



## Supply List

---

To play along making the mini album featured in the classes you'll need to collect together the following:

*5 sheets of 12x12 patterned paper*

*5 sheets of 12x12 cardstock plus one or two extra scraps for matting*

*1 piece of canvas or canvas paper 12x12*

*1 pack of 6x6 American Crafts Page protectors or other 6x6 size page protectors*

*1 sheet of transparency or acetate or you can use off cuts of transparency plain or patterned*

*Label stickers – the kind that have blank spaces to fill in or you can use small scraps of cardstock*

*Washi tape or paper tape – if you can't get washi tape you can use regular masking tape*

*Tab stickers & patterned stickers for decoration*

*Mini alphabet stickers*

*Regular sized alphabet stickers, (chipboard stickers or any others you like)*

*Rub ons to decorate – you'll need some picture rub ons or other decorative kinds that work with your project/photos*

*Acrylic paint in a colour that works with your project/photos*

*Drawing ink in a colour that works with your project/photos*

*Book rings or other form of binding for your mini album*

*A little trim or ribbon for decorating*

*A small piece of netting fabric*

*Some paper flowers*

*Some small paper tags or off cuts of card*

*A luggage style tag 6x12cm size*

*Paint brushes 1 large & 1 small for using with your paint & ink*

### Photos

*The photos I'll be using are all 4x6 size. The idea is this album is a place to keep in photos that you don't necessarily want to make whole scrapbook pages for but you still want to keep in a book so if you have a wallet of photos that have been gathering dust grab them to use.*



If you would like to use some of the exact same things I'll be using you can do that too. I've kept the supplies fairly generic just adding in the colour palette that will work with my photos so you can use the same stickers and rub ons but just change the colours of the patterned papers, paint and ink you're using to make your finished book suit your own photos or you can use the same brown/orange/turquoise blue colour palette as it's fairly generic and will suit as a base for most themes.
