



Western Boot

## Western Boot Card

Print off the Western Boot template. Cut out the boot shape cutting around the outermost line only, all the way round so you have the boot shape. Fold an A4 piece of paper in half and place the boot shape on the card matching up the edge with the dashed line to the folded edge on your card. Draw around the boot shape then cut it out, still keeping the card folded. Now you have your shaped base card. Pick out some colours you'd like to use for your card, you can go for tan/leather colours or prints etc. Cut the heel and sole part off the boot template and draw around that on to black card. Draw around the boot shape on to your choice of card and cut out both the heel and boot pieces. Attach them both to your shaped card blank, matching the edges up to position them correctly. Next cut the pocket shape from the template, keep it as a whole shape first and draw around on to card and then cut off the top flap and draw around that again on to card. Cut out the pocket pieces and attach them to your card. If you'd like to make it an actual pocket on your card leave the top part open. Add a bit of decoration to finish off with.
