was added on top using 3D foam pads.

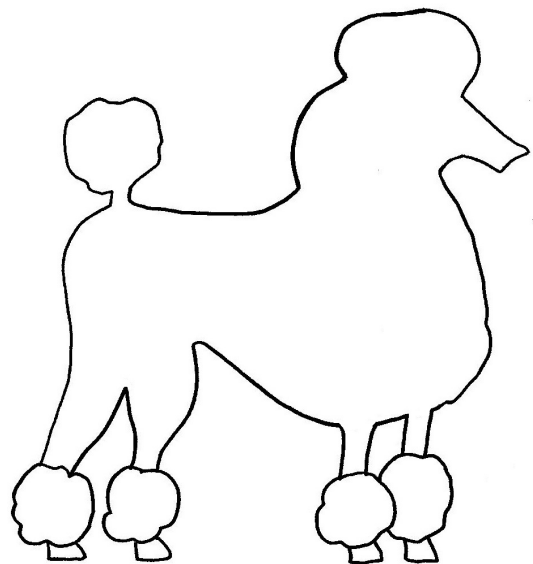




Large square card size

Gift tag size



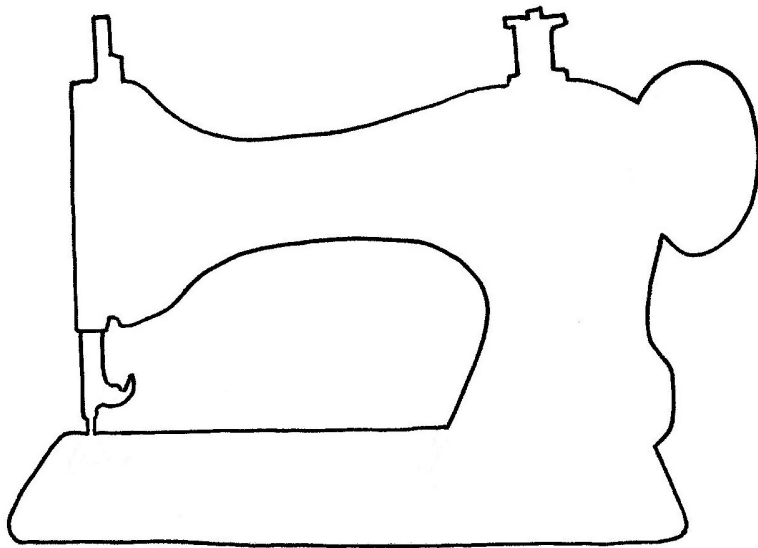
C6 card size (4x6)

Print off the template sheet and decide which of the template sizes fit your project the best then cut out the corresponding template. Pick a plain or patterned paper and draw around the template on to it then cut it out. To keep the design as a silhouette just draw around the outline of the shape. You can if you want to add more details to make the poodle a character. You could also add a sparkly collar with a line of self adhesive gems. When you've completed your embellishment add it to your project.

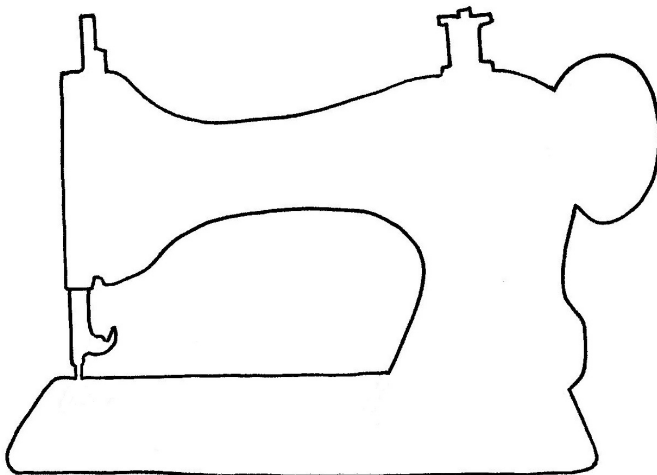
In the card bellow a background paper has been cut out then a stitched boarder added to it with the sewing machine then it's been glued to the card blank. Strips of tulle, ribbon and a boarder sticker have then been added to the card across the middle and a tag added to one of the ribbons. The message has been added using Safmat and stickers then the embellishment on top to finish.

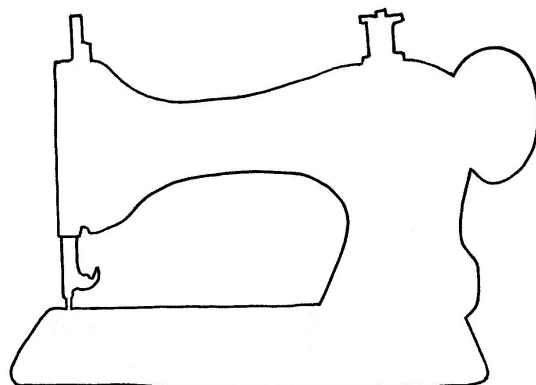




Large square card size

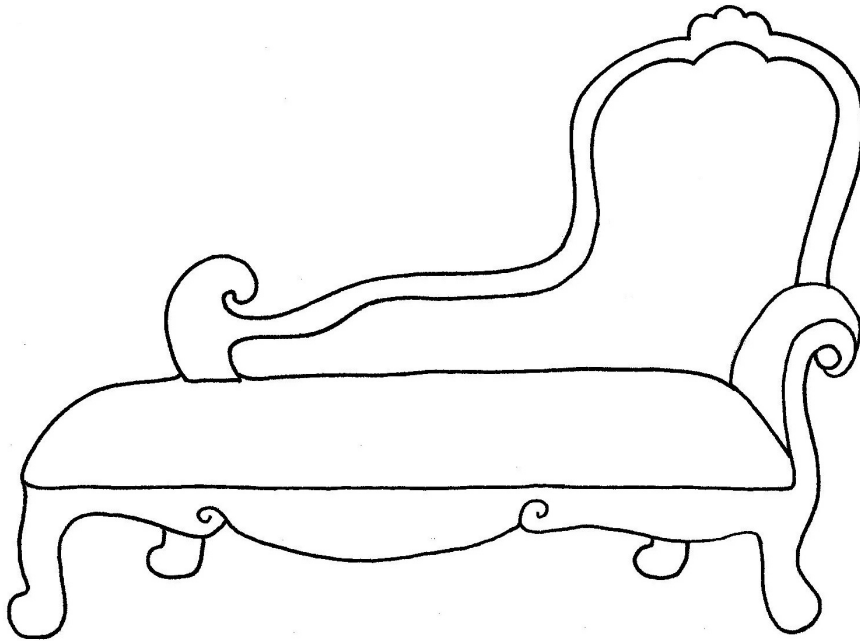
Print off the template sheet then decide which template you would like to use. Cut out a square of patterned paper to fit over the top of the template then fix it in place with masking tape. Pop the sheet back into your printer and print the template sheet again so it should print over the top of the patterned paper this time.

Peel the paper off the template sheet and cut out the sewing machine shape leaving a small boarder around the edge. If you want to you can colour in the sewing machine silhouette and just print it on plain card. You could also cut around the template shape onto fabric to make a fabric sewing machine embellishment. On the embellishment bellow some fake stitching has been added to the embellishment drawing it on with a pen.

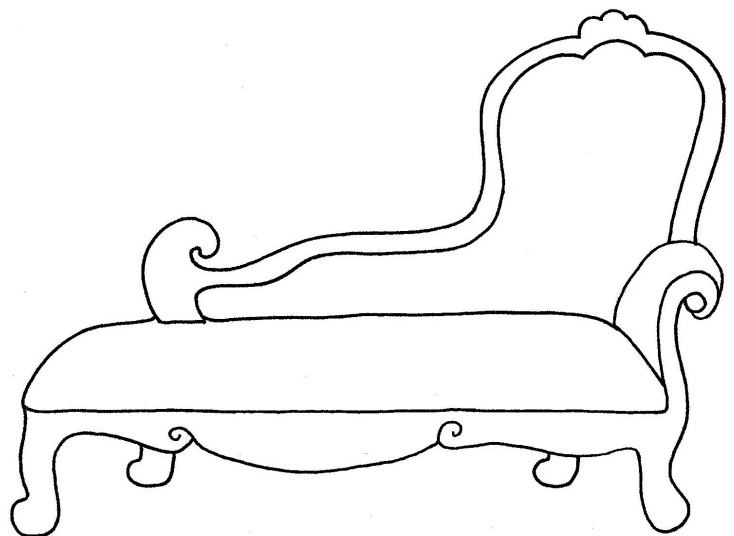
In the card sample bellow layers of tags and scraps of patterned paper have been added to the card blank then a piece of ribbon on top and the embellishment on top of that. The flower has been made by rolling up some more of the same wired paper ribbon with gems added to the centre. The message has been added on top with stickers.

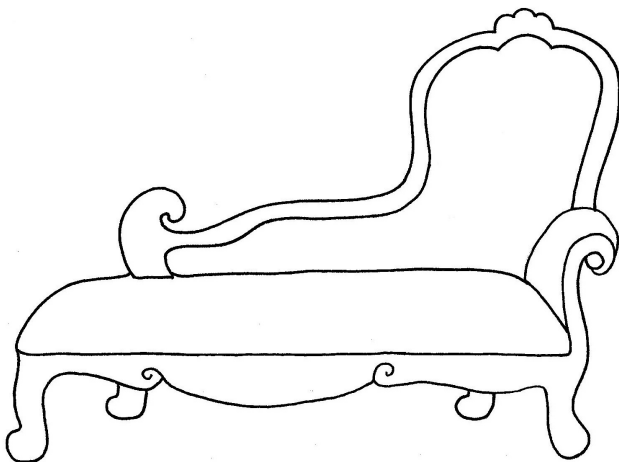




Large Square Size

Print off the template sheet. Decide which template size you would like to make and cut it out from the sheet. Draw around the template onto a white piece of card then cut it out.

Next take the template and cut out the cushion area of the template. Cut the cushion sections apart and draw around each section onto patterned paper then cut them out. The pattern will be naturally broken up more so it will make your finished embellishment appear more three dimensional. Glue the cushion pieces on top of your white shape using the remaining cut out bits of template as a guide for the placement. Draw on the detail on the frame copying it from the template sheet. Add a little shading to your embellishment or extra colour using marker pens or pencils. When you've finished your embellishment add it to your card.



In the card sample below a square of paper has been added to a card blank then smaller strips of paper have been added along the bottom half along with a piece of ribbon with one end tied in a bow. The embellishment was then added on top and the message added with stickers to the top left corner.
