## New Year Clock Card

Print off the template directly onto card. Cut out all the numbers and the clock parts. Cover the pieces with paper or card or decorate them with glitter etc. For the clock face you can use patterned paper or as I've done bellow stamp a design on and decorate with more glitter. Attach the clock hands and numbers around the edge of the clock face. You can use a brad to attach the hands if you want to make them move around or fix in place. As this is a happy new year card I put the hands at a minute to midnight. When you've done decorating your clock attach it to a card blank or create your own card blank from a folded sheet of A4 card.

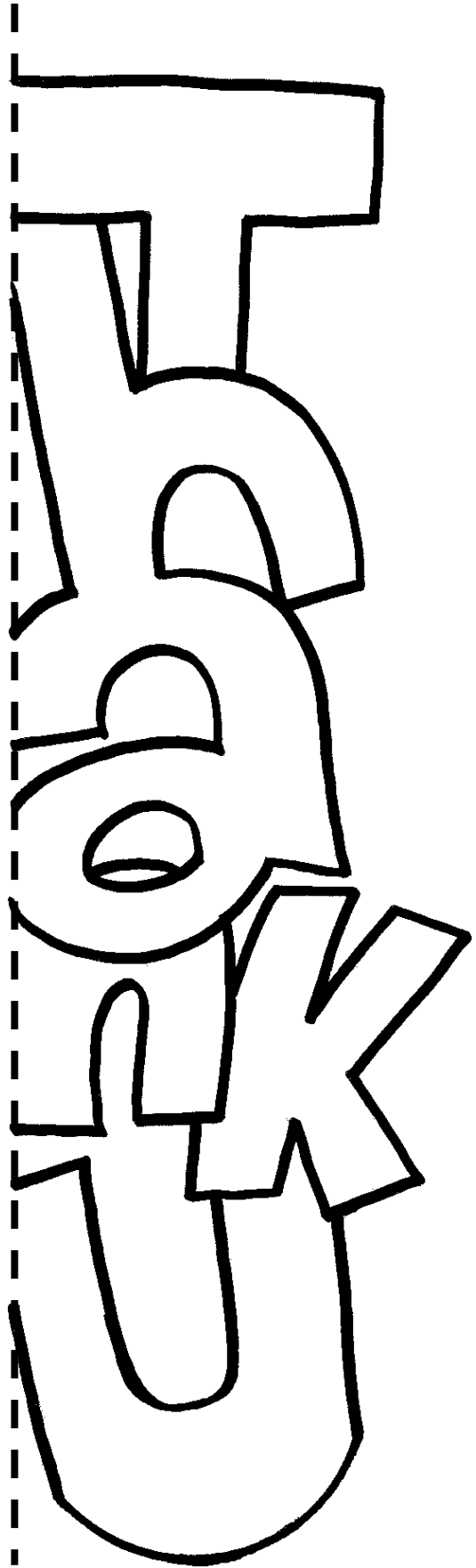
This template can be used for birthday cards too, how about time flies or party time?

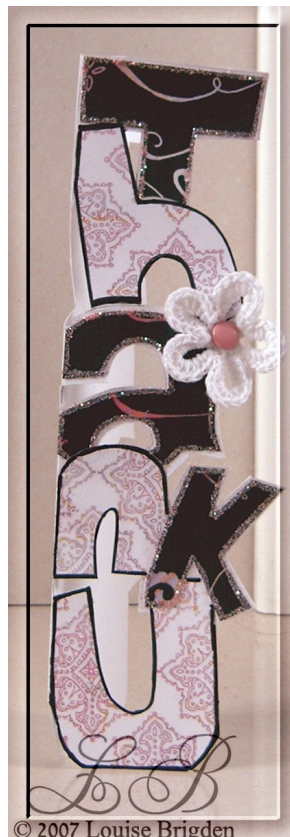
Thank u card



## Thank u Card

This cute card is ideal as a thank you card to send out to say thank you for your favorite Christmas gifts!

Print out the template and cut out the whole shape, cutting around the outermost edge only. Fold a piece of A4 card in half and match the template to the fold on your card, draw around the shape and cut out from the folded card to create a shaped card. Next take the template again and now cut out around each individual letter. Draw around them onto patterned paper, use alternative colours as Louise has done in the sample bellow for a nice effect. Stick the paper pieces over the letters and highlight the edges with a black pen. Decorate some more with your choice of embellishments.

## 2008 Card

Another simple new year card design you can adapt not just for cards but for decorations too.

Print off the template directly on to card and cut out the central bits first, the middle bits of the zeros, the gap right in the center and the eight. A way to do this is to make a hole in the centers (with a hole punch if you have one) first then snip into them with scissors using small cuts. Cutting the centers out first is much easier. Now cut around the outside lines to get your shape. Decorate the shape with stamps or cover with patterned papers then embellish with ribbons, gems, sequins etc. Cover a large square card blank with patterned paper or use a plain coloured one. Alternatively make one from A4 card by folding a sheet in half and cutting down to around 15cm square.

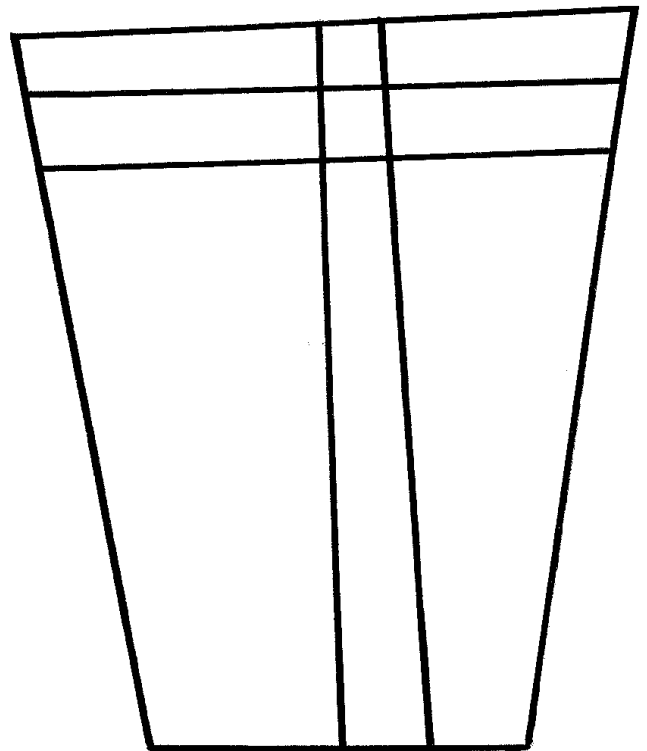
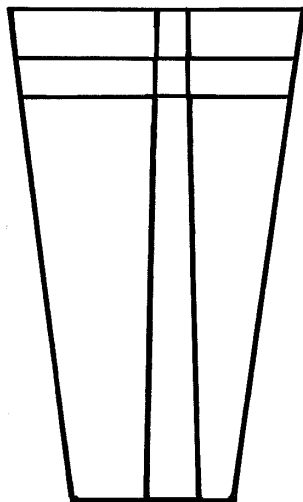
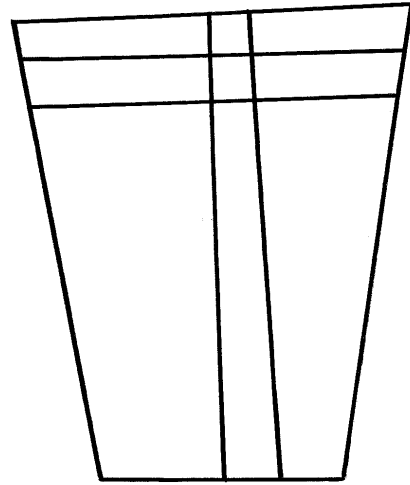
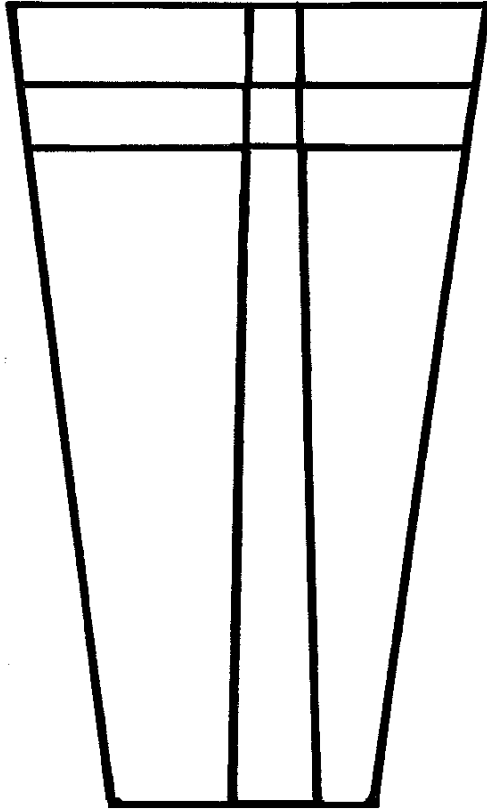
Rub an inkpad around the edge of your card blank then attach your shape on top.

Gift Boxes

## Gift Boxes

These funky little gift box shapes make great cards for so many occasions and best of all can be made from off cuts of card and paper!

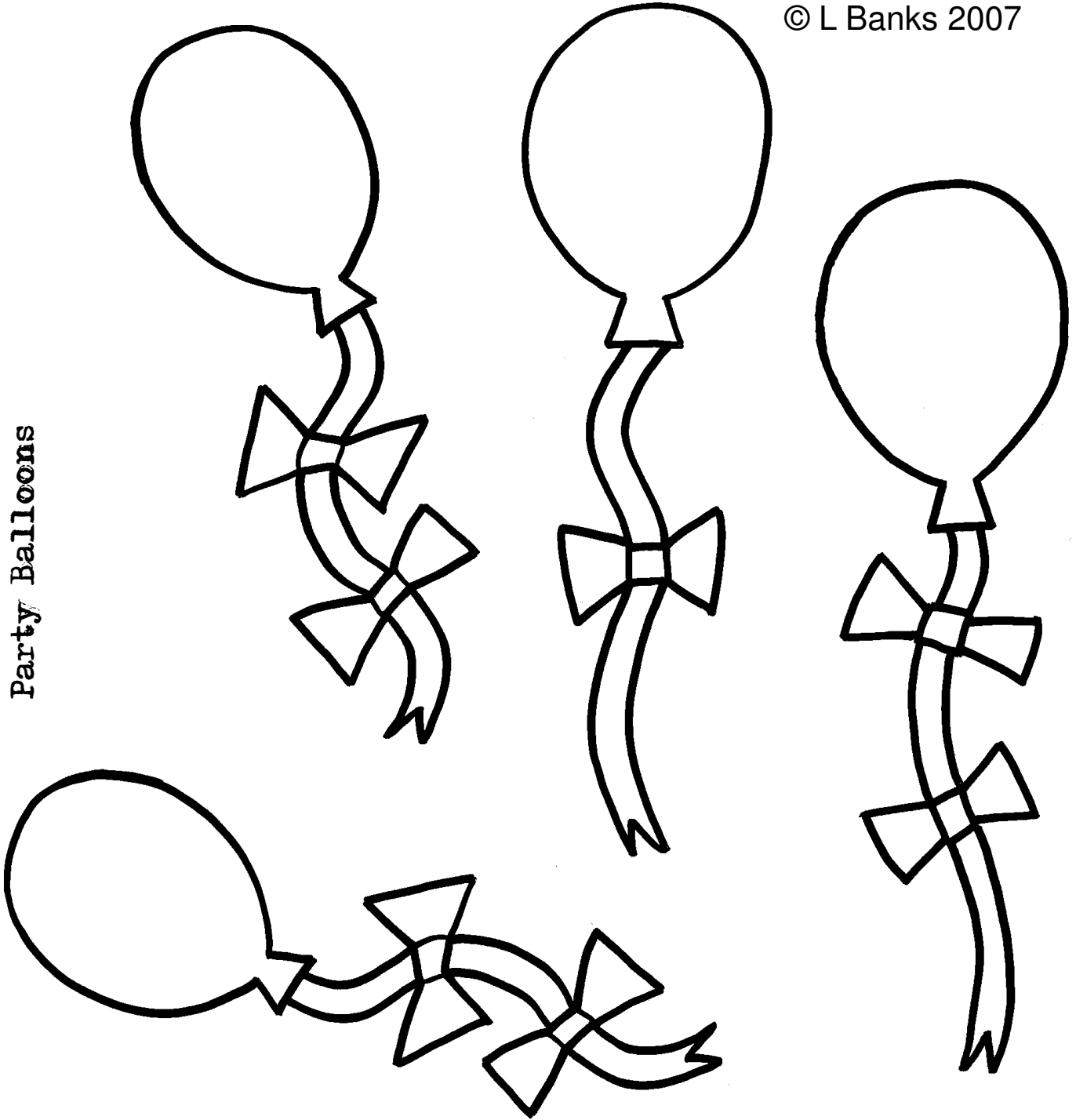
Print off your gift box sheet template and choose which gift box shapes you'd like to use. Cut them out just cutting around the outermost lines first. Take some off cuts of card or paper or use sheets if you don't have suitable off cuts and draw around the shapes on to them. Cut them out. Next cut out the ribbon parts on the gift box shapes and draw around on to a different colour of card or pattern paper and stick over your gift box shape. Draw around the edge of the shape with a black gel pen and along the edge of the ribbon. To finish you can also tie a real ribbon bow and attach to the top of your gift box shapes.

When you've done arrange the shapes on to your card and stick down. In the sample bellow I've made a doodled frame, look in your December inspiration sheet for details on how to make one, they're really simple!

## Party Balloons Card

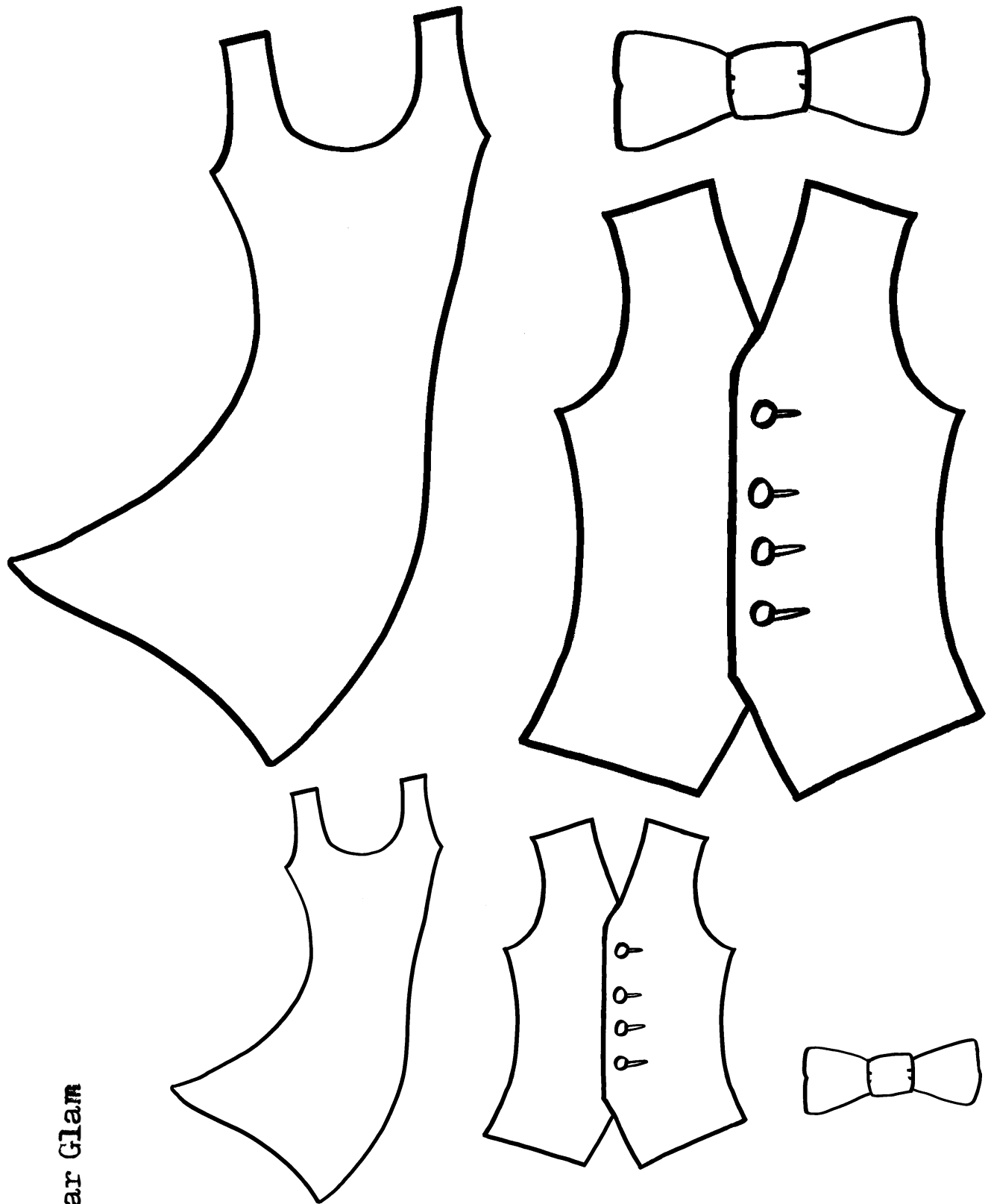
This is another card template that's great to use to make a happy new year card but also just as fab to make a birthday card with just by swapping your message on your balloons!

Print off your party balloons template sheet and cut out the balloons and the numbers. Draw around the balloons on to some patterned or plain paper and cut them out. Do the same with the numbers drawing around them on to holographic card or other decorative card or paper. Cut out the centers of the numbers before cutting out the outside, this is a lot easier that cutting them out afterwards.

When you have your four balloons and numbers attach each of the numbers to a balloon. Now you need a card blank. Take a sheet of A4 card (I used black card) and fold it in half. Measure and make a line 10cm from the folded edge and trim down to this size so you have a long tall card 10cm across. Turn the card so it stands horizontally. Now fold a scrap piece of A4 paper in half and lay your card so the bottom edge matches up to the scrap papers bottom edge. This will work as a guide when you're attaching your balloons so you know your card will still fit a C5 envelope. Attach your balloons to your card to finish.

## New Year Glam

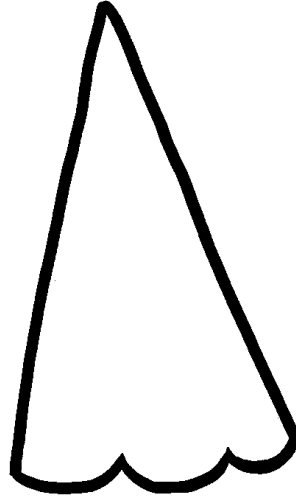
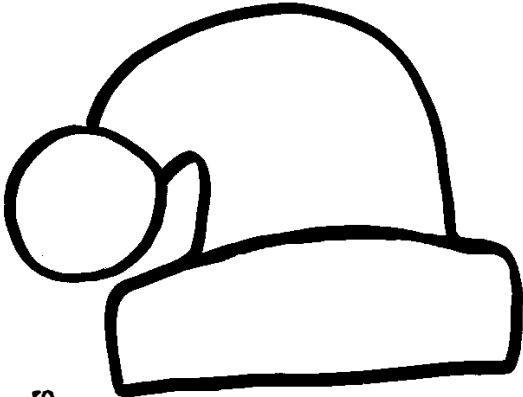
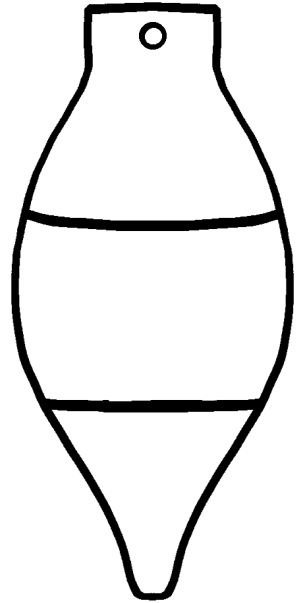
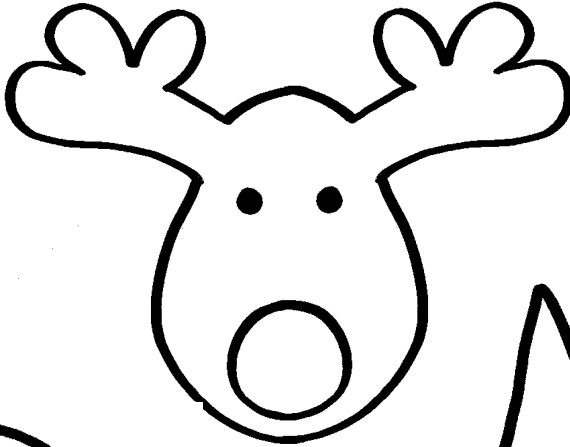
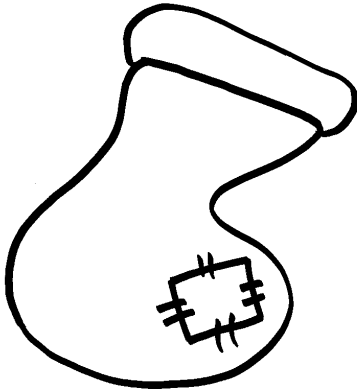
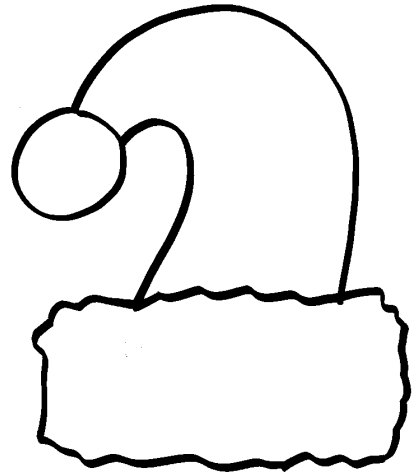
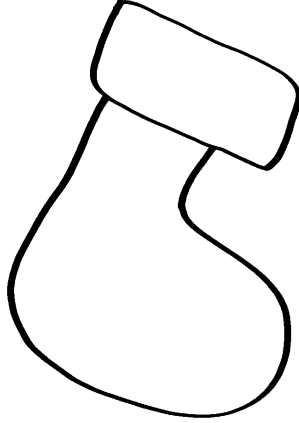
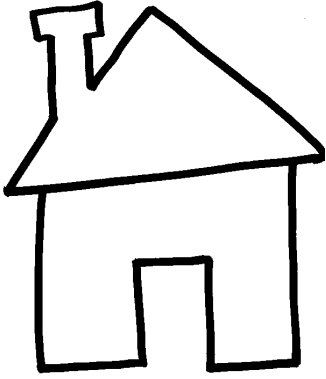
On this template sheet you have a waistcoat and a dress. You can choose to make individual cards or use them both on one card. There are also two sizes to use so you can make small card toppers or larger ones.

The cards bellow are both A6 sized cards and I've used the larger templates. First print out the template sheet and cut out the large dress and waistcoat. Draw around the dress on to black card (I used a silver marker pen). Cut out the shape and decorate with glitter glue and gems. Cover an A6 shaped card blank with glitter card or patterned paper and matt your dress on to it. Add on your message to finish.

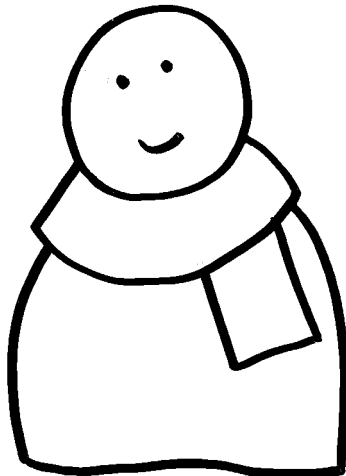
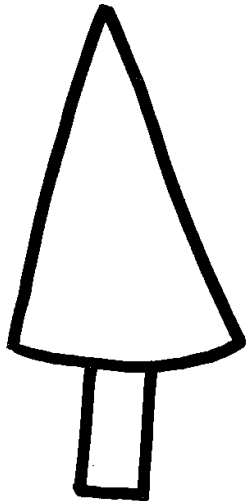
For the waistcoat draw around the shape on to holographic card or metallic card and also on to black card and cut them out. Stick the black piece over the holographic on so it's showing a slight over lap. Draw on the detail from the template and decorate with gems and glitter glue. Cut out the bow tie from holographic card and again draw on the detail, (the best thing to use for this is a marker pen as holographic card has a glossy coating). Attach the bow to the waistcoat. Matt a piece of patterned paper to the front of an A6 card blank and attach your waistcoat to the center.

## Festive Mini Topper Templates

This template sheet has lots of mini templates to use ideally sized for gift tags, place cards and small cards. Print off the template sheet and pick a shape to use, cut it out and draw around on to coloured card. Add the details and decorate as you choose.

Bellow I picked out the tree and cut it from silver glitter card then matted on to a small piece of folded black card to create a simple place setting. I used the house shape cut from brown card and decorated with a white pen and glitter to create a gingerbread house topper.

The reindeer head I cut out from brown card and used red for his nose (covered with glossy accents to make it shiny!). I cut out a piece of green card to make a gift tag and matted a piece of red card edged with brown ink on to it. I then stamped on the greeting across the top and inked around the whole of the tag. Finally I attached the reindeer topper and threaded some ribbon through the top.

You can create combinations of shapes by mixing them to create mini scenes or keep it simple using them alone. Have fun!

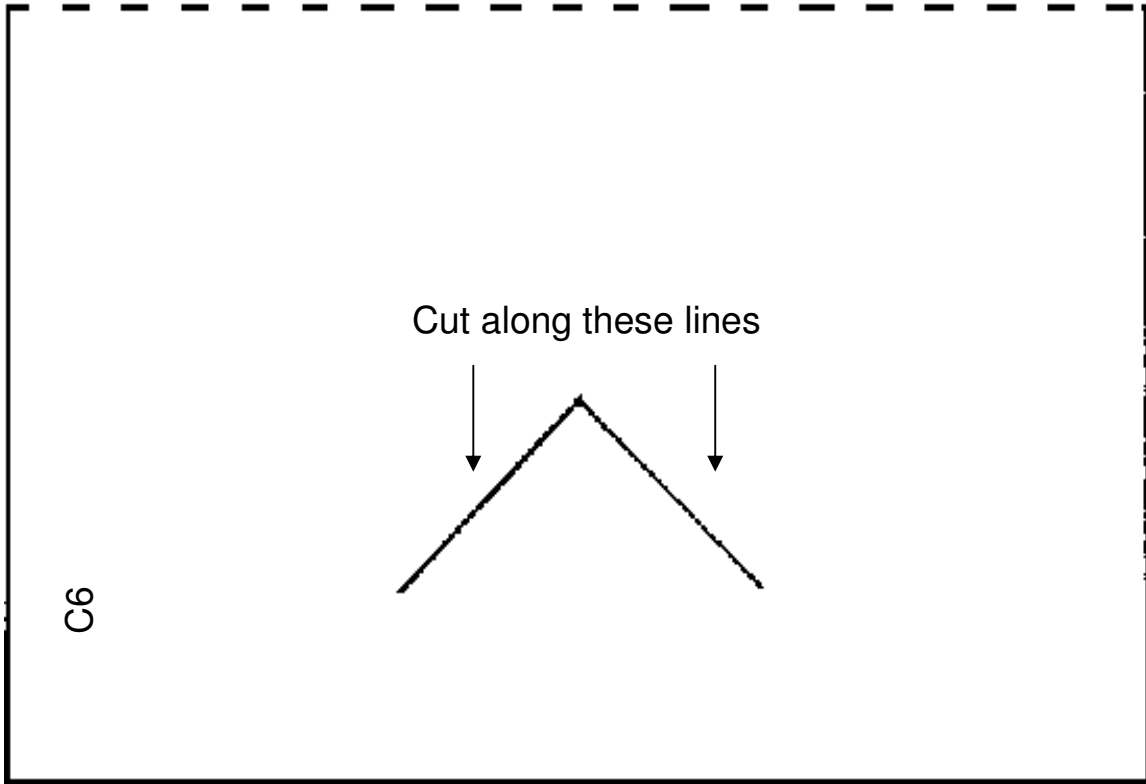

## A Gift For You Card

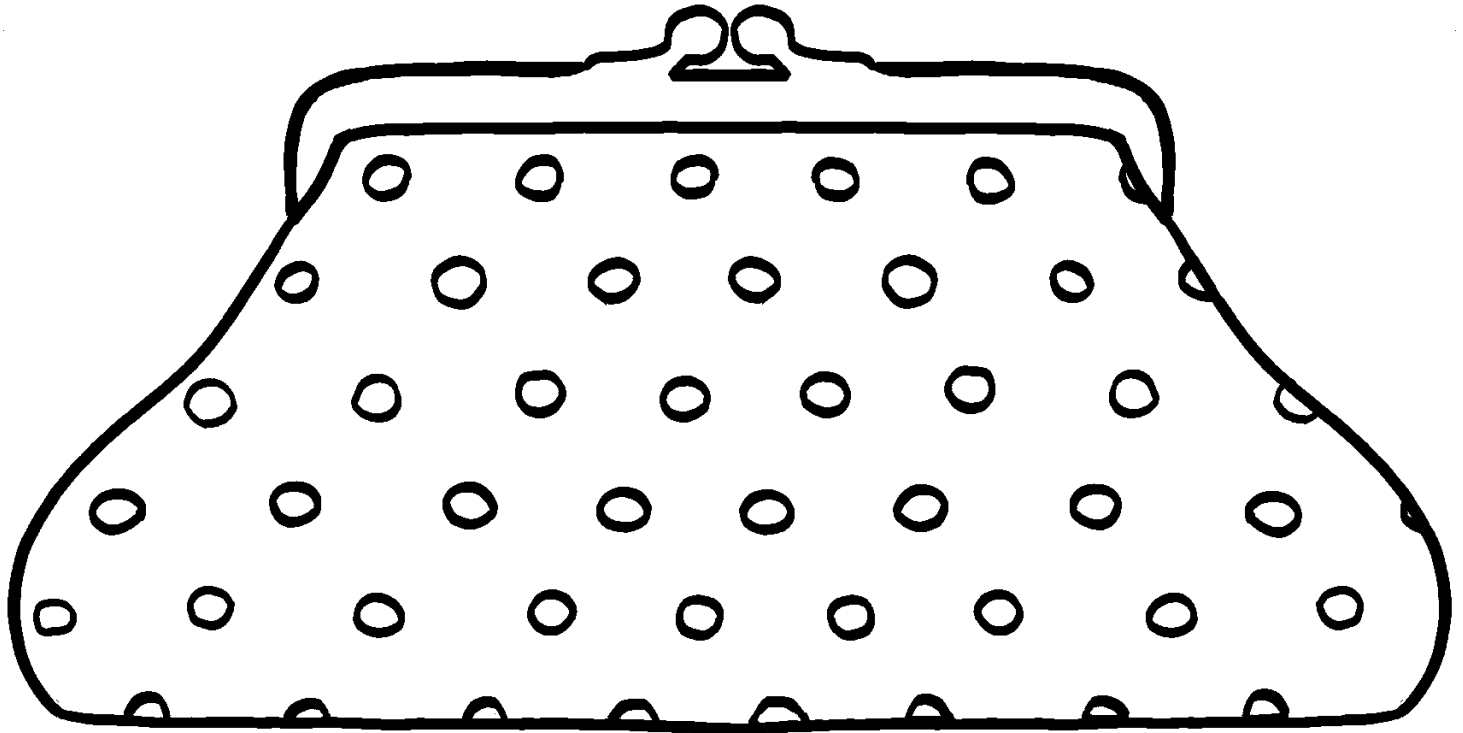
This template sheet has been designed so you can use it to create lots of different gift card designs using the basic gift box shapes along with some of the smaller shapes (heart, star and music note). There's also a small gift tag for you to write on your greeting.

To make the card simply print off the template sheet and cut out both gift box shapes and symbols you would like to use. Pick out some of your favorite patterned papers or plain card and draw around the template shapes on to them. Cut out and put to one side. Next take the template pieces again and now cut out the ribbon pieces in the middle and on the top. Draw around these on to more patterned or plain papers and stick them over the gift box shapes. Cut out the tag from plain card and write or stamp on your greeting. Add some thread and attach around the largest gift box shape. Finally arrange your shapes on to your choice of card blank and stick down.

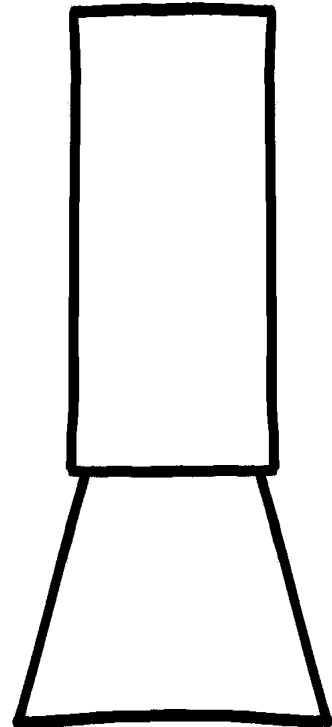
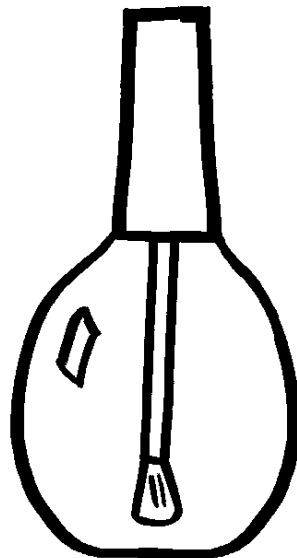

Make up bag



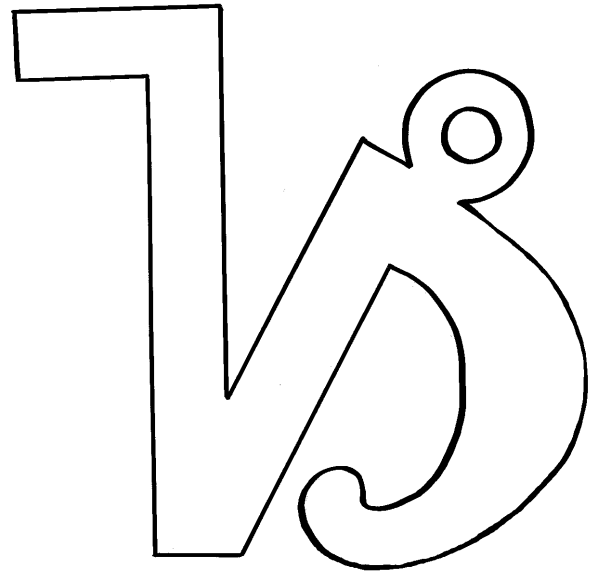
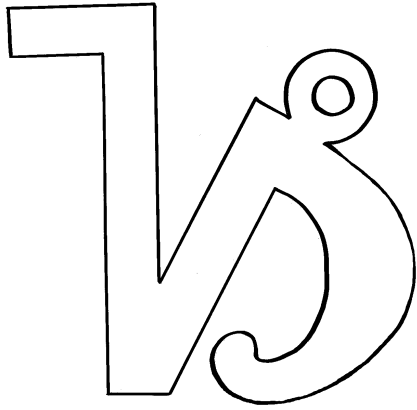
## Going out Glam Card

This card can be used for many different occasions, you can make it into a fun different new years card or a birthday card etc. To make the card bellow print the template on to a sheet of plain card and cut out each of the pieces. Cover the make up bag with patterned paper or colour in the pattern already on the bag. Take the nail polish bottle and cover the bottom half with a colour and the top half with black for the lid. Alternatively you can colour this too, (using glossy accents or gel pens can give the effect of a glass bottle). If you're creating a clear glittery nail polish bottle remember to colour in the nail brush on the inside too. For the make up brush simply cover the handle with silver glitter card or plain card and the brush end with black card. Use a DL sided card to matt your shapes onto to finish. You can use 3D sticky pads if you like to create depth.

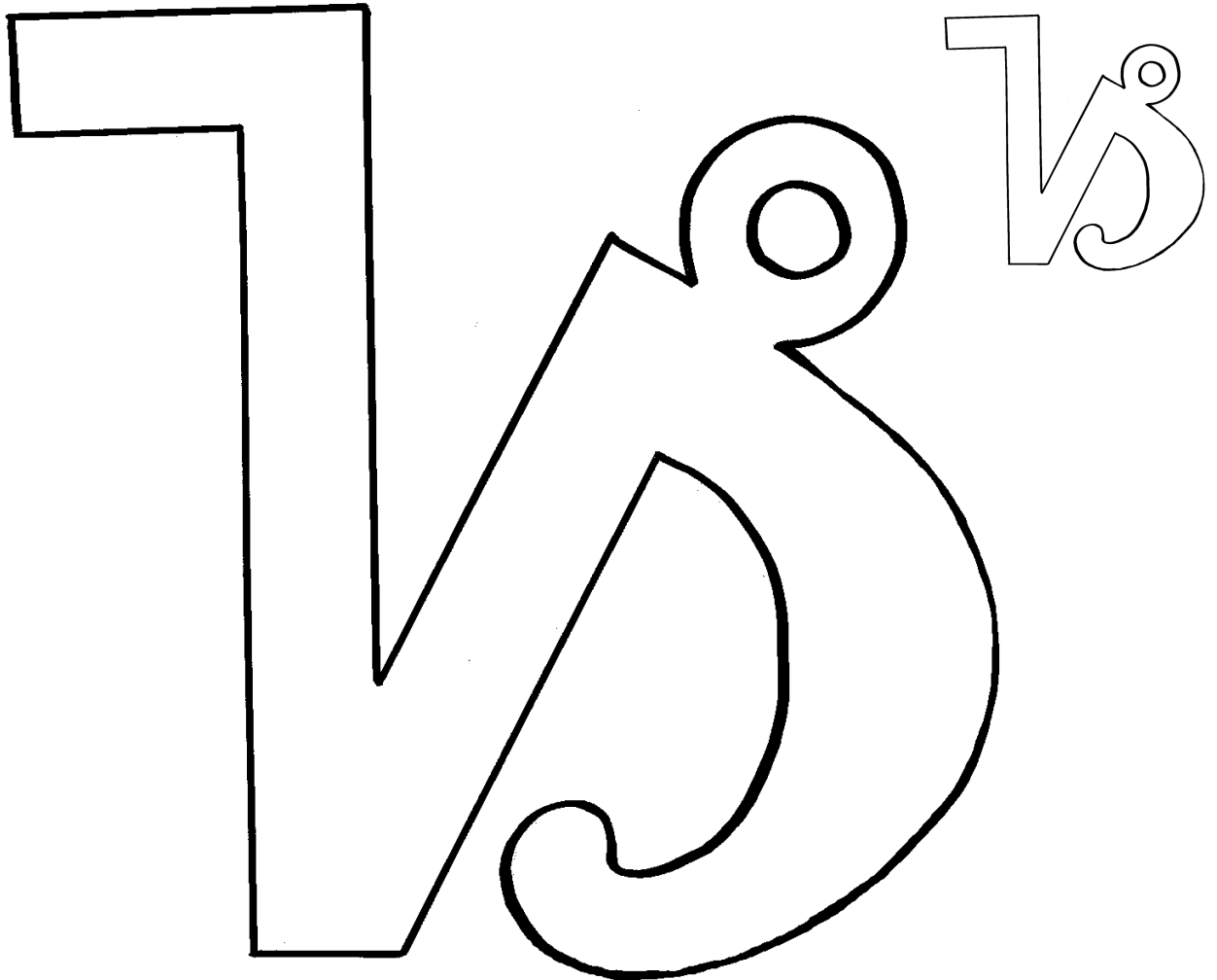

## Zodiac - Capricorn Card

On the Capricorn card template sheet there are different sizes to use so you can adapt them to your style and size of card. Choose which size you would like to use and cut out the shape. Place on your choice of card, draw around the shape and cut out. Alternatively you could print the template sheet directly on to card to cut out. Mount your shape on to your card and decorate as you wish there are some ideas bellow.

A really simple way to create a stylish card is to use silver or gold card to cut out the shape from and matt on to glitter card or black card. You could also use glitter to decorate the symbol or cut out one of the smaller shapes and make into a charm to hang from your card. Use silver embossing powder to create a metallic look or wrap thin silver jewellery wire around a shape cut from card. You could even thread some beads on to the wire of the birthstone colour.
