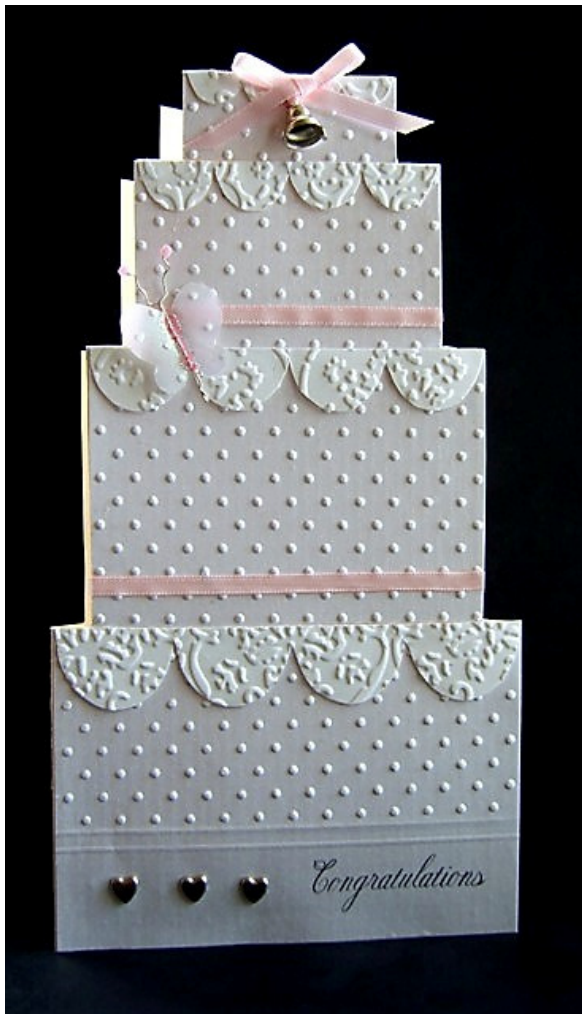
How adorable is this! Here Kathy has used the Baby Bootie template (page 9 of your template set) to create a mini book rather than a shaped card. All you need to do to recreate this is to draw around your template on to a single sheet of card once for each page you would like to create and one for your cover. Cut them out, punch a hole in the top corner of each piece and then attach together with ribbon, a book ring or other fastening.

If you like the idea of creating a mini book experiment with other Crafty Templates or check out the new Mini Book Crafty Templates that have been specifically designed to create shaped mini books without the need to create shaped pages too. They've also been designed to work with a Bind-it-All machine too. Check out the new templates in the subscribers area.

## *Cards By Tracy Gough*

I'm delighted to introduce a new member of the Crafty Templates design team, Tracy Gough! Tracy has designed some adorable cards with this months templates and kit and will be back next month to make more too!

Tracy has used the Love Birds template (page 1) to create the card opposite adding a scalloped edge along the bottom of the shaped base card. To do this simply cut or punch out circles of card and arrange along the edge to look like a scalloped edge then stick down. In the other cards below (right to left) Tracy has used the Linked Hearts template (page 5) the Tiered cake template (page 7) and the Wedding Bells template (page 3).
