Patsy got the flip flop template (page 1 ) and the dinosaur template (page 2) to play with this month. Patsy used Jennie Bowlin Spring Picnic paper from Altered Treasures as well as lilac cardstock, buttons and fabric blossoms.



Patsy says:

*" Whilst making this, I thought it would be a great card to give to someone off on some travels or a sabbatical or something so I printed out a 'bon voyage' sentiment and attached it with a knot of ribbon and a silk bloom from the Altered Treasures kit."*

Patsy says:

*"Dino was made out of bright green bazzill cardstock which I put through my Cuttlebug and embossed in mosaic squares (to give a kind of scaly effect), I then used lilac card from the Altered treasures kit. I doodled, inked and glittered him up! This would make a great kid's birthday card!"*

This month Louise got to play with the hat template (page 8) and the well done template sheet (page 5). Louise made this fantastic card with the well done template. Some of the stars are attached to the others with little springs, so cute!



Here's Louise's card made with the hat template. She's covered the hat with patterned paper and added a ribbon effect with glitter card around it. The feathers she's attached underneath the addition layered flower embellishments with a button in the centre to finish. Just stunning!



Louise got a feel for the fashion templates so decided to use these two previous Crafty Templates designs to make cards in a similar way to the hat card. These templates are the fashion boot and fancy purse. The Fancy purse is from set 5 and the fashion boot is from set 4 both available in the subscriber content or you can email me if you can't find them and I can send them on to you.
