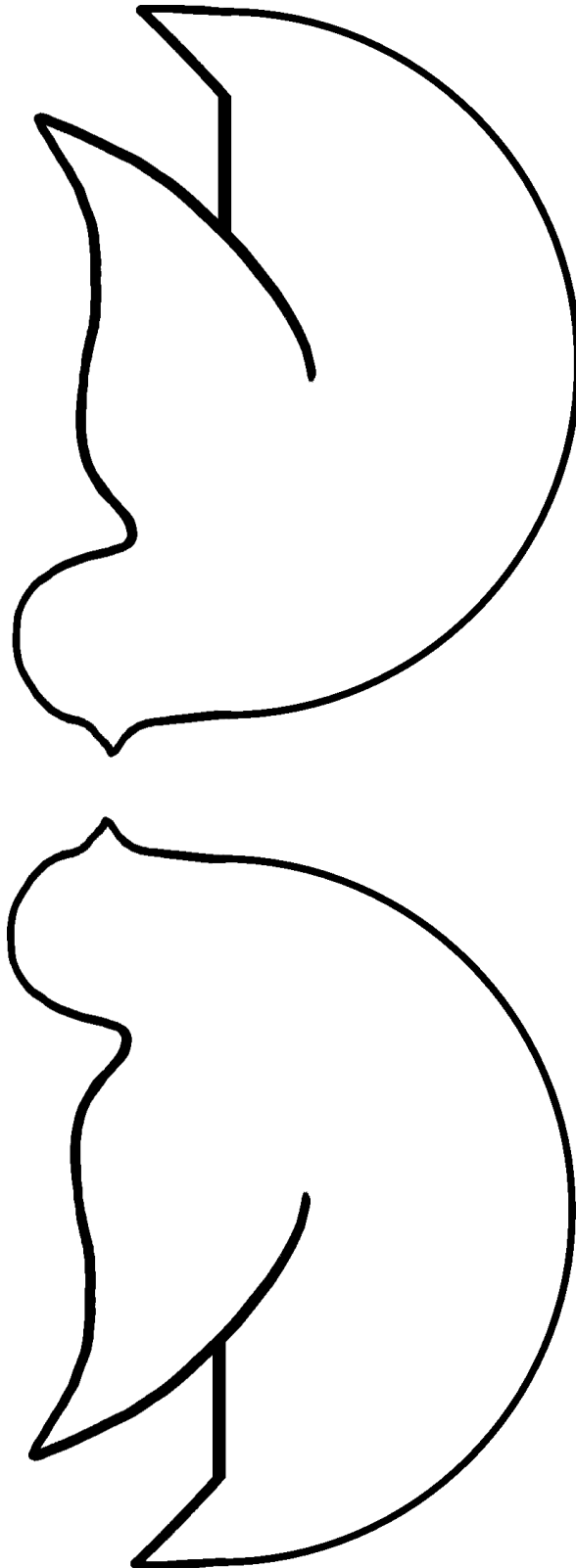
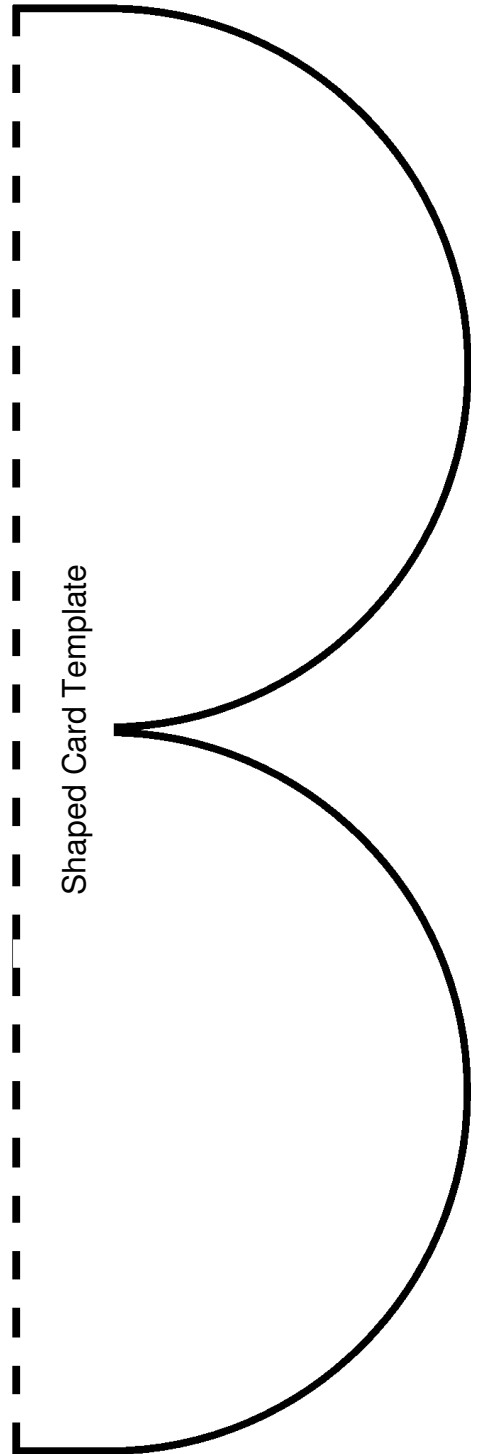


**Love Birds**



Fold Line - Match the dashed line up to the fold on your card



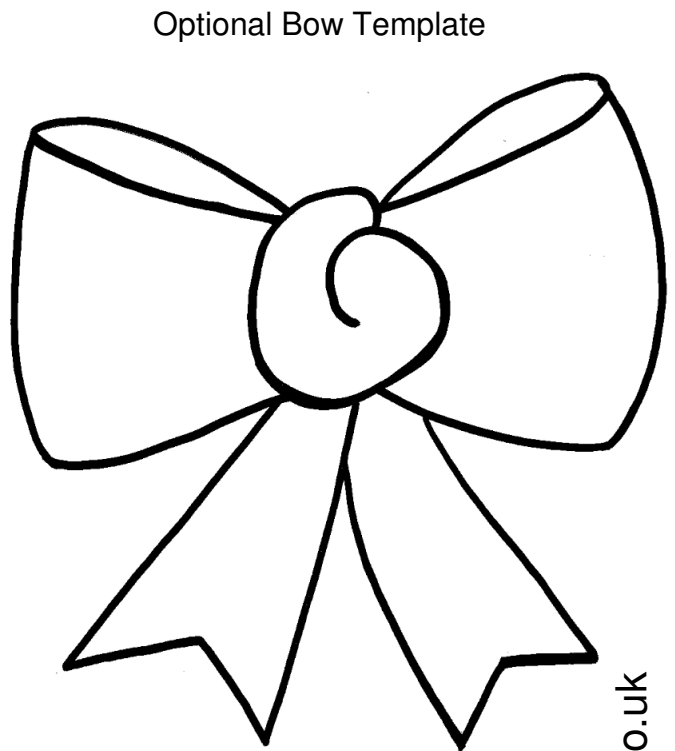
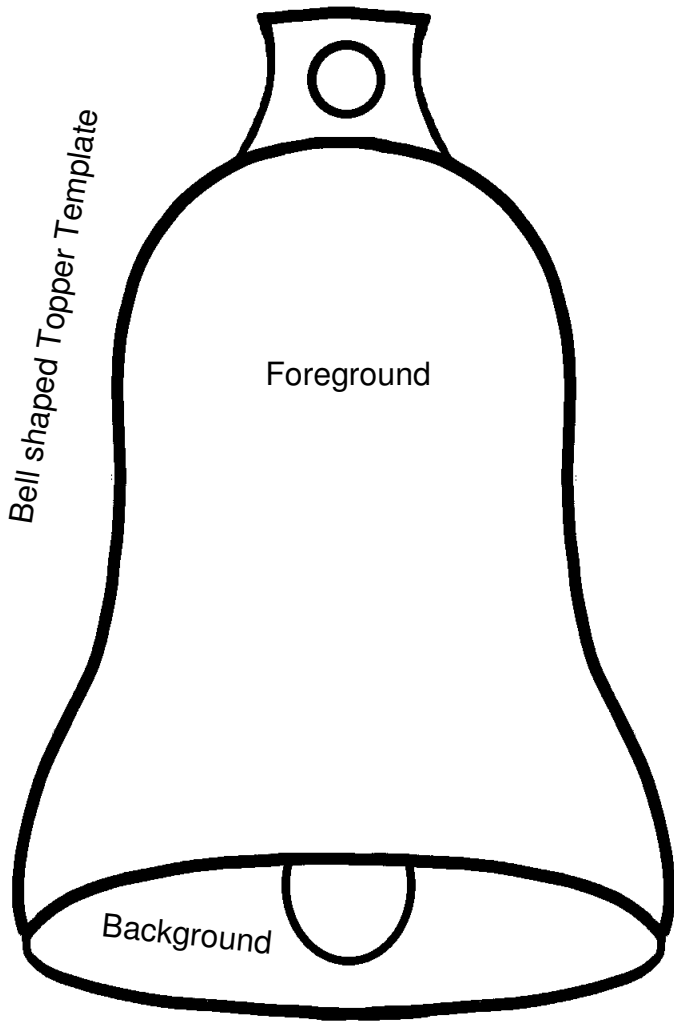
## Love Birds Card

Print out the Love Birds template and cut out the shaped base card piece. Fold a piece of A4 card in half (or you can use a DL size card for this one) and place the template on it matching up the dashed line to the fold on your card. Draw around the shape and cut it out keeping the card folded to create your shaped base card. Cover your base card with patterned paper. Next cut out the two birds from the template sheet. Draw around one of the birds on to one colour and the other bird on to another colour. Cut both out. Decorate them with inks/embossing/glitter etc, what ever you would like to use. Attach both the birds to your base card so they're beaks are just touching, there's a straight line between the tail and the wing, use this bit as a guide lining it up with the top of your base card.

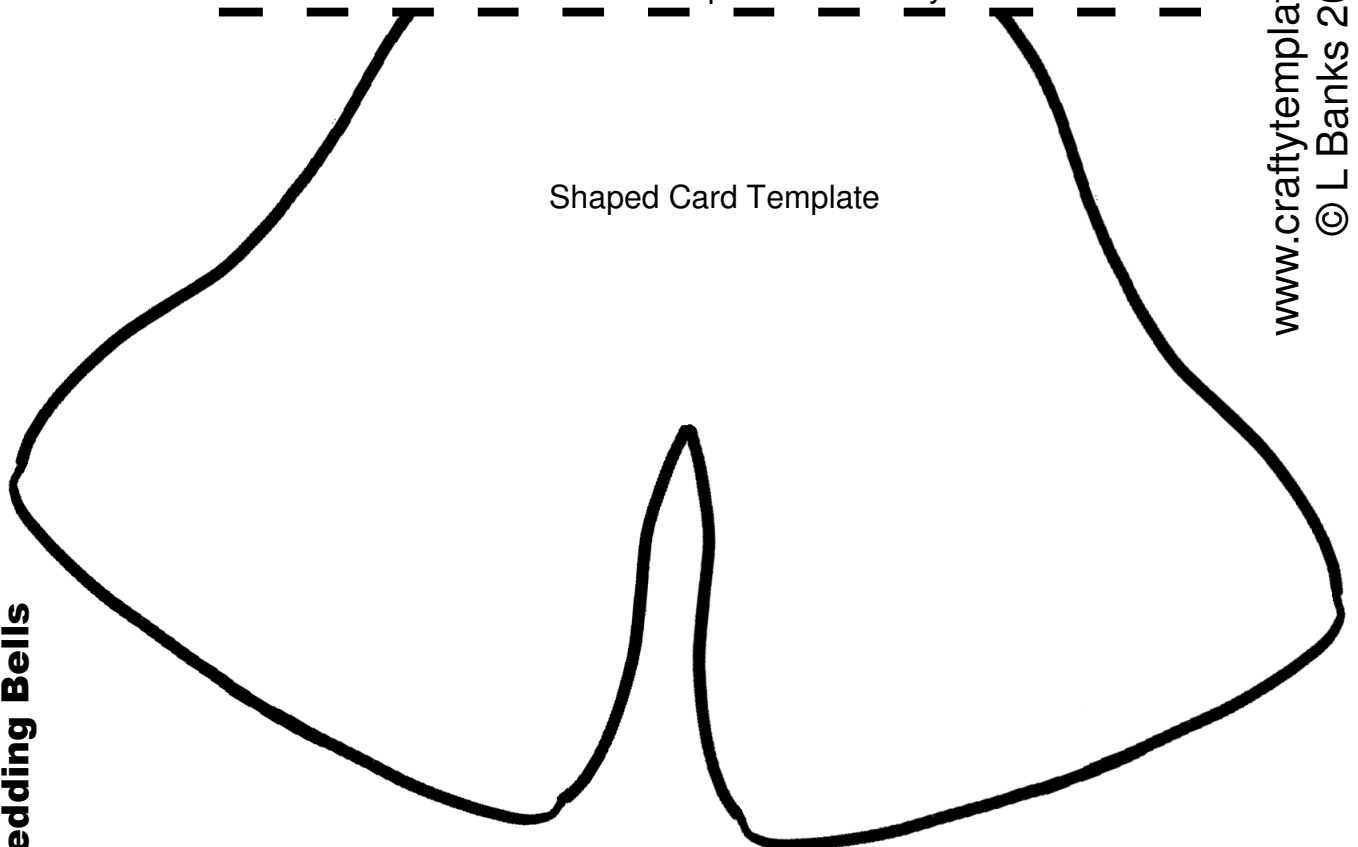

**Wedding Bells**

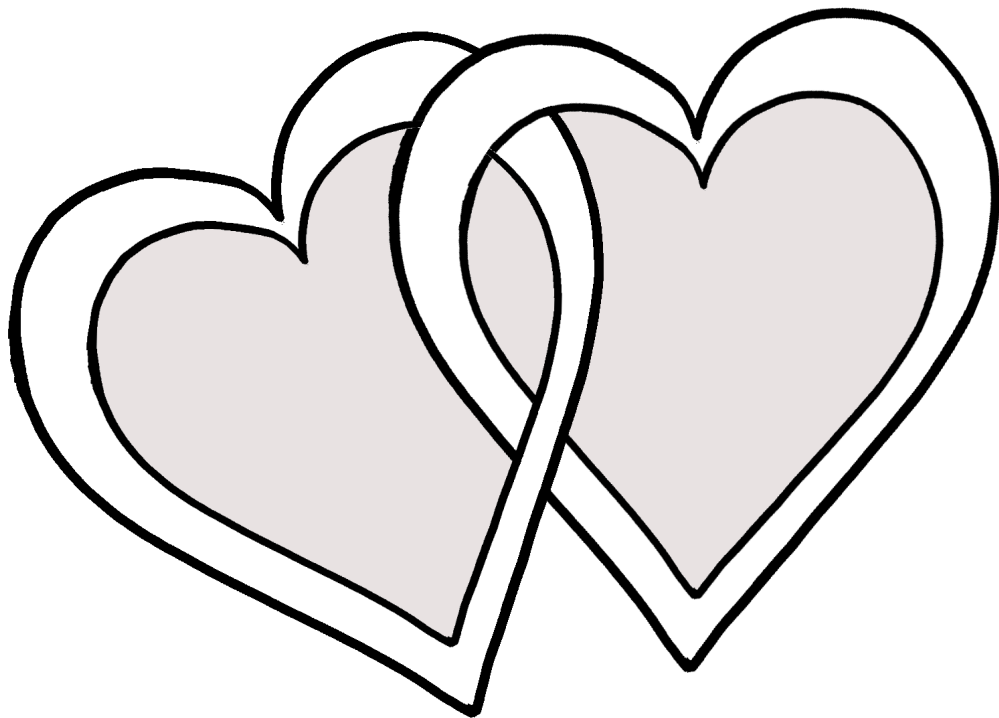
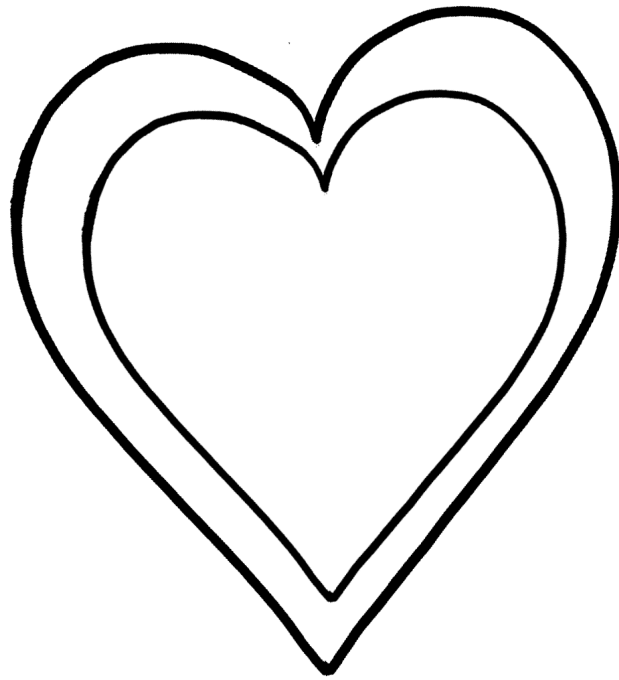
## Wedding Bells Card

Print off the Wedding Bells template and cut out the shaped base card template. Fold a piece of A4 card in half and place the base card template on it matching the dashed line up to the fold on your card. Draw around the shape and cut it out keeping the card folded to create your shaped base card. Next cut out the bell shape from the template sheet and draw around it twice on to plain or patterned card. Cut out both pieces. Next cut off the piece of the bell marked as background, put it to one side and draw around the template piece marked foreground twice on to more of the same patterned or coloured paper. Cut the inner little bell bit from the piece marked background and draw around that twice on to silver card or paper. Assemble all the pieces together to recreate each of the two bell shapes. Stick them to the shaped base card, matching the bottom edges to get each one placed correctly. Punch out holes from the top of the bell shapes and thread some ribbon through the tops then tie in a bow.

**Linked Hearts**

## Linked Hearts Card

Print off the template. You can choose to cut out the single heart shape and create two linked shapes or cut out the shape that's already linked.

The linked shape has areas shaded grey, cut out these pieces first snipping into the middle bits with small scissors. Cut out the outside of the shape when your done. You should now have a shape that's like two linked heart frame shapes. Draw around them on to patterned or plain card and cut out in the same way you cut out your template. You can decorate some more if you wish then when you're done attach to the front of a card blank.

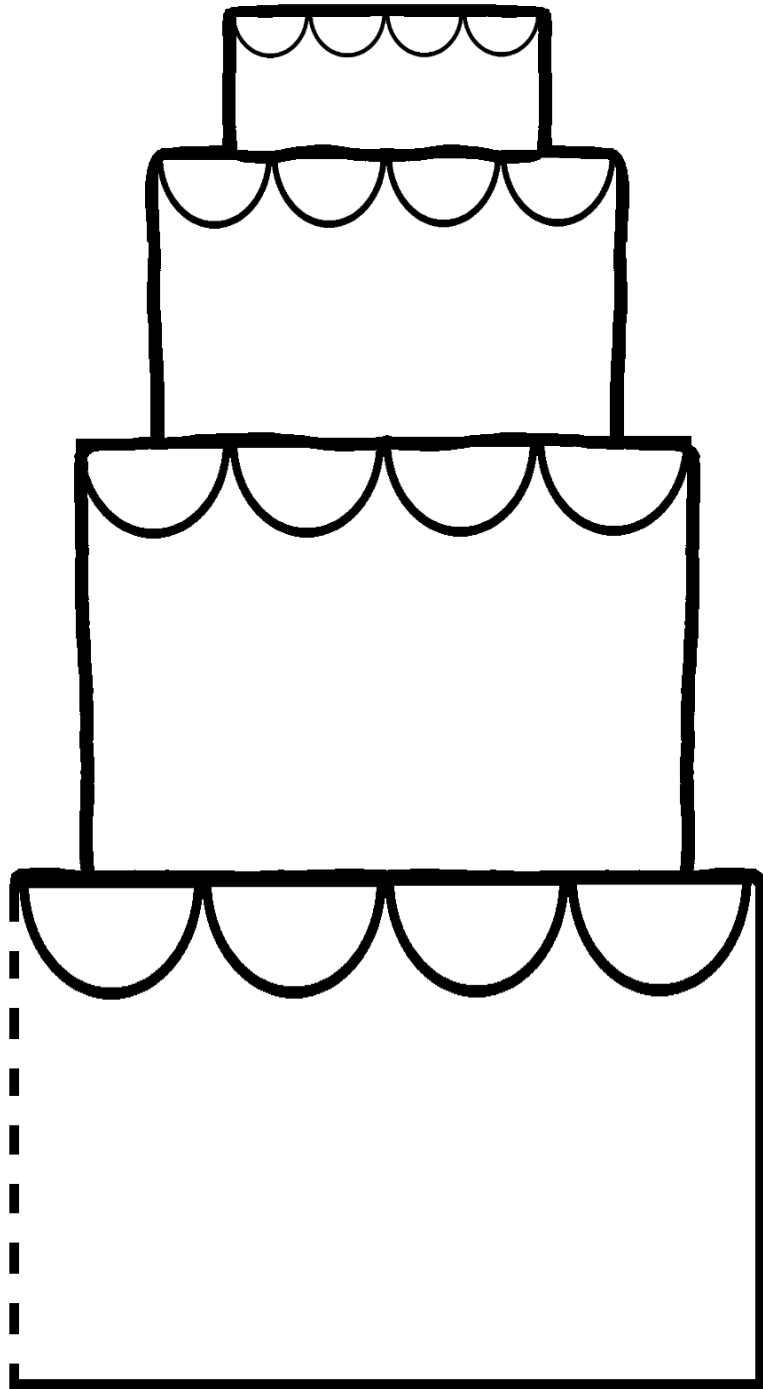

**Tiered Wedding Cake**

Fold Line - Match the dashed line up to the fold on your card



## Tiered Wedding Cake Card

Print off the Tiered Cake template and cut it out, around the whole of the shape following the outermost line. Fold a piece of A4 card in half and place the template on the card matching the dashed line to the fold line on your card. Draw around and cut out to create your shaped base card.

Next cut off each of the tiers on the cake template and draw around on to plain or patterned card. Cut out each on and attach to your base card.

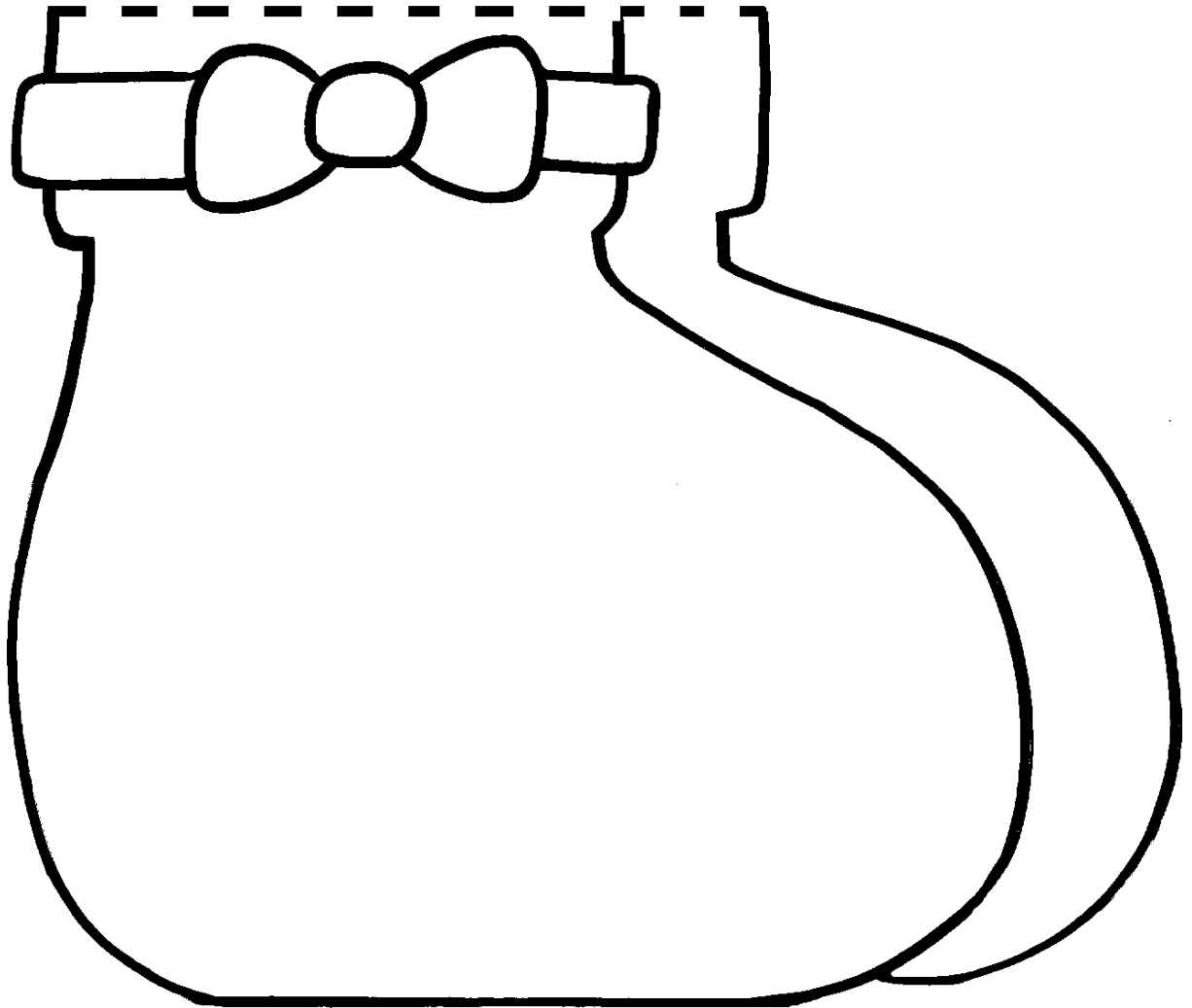
Now cut off each of the scallop pieces and draw around those on to more coloured card, these are depicting the icing on your cake so pick out a suitable colour or you could use something else completely to depict the icing if you wanted to. Attach the scallop pieces to each tier and decorate a little more with beads or glitter etc. The card had been designed to fit a DL size envelope so the top of the cake has an allowance for you to attach something. You could add a bow or a flower or a little stamped image if you like, whatever you choose to use.

**Baby Booties**

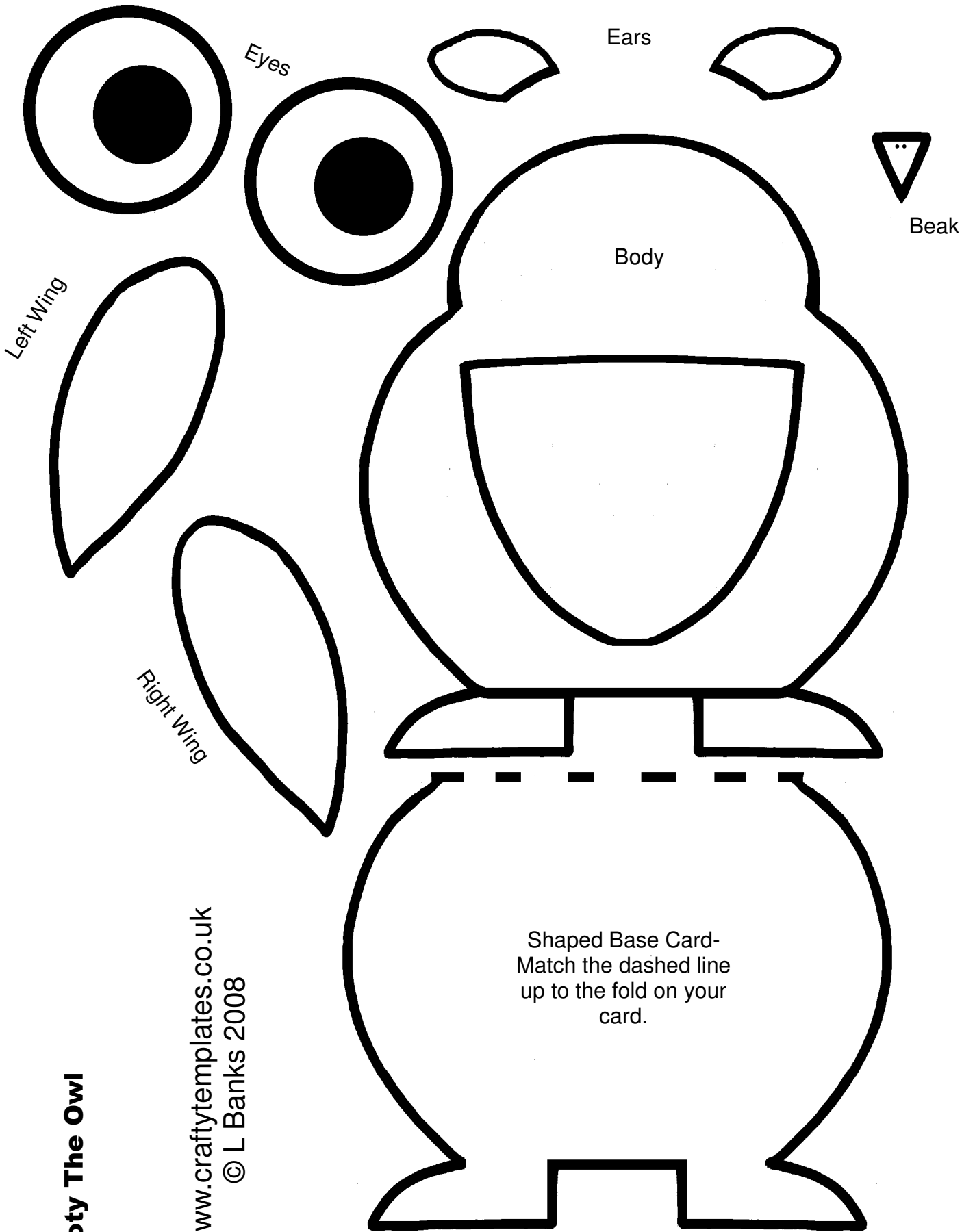
## Baby Booties Card

Print off the Bootee template and cut it out, around the whole of the shape following the outermost line. Fold a piece of A4 card in half and place the template on the card matching the dashed line to the fold line on your card. Draw around and cut out to create your shaped base card. Next cut out the left bootee shape from the template and draw around it out to some patterned card/paper. Cut out the shape. For the ribbon bit at the top you can either use the template to create it from card or use actual ribbon tied in a bow around the top. You can decorate your bootee shape more if you like, inking around the edge/embossing etc. When you're happy attach it to your base card, matching up the left edge and the bottom edge on your base card.

# Hooty The Owl

## Hooty the Owl Card

Print off the owl card template sheet and cut out all the pieces. Take the shaped base card bit first. Fold a piece of card in half (an A5 size will do for this one) and place the card template on it matching the dashed line to the fold on your card. Draw around the shape and cut it out to create your shaped base card. Next draw around the body template piece on to plain or patterned card and cut it out. Stick over your base card matching up the bottom edge. Next cut out the middle bit on the body template and draw around on to a different patterned or coloured card.

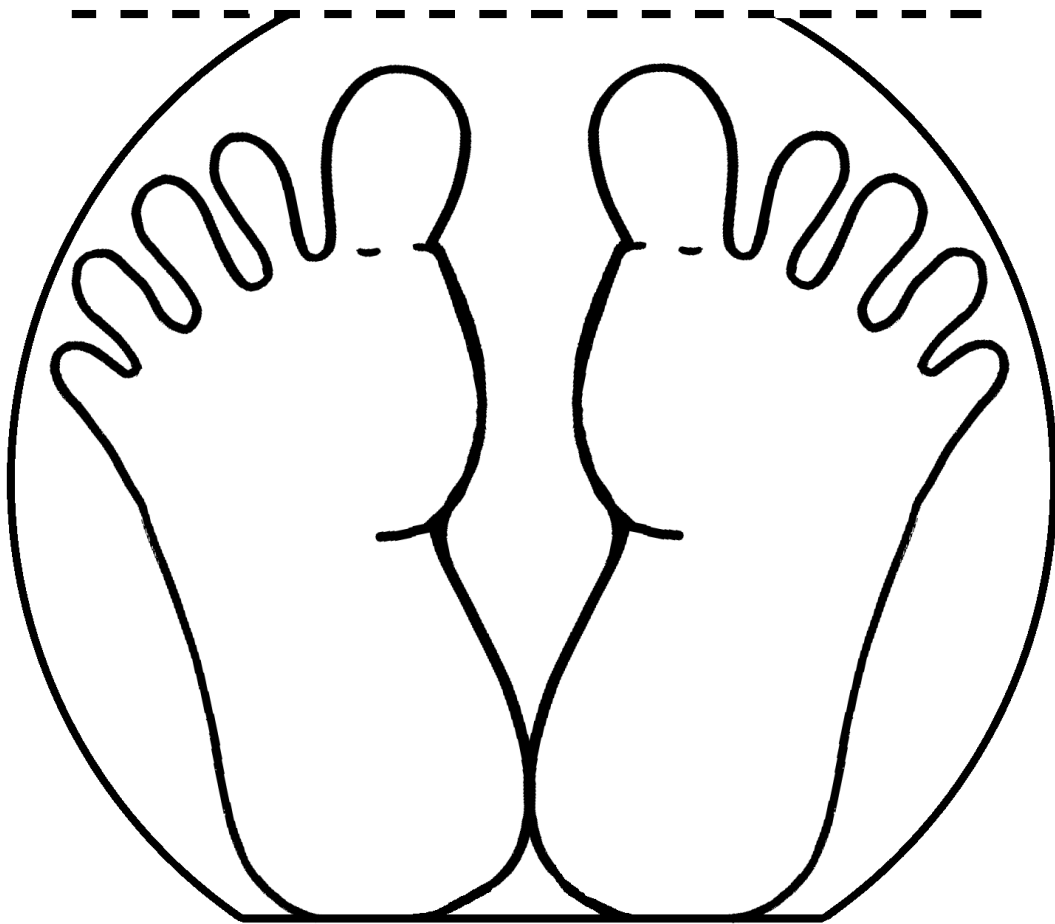
Cut it out and attach it to the middle of the owls tummy. Next draw around all the rest of the pieces on to more patterned/plain card and cut them out. Attach them to your card, the ears at the top of his head, then the wings at the sides then the eyes and finally the beak.

## Baby Feet Card

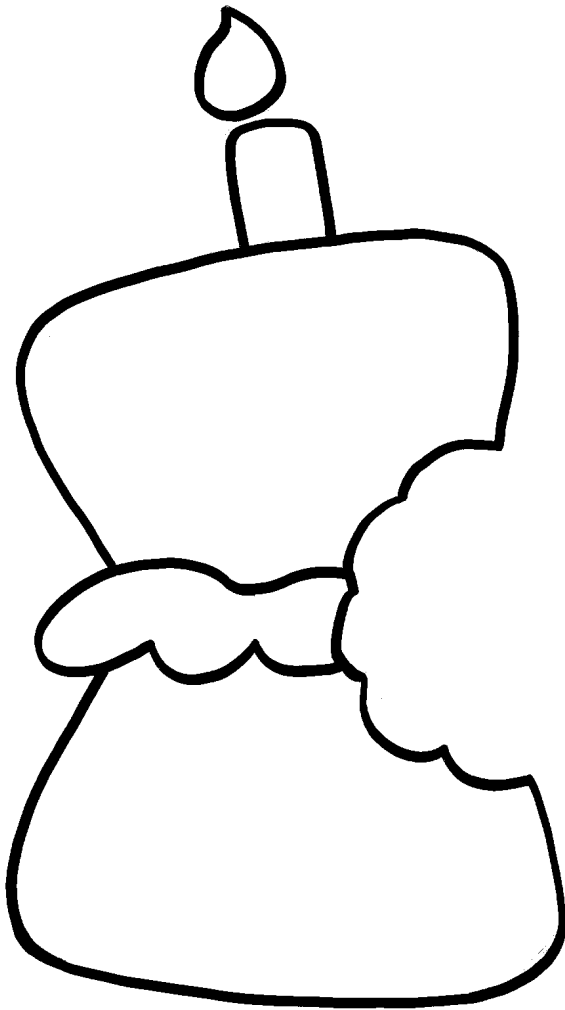
Cut out the template around the outermost line only. Take a sheet of A4 card and fold it in half. Place the template on it matching the dashed line on the template to the fold on your card, draw around and cut out keeping the card folded. You now have your shaped base card. You can cover it with patterned paper if you like or leave it a plain colour. Next take the template again and cut out the little feet. Place them onto coloured card and draw around then cut them out. Use an inkpad or coloured chalks around the edges and to depict the shape of the feet. When your happy with your feet, attach them to your base card with foam pads if you have them to give the card a bit of dimension. Finally attach on a little message.

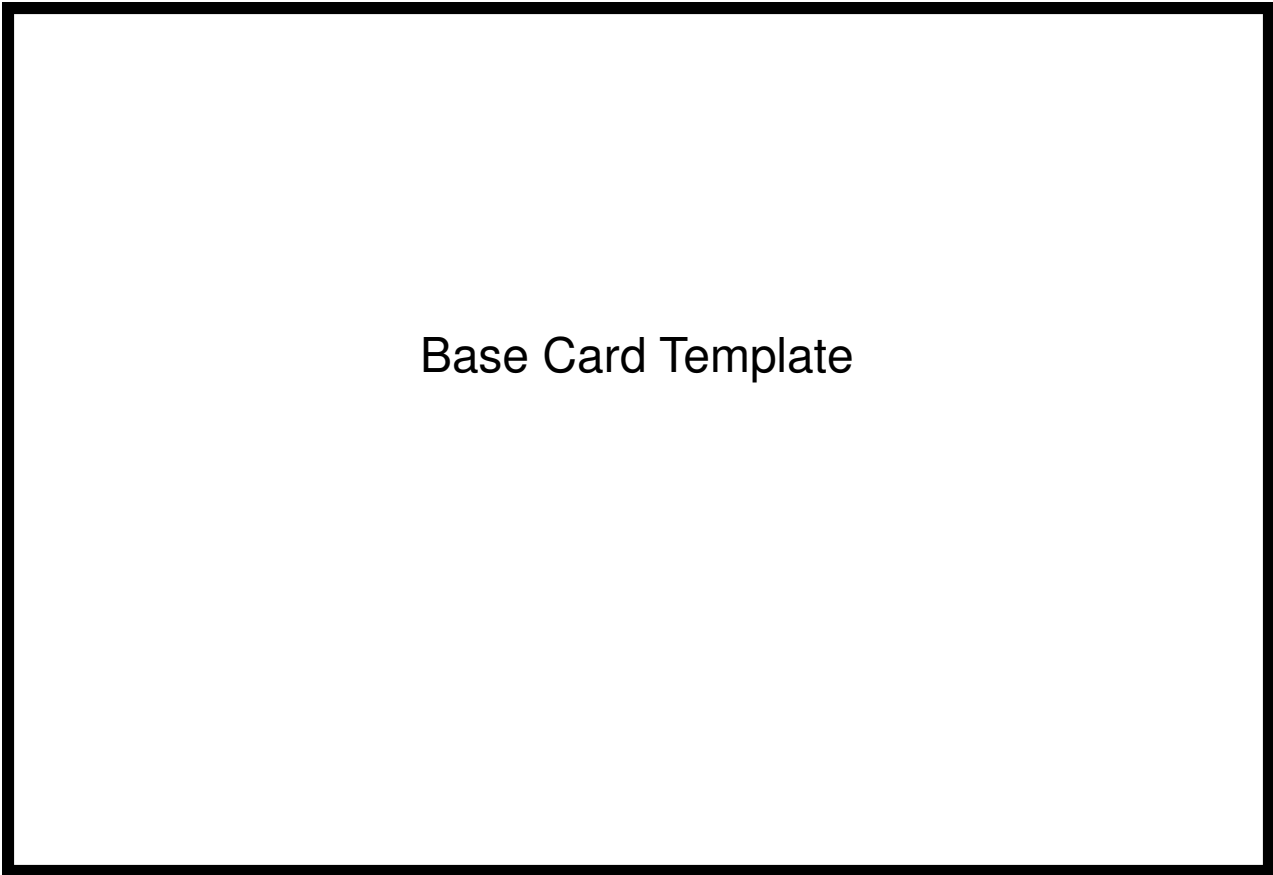
**Eat Cake!**

## Eat cake! Card

Cut out the text message box if using and the letters too. As a quicker alternative you can use letter stickers on your card instead of cutting out the ones on your sheet. Choose a card blank and attach a background piece of card or paper of your choice. Assemble the pieces of the card till your happy and stick down to finish.

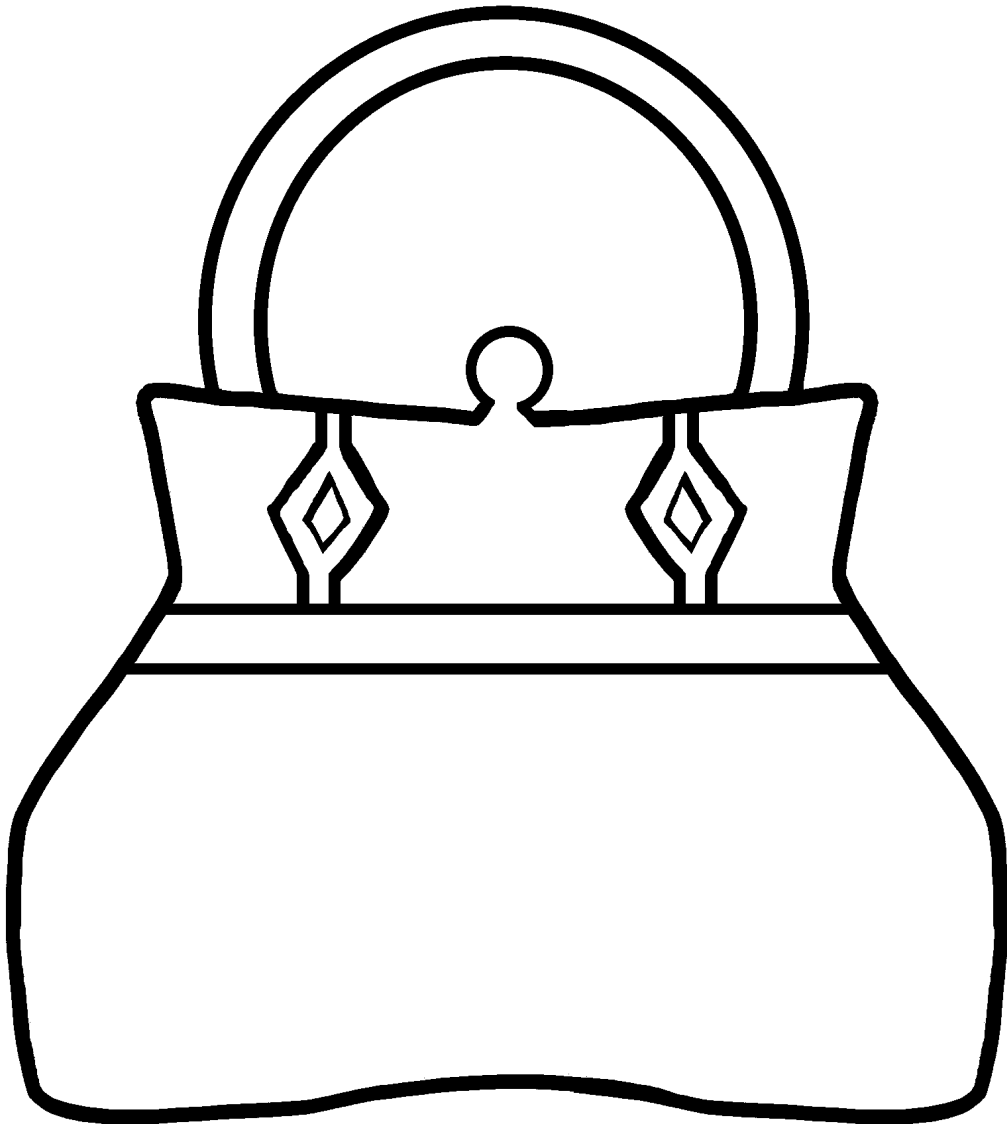

## Fashion Shoes and Bag Card

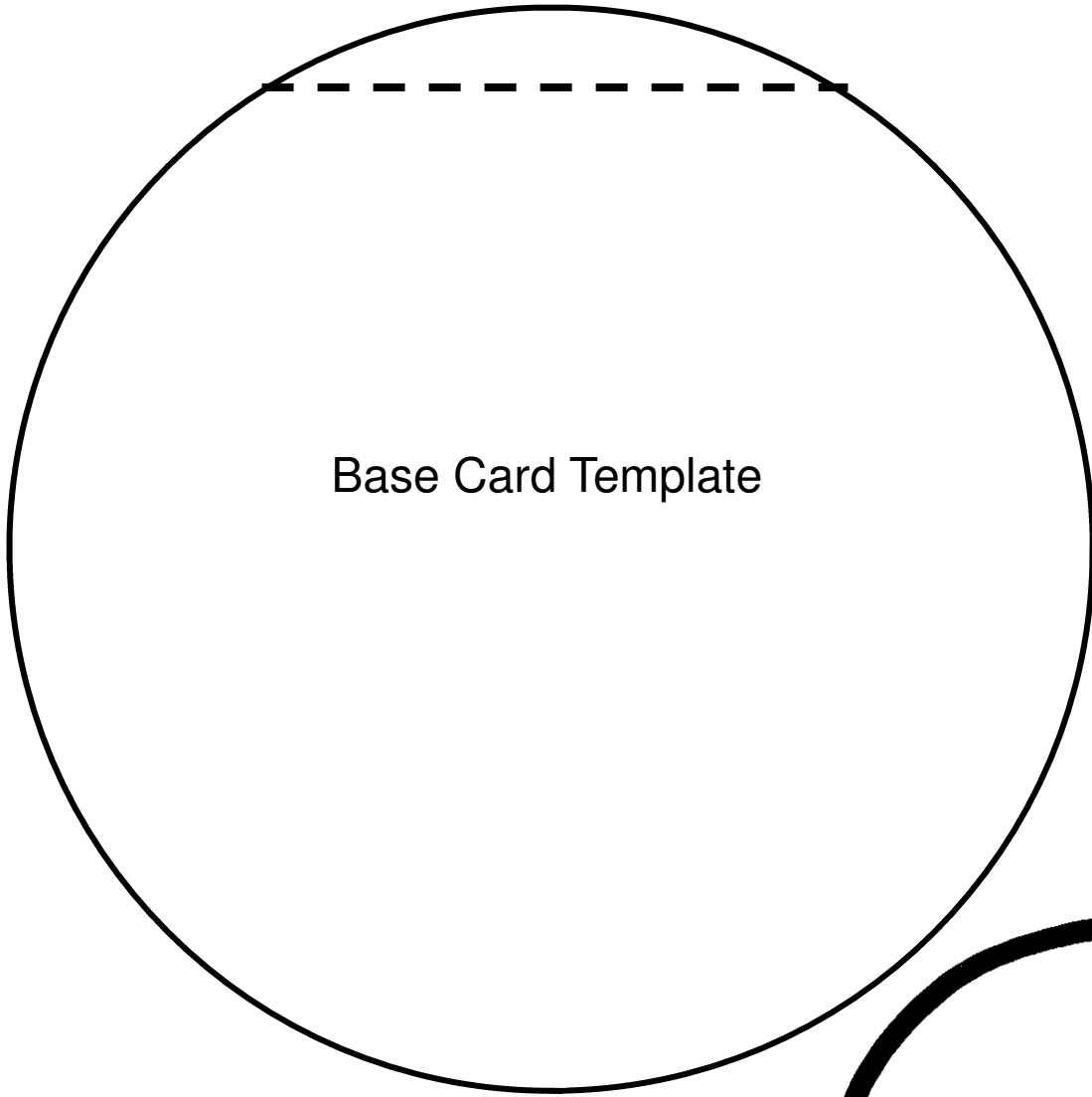
You can use this template in many different ways, you could use the bag and shoe independently or you can follow these instructions to use both template on one card.

Print off both sheets of the template and cut out the piece marked base card template. Fold a piece of A4 card in half and place the base card template on it, matching the top edge with the fold on your card. Draw around the shape and cut it out keeping the card folded to create your base card. Next cut out the shoe from the template and draw around that on to plain or patterned paper. Cut off the inner part and draw around on to a different card or paper and then reattach it over your shoe shape. Put these pieces to one side. Next cut out the bag template. You can cut out the inner bit between the bag and the handle and keep it all as one piece or you can snip off the handle and draw around it independently or use something else for your handle. Draw around the bag shape on to plain or patterned card and cut it out. Decorate with ribbon/lace/pens etc. Once you're happy with your pieces you can assemble your card. Take the base card and cover it with plain or patterned paper for your background. Attach the bag to the front first, the left edge slightly overlaps the edge of the card. Attach the shoe on next, sticking down the shoe so it slightly overlaps the right edge of the card. The card has been designed to fit inside a C5 envelope so if you want to play about with the layout of it you can pop a C5 envelope behind it and line up your pieces so they'll fit the envelope.

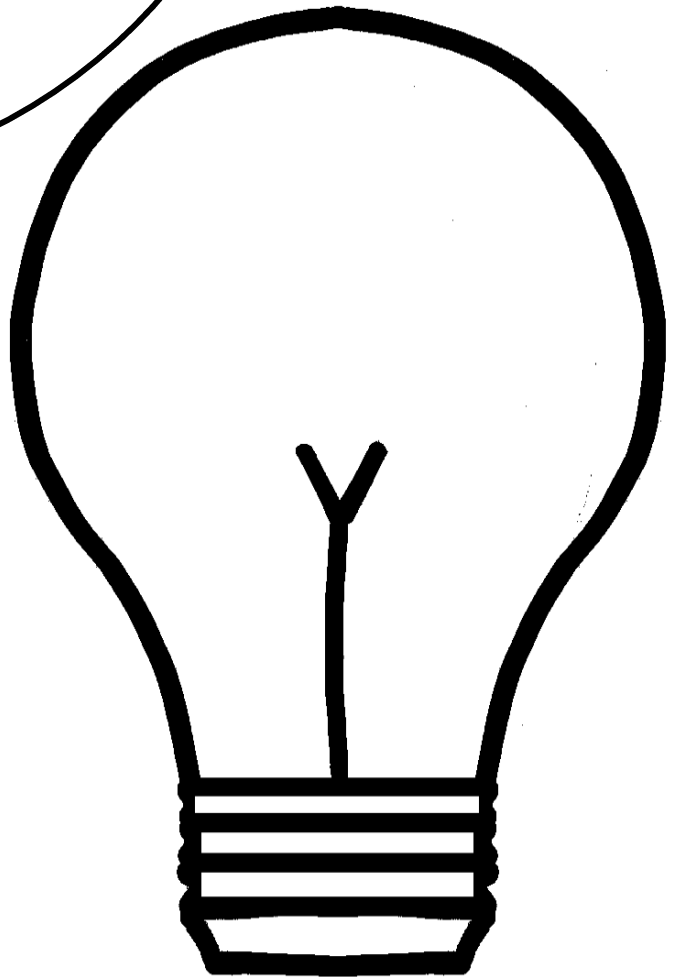

**Bulb - I remembered!**



## Bulb Card

Print off the bulb card template and cut out the shaped card template piece. Fold a piece of A4 card in half and place the card template on it matching the dashed line on the template to the fold line on your card then draw around the shape. Cut out the card shape keeping the card folded. Now you should have your base card. Next take the card template again and some more coloured or patterned card, whatever you would like your card background to be. Draw around the whole circle shape this time and cut it out. Attach to the front of your base card, matching up the bottom edge. The card will stand with a round bottom edge but it does rock slightly, this could be fun but if you'd prefer it didn't at this stage cut off a small portion at the bottom to give it a flat edge. Next take the printed template sheet again and now cut out the bulb shape. Draw around the whole shape on to yellow card and cut out. Cut the bottom part off the bulb template and draw around that onto silver card or paper. Do the same with the filament bit inside. Edge all the pieces of the bulb with a black pen and stick together. Attach the bulb to the front of your card and finish with your choice of message.
