

**Rainbow Frame Card**

## Rainbow Frame Card

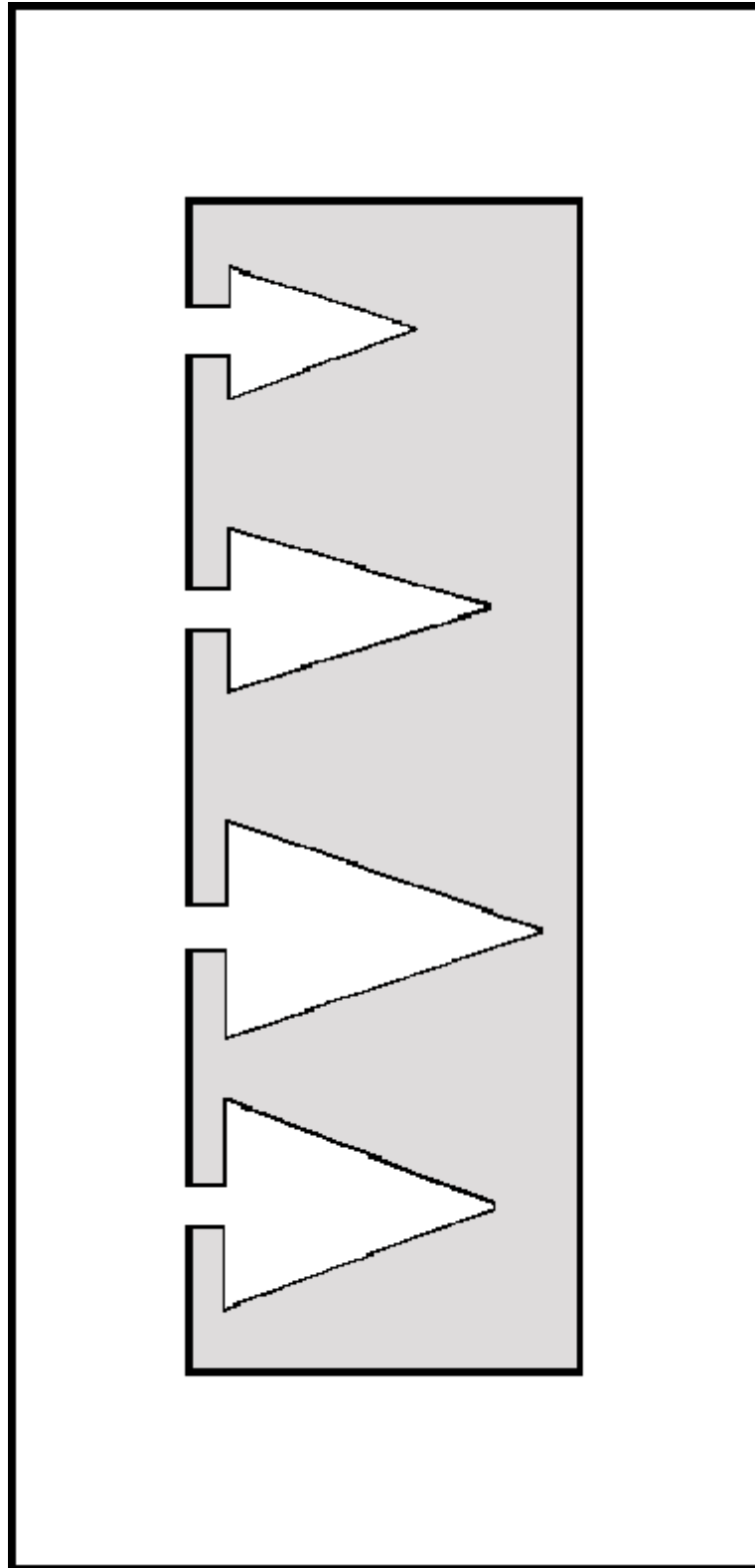
Print off the template and cut it out around the outside then cut out the grey area to create your frame template shape. Use the outside line of the template to create your card blank, matching up the left side of the template to the fold on your card then drawing around and cutting out. Alternatively use a ready made large square card blank. Place the template over the front of your card and draw around the inside bit of the frame on to the front of your card. Unfold your card and cut away the middle bit just like you did when you cut out the grey bit of the template. You should now have an aperture cut out of the front of your card. Cover the rainbow bit of the card using pieces of coloured card or alternatively colour it in. Cover the inside of your card with patterned paper so it shows through the front of your card. Finish off with a stamped message on the front of your card and add a little more embellishment as you wish.

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**Christmas Tree Frame Card**



## Christmas Tree Frame Card

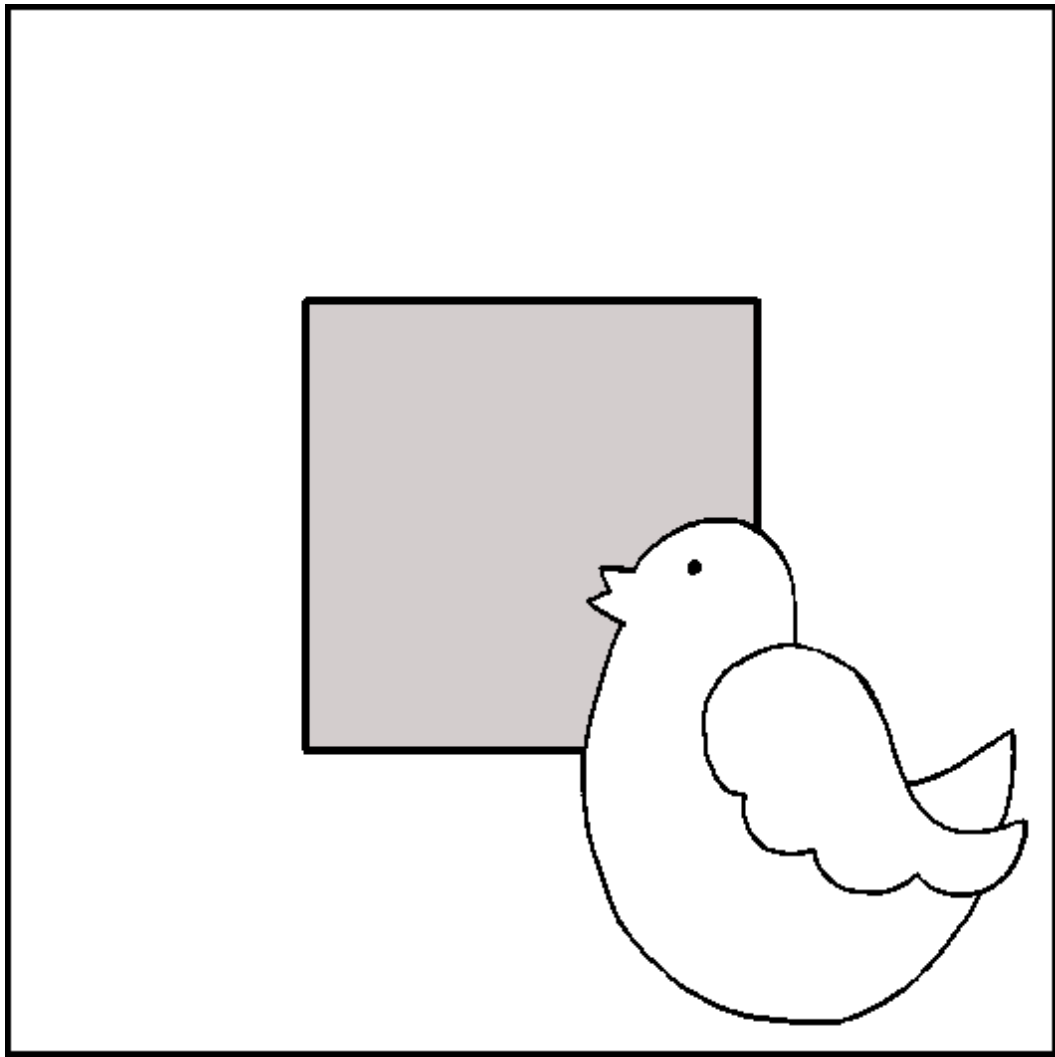
Print off the template and cut it out around the outside line. Cut away all the grey area to create your frame template. Draw around the template on to your choice of patterned or coloured card and cut it out. This is your 'frame' piece. Use the template drawing around the outside line to create your card blank (or use a ready made DL size card blank). Place some patterned or coloured card over the front of your card blank. Place the frame over the top and glue down. From here you can embellish your card further as you wish.

Alternative to placing the frame directly over the whole front of the card you can also use your template to draw on to the front of your card and cut out the inner shape to make an aperture in your card and then decorate your card.

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**Birdie Frame Card**

## Birdie Frame Card

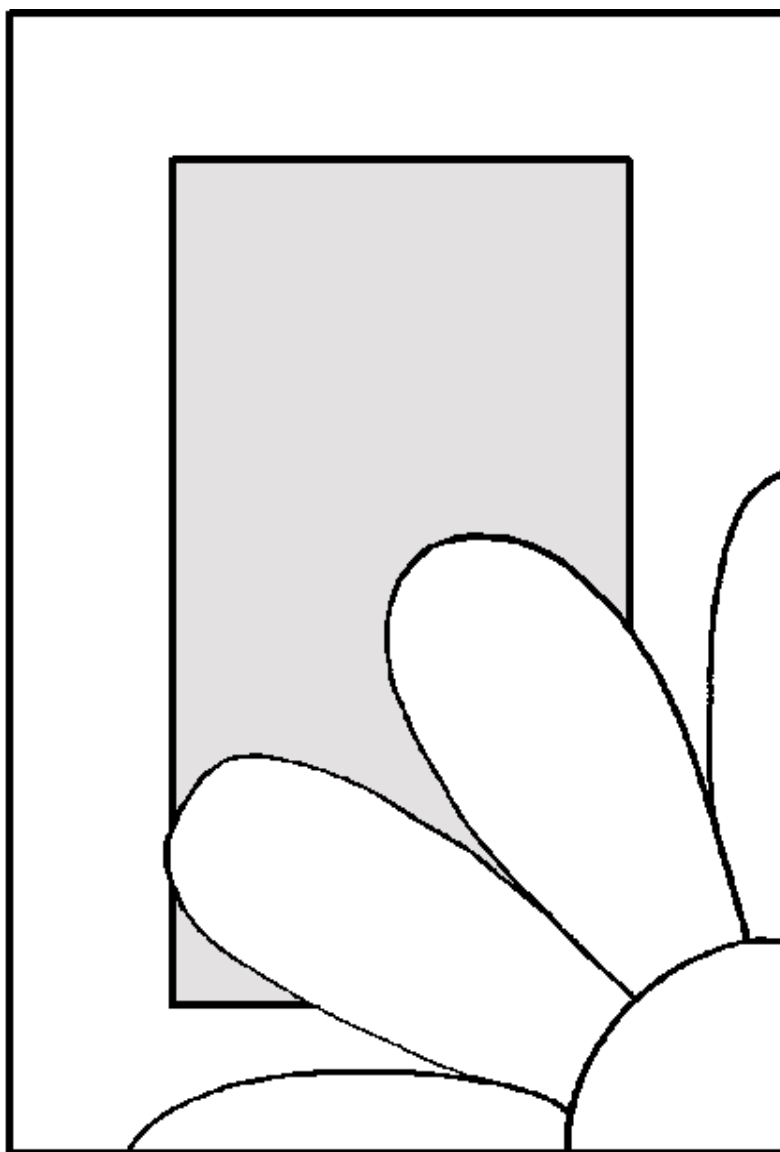
Print off the template and cut it out around the outside then cut out the grey area to create your frame template shape. Use the outside line of the template to create your card blank, matching up the left side of the template to the fold on your card then drawing around and cutting out. When you have your card blank place the template back over and draw around the inside bit of the frame on to the front of your card. Unfold your card and cut away the middle bit just like you did when you cut out the grey bit of the template. You should now have an aperture cut out of the front of your card.

Next take the template again and cut out the birdie shape from it. Draw around it on to coloured or patterned card and cut it out to create your birdie embellishment. Decorate the front of your card some more around the frame before sticking over the birdie embellishment if you wish then once you're happy stick over the birdie embellishment matching the shape on the frame to get it in the correct place. Cover the inside of your card with patterned paper and add a message and a little more embellishment to the front of your card to finish.

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**Flower Frame Card**

## Flower Frame Card

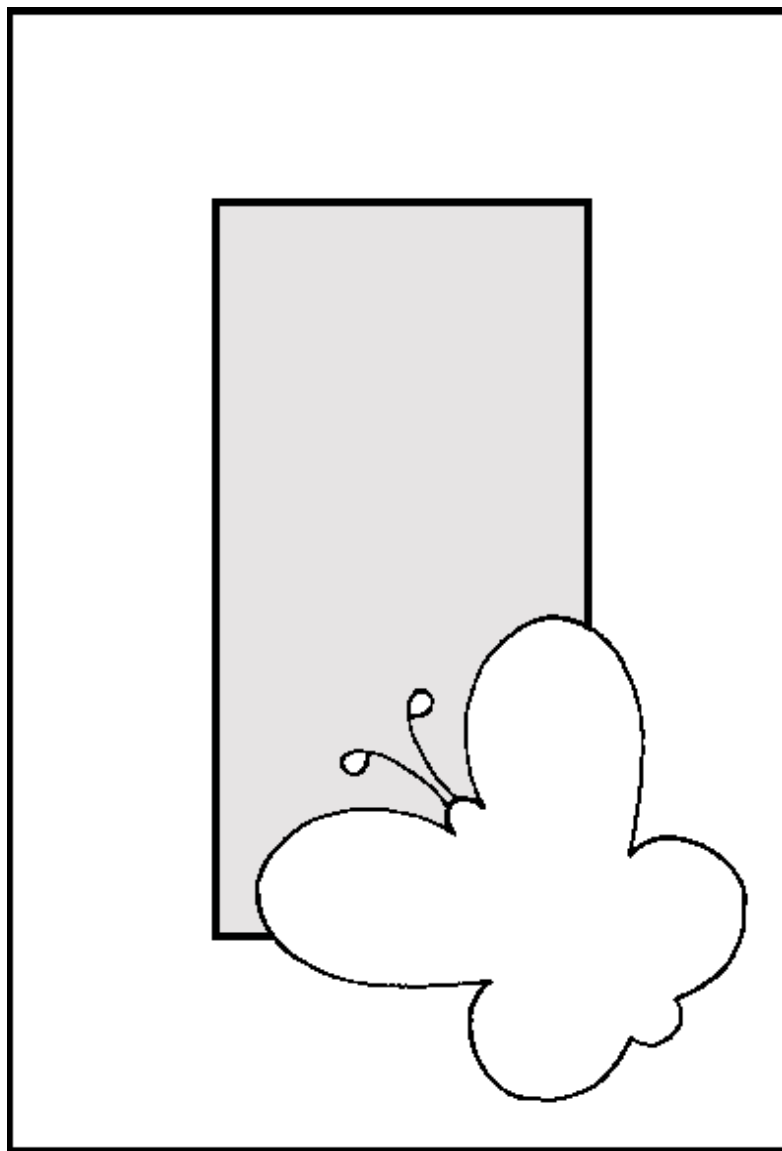
Print off the template and cut it out around the outside then cut out the grey area to create your frame template shape. Use the outside line of the template to create your card blank, matching up the left side of the template to the fold on your card then drawing around and cutting out. When you have your card blank place the template back over and draw around the inside bit of the frame on to the front of your card. Unfold your card and cut away the middle bit just like you did when you cut out the grey bit of the template. You should now have an aperture cut out of the front of your card.

Take the template again and cut off the flower part. Draw around it on to coloured or patterned card and cut it out. Draw over the edges to recreate the flower shape as it appears on the template. Next cover the whole of the front of your card with a co-ordinating patterned paper and re cut out the aperture shape from the middle. Trace around the frame edge with a marker pen, you can also add some doodling if you wish to. Place the flower shape over the corner of your frame and glue in place. Stamp a message to the inside of your card so it shows through the aperture from the front.

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**Butterfly frame card**

## Butterfly Frame Card

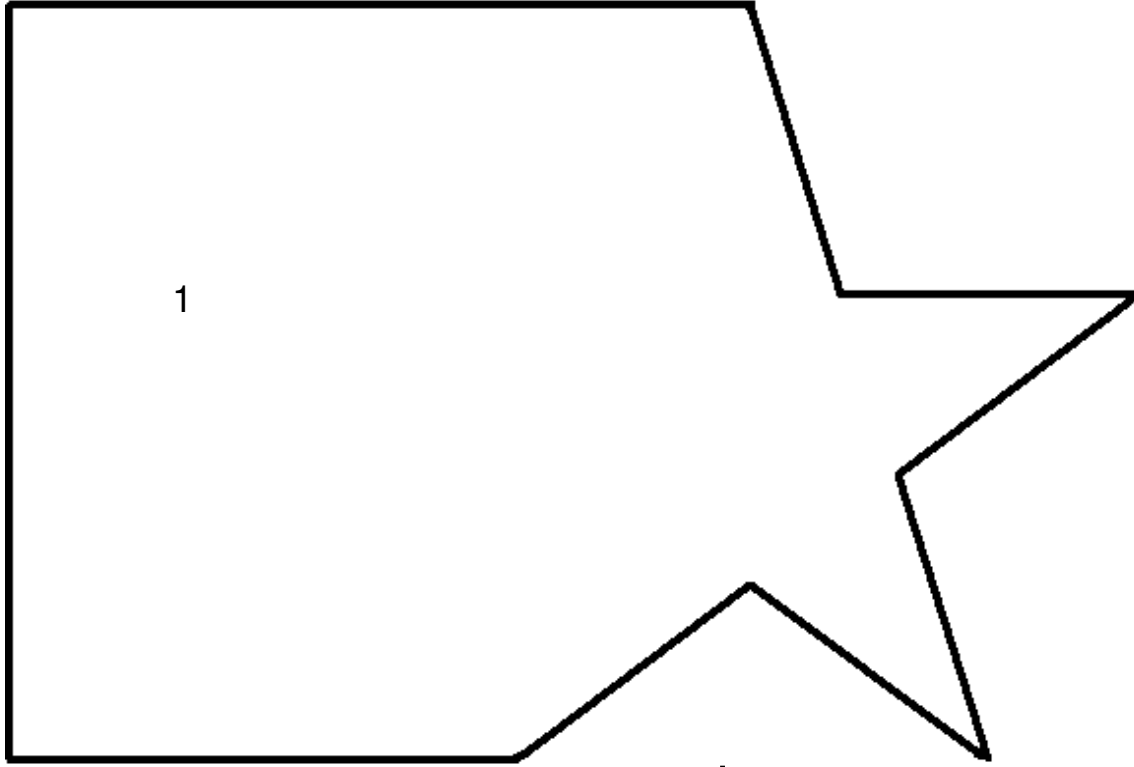
Print off the template and cut it out around the outside then cut out the grey area to create your frame template shape. Use the outside line of the template to create your card blank, matching up the left side of the template to the fold on your card then drawing around and cutting out. When you have your card blank place the template back over and draw around the inside bit of the frame on to the front of your card. Unfold your card and cut away the middle bit just like you did when you cut out the grey bit of the template. You should now have an aperture cut out of the front of your card.

Take the template again and cut off the butterfly part. Draw around it on to coloured or patterned card and cut it out. Draw over the edges to recreate the butterfly shape as it appears on the template. Next cover the whole of the front of your card with a co-ordinating patterned paper and re cut out the aperture shape from the middle. Doodle around the frame edge and card edge to give it definition. Place the butterfly shape over the corner of your frame and glue in place. Stamp a message around the frame to finish. You can add further embellishment to the inside of the card so it shows through if you wish to or have a greeting or verse show through from inside.

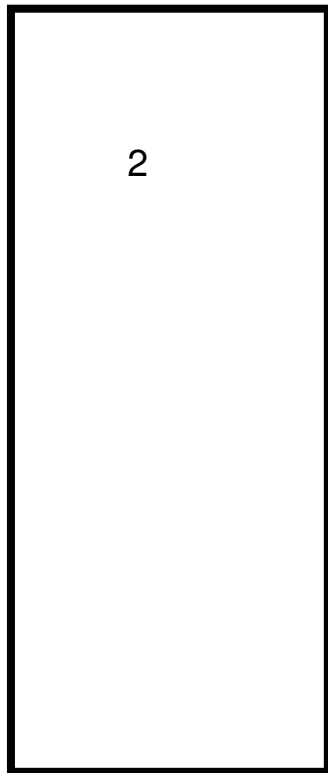


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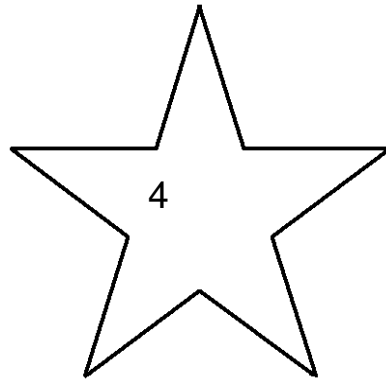


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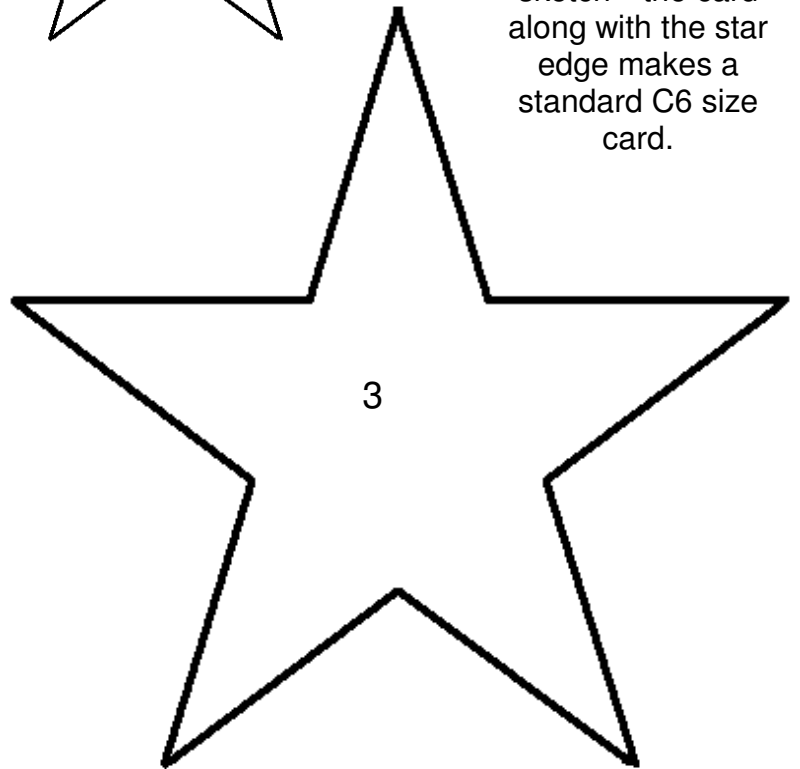

**Star Shaped Edge Card**

## Star Shaped Edge Card

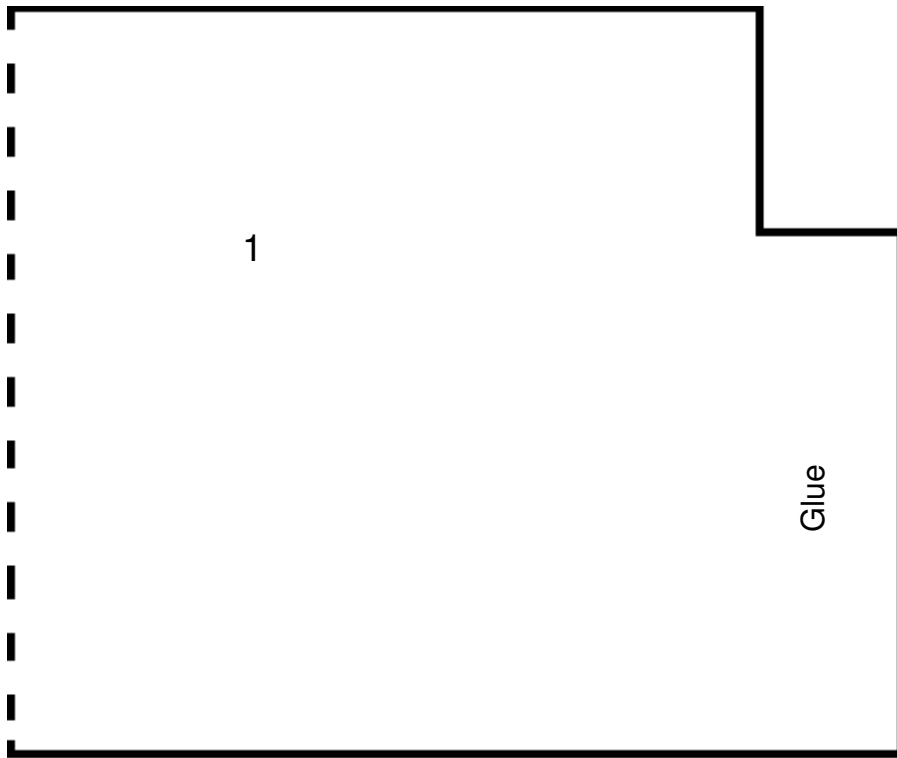
Print off the template sheet. Take an A4 sheet of card and fold it in half then cut it in half so you get two A6 size card blanks. You will only need one of these for your card so keep one and put the other to one side.

Cut out the piece marked as 1 on the template sheet. Place it on your card blank so that the left edge matches up to the fold and draw around the shape. Keep the card folded and cut out the shape from your card blank to create a card with a star shape going off the edge. Next cut out the piece marked 2 and draw around that on to a patterned paper. Stick this piece of paper across the middle of your card. Cut out both the stars from the template sheet. Draw around them on to patterned paper and cut them out. Take the star marked 3 and glue it on to your card blank matching up the shaped edge. Finally attach the small star to the centre.

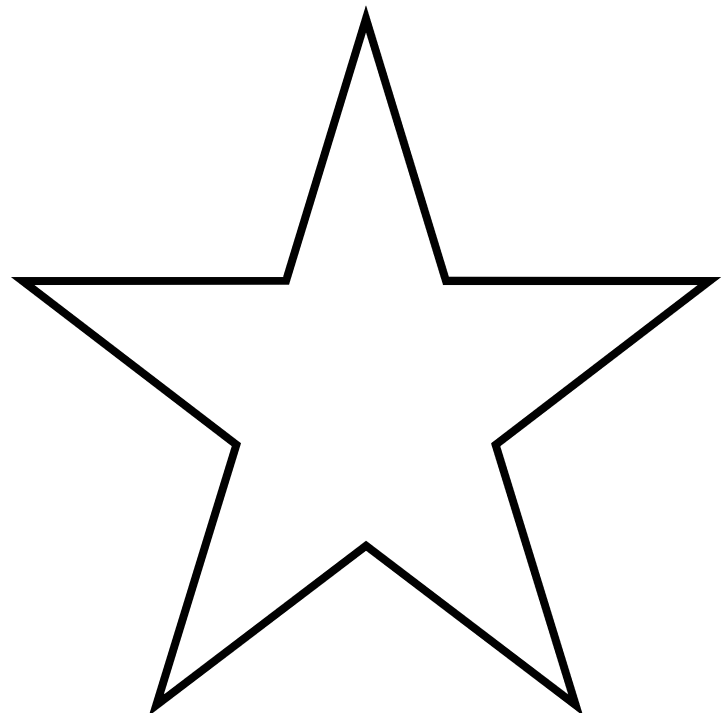
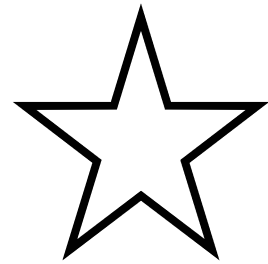
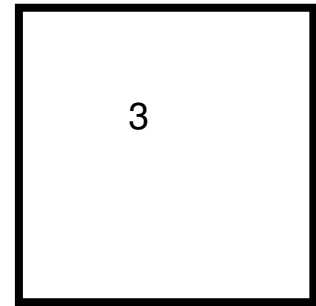
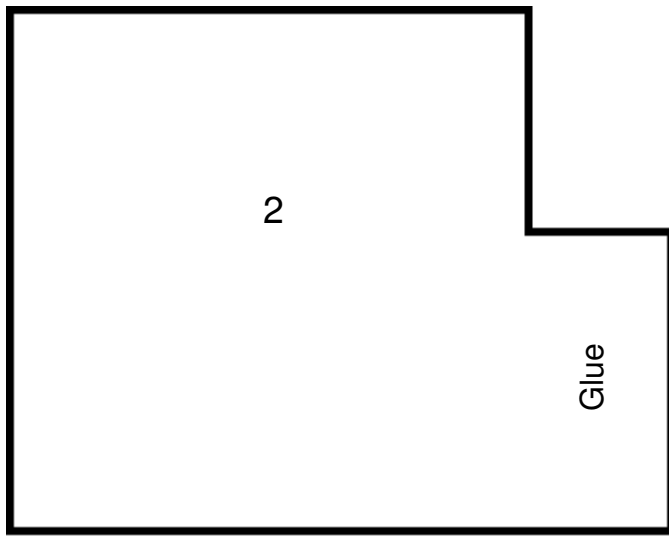

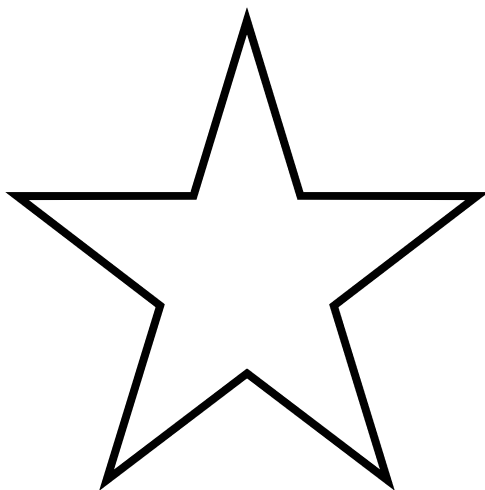
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Makes a D1 Size card, layer starting with 1 (make your card front this shape) then layer the squares using the flaps and add the stars on each square.



**3 Stars Card**



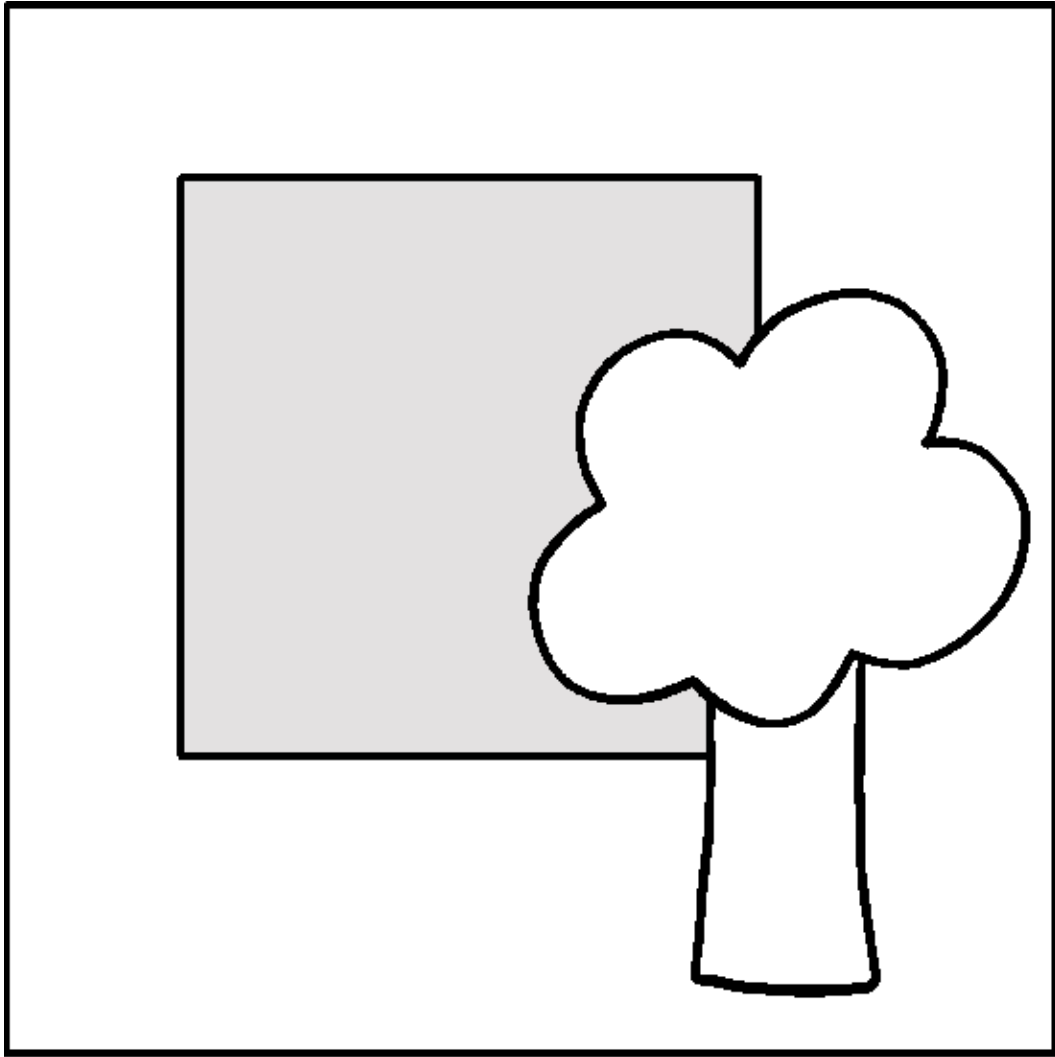
### 3 Stars Card

Print the template sheet and cut out all the pieces. Take an A4 sheet of plain card and fold it in half. Place the template piece marked 1 and place it on your folded card matching the dashed line to the fold on your card, draw around the shape and cut it out keeping the card folded. This will be your base card bit. Next take the template pieces marked 2 and 3 and draw around those on to the scraps of plain card you have left over. Cover all the pieces with plain or patterned card/paper. Now to put the card together place glue in the places indicated on the template and attach each of the squares together using the flap pieces and matching up the top and bottom edge. You should now have a long card with three square panels at the front and a small bit that opens with a fold at the back. You can cut off the flap piece on the back of your card to make it square if you want. Next draw around each of the stars on coloured card and cut them out. There's a star to fit in the centre of each of the squares so simply glue them on to each square. You can add your choice of message and further embellishment as you wish.

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**Tree Frame Card**

## Tree Frame Card

Print off the template and cut it out around the outside then cut out the grey area to create your frame template shape. Use the outside line of the template to create your card blank, matching up the left side of the template to the fold on your card then drawing around and cutting out. When you have your card blank place the template back over and draw around the inside bit of the frame on to the front of your card. Unfold your card and cut away the middle bit just like you did when you cut out the grey bit of the template. You should now have a aperture cut out of the front of your card.

Next take the template again and cut out the tree shape from it. Draw around it on to coloured or patterned card and cut them out to create your tree embellishment.

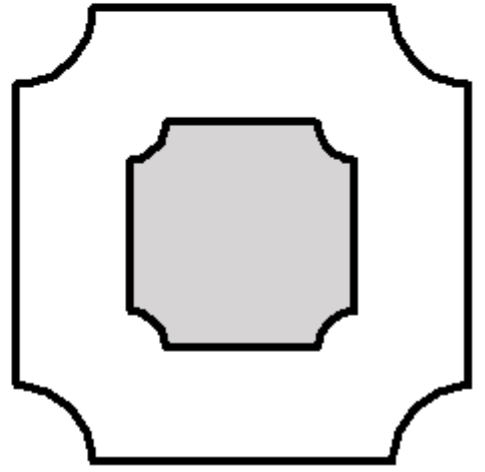
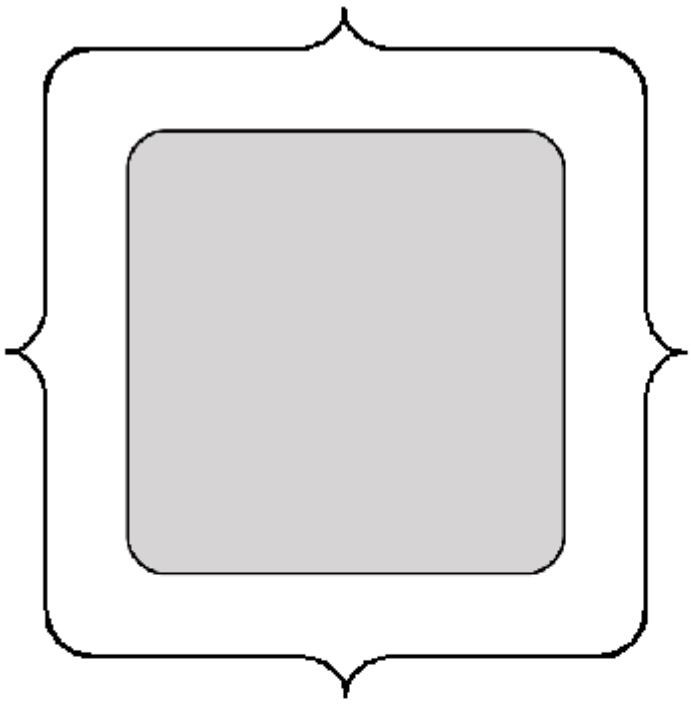
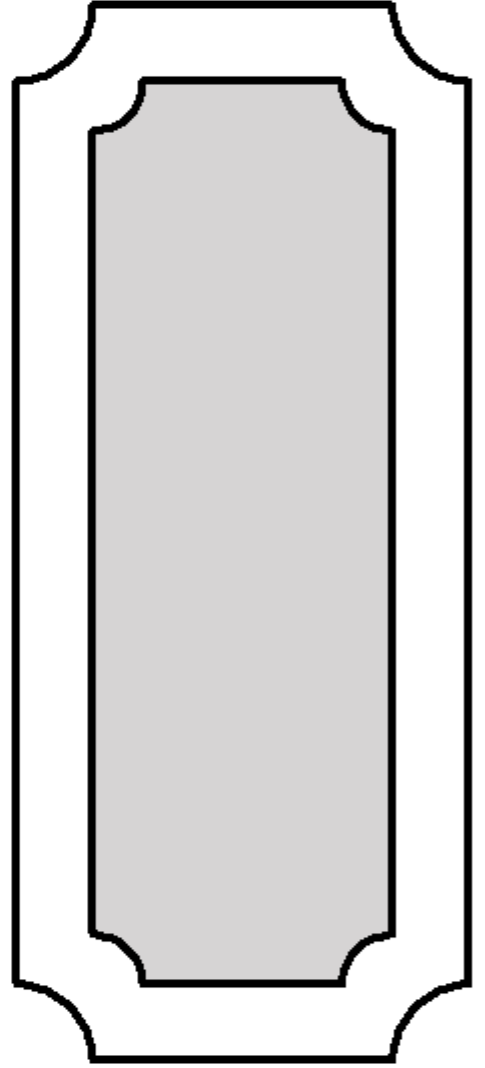
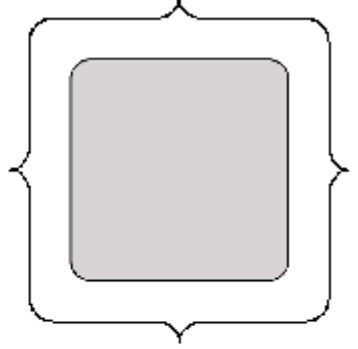
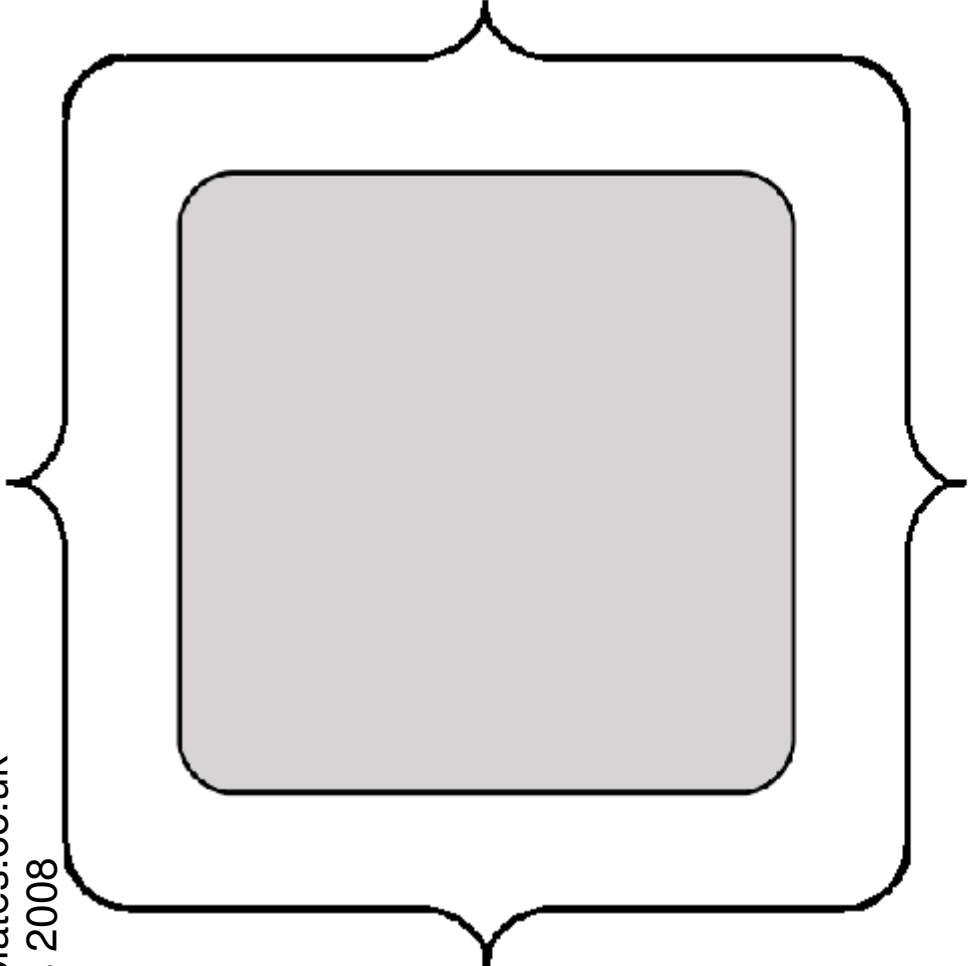
Decorate the front of your card some more around the frame before sticking over the tree embellishment if you wish then once you're happy stick over the tree embellishment matching the tree shape of the frame to get it in the correct place. Cover the inside of your card with patterned paper and add a message so it shows through the aperture. Finish off with a little more embellishment, a little ribbon etc.

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**Fancy Frames**

Mixture of fancy frames for cards

## Fancy Frames Card

This template sheet has lots of different frames for you to pick out and use. As with all the templates in this set you simply cut around the outside and then cut away the grey area to create your shaped frame template.

In the card sample bellow I used the largest template on the sheet which fits a large square card blank (the 6x6 ones) perfectly. The template is used to create a frame from card I've then stamped a message in repeat all over the front of it. The flowers have been scattered around the frame and glued in place then finished off with some brads and buttons. I also tied some ribbon around the frame along one edge.

The card blank has been covered with some patterned paper and then a piece of crochet lace placed over the top. Finally I attached the frame on to the card with 3D foam pads.

Have a go at experimenting with your frames, both in what you use to cut them from (try card, patterned paper, fabric, foam, felt etc) and what you decorate them with!

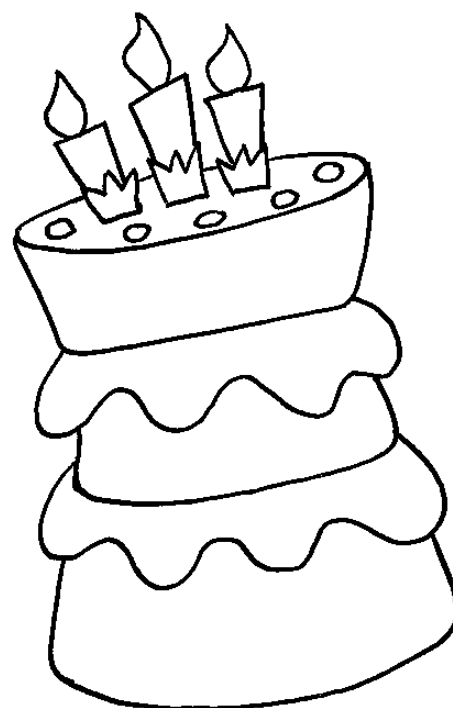


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**Cake Frame Card**

Copy of main embellishment.  
You could print this directly  
on to coloured card or white  
card and add colour.



## Cake Frame Card

Print off the template sheet. Place a piece of plain card over the top of the cake shape in the bottom right corner of the sheet and use tape to stick it to the sheet around the edges. Pop the sheet back in your printer and print off the same sheet again so the cake is printed on to the piece of card. Remove it from the sheet and pop it to one side to dry.

Now cut out the frame template, cutting around the outside edge and then cutting away the grey area to create the frame. Place the frame template on to plain or coloured card and draw around it then cut it out. Pick out or make a card blank to use.

In the sample I used an A6 size card (A4 sheet of card folded and cut in half) but you can also use the outside edge of the frame template to create a card blank or use a ready made square card blank.

Decorate the front of your card with your choice of whatever you want to put behind your frame. I chose a combination of ribbon and strips of patterned paper. Take the frame you cut out earlier and place it on top of your card, gluing in place once you're happy.

Next take the picture of the cake that you printed on to card at the start and colour it in. Once you're happy with it glue it to your card matching up the edges on the frame to get it in the correct position. Finally add a little more embellishment as you wish to finish off your card.
