

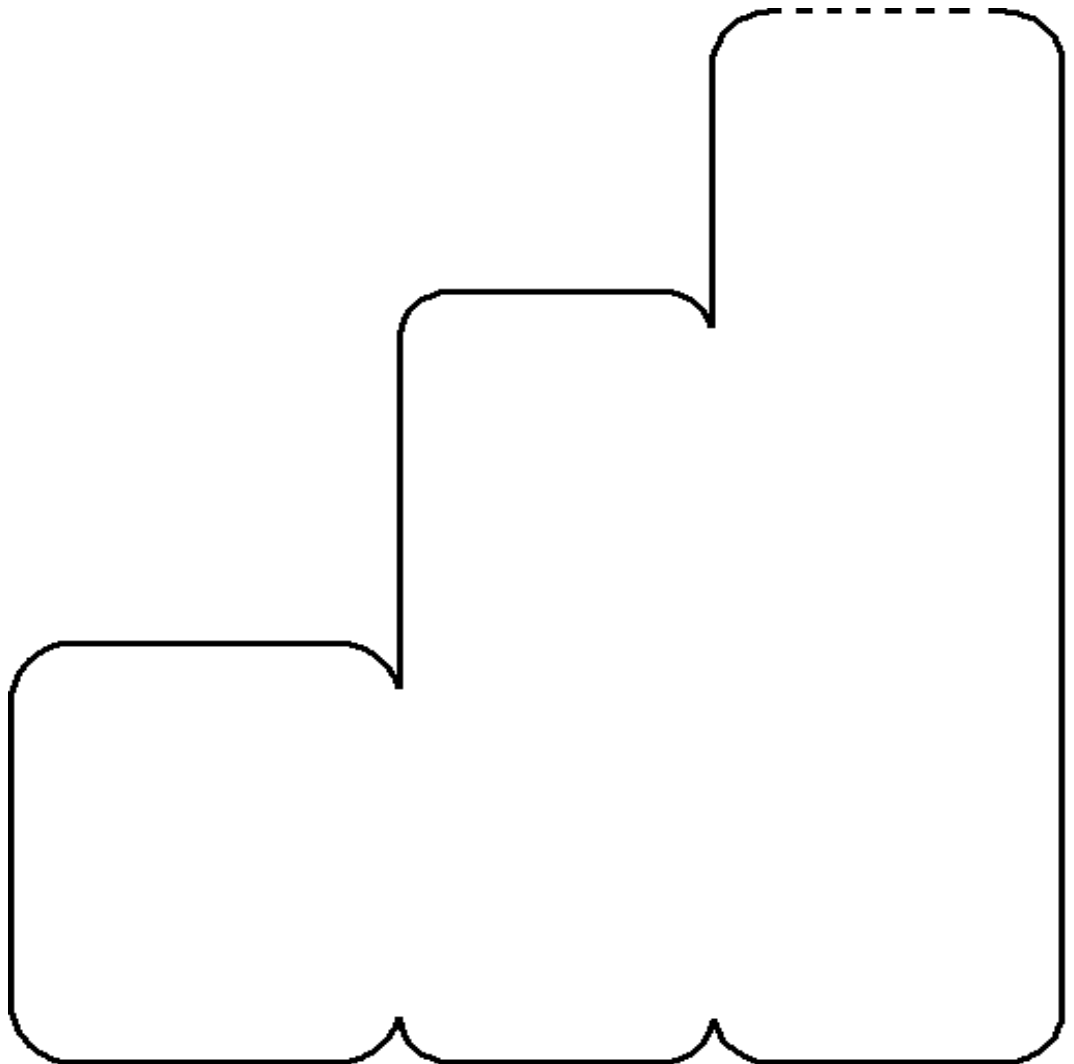
Use along with the Quirky Flower card template and the Smiley Hearts card template or add your own design.

There are two dashed line to use as the fold lines so you can choose to make either a top opening or a side opening card.

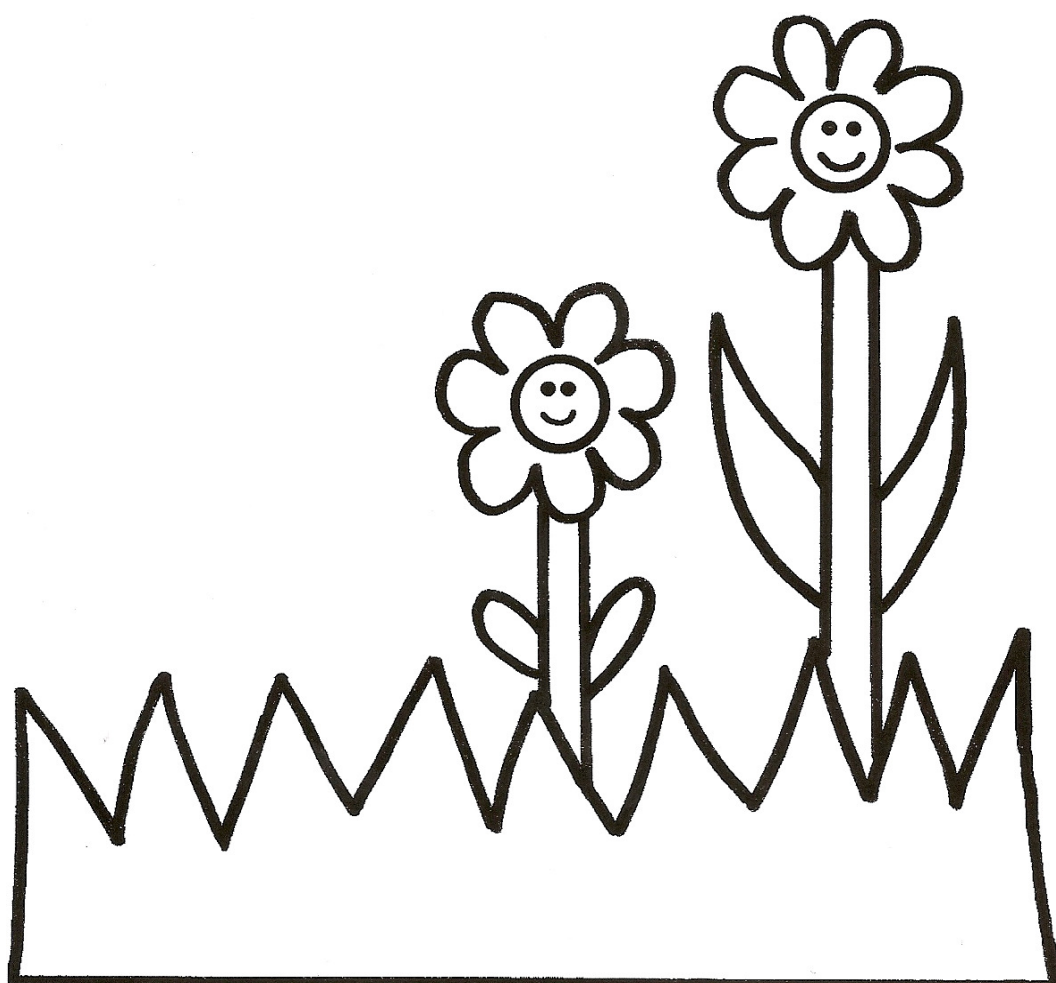
If you choose your own decoration for your card (not using the template on page 2&4) then you could in fact use any of the straight edges as your fold side and make four totally different cards from the same template.

## Quirky Flowers Card

This card template has been designed to fit the tabbed shaped card template (on page 1) so you can use it in conjunction with that or you can use it on its own to decorate the front of a card blank.

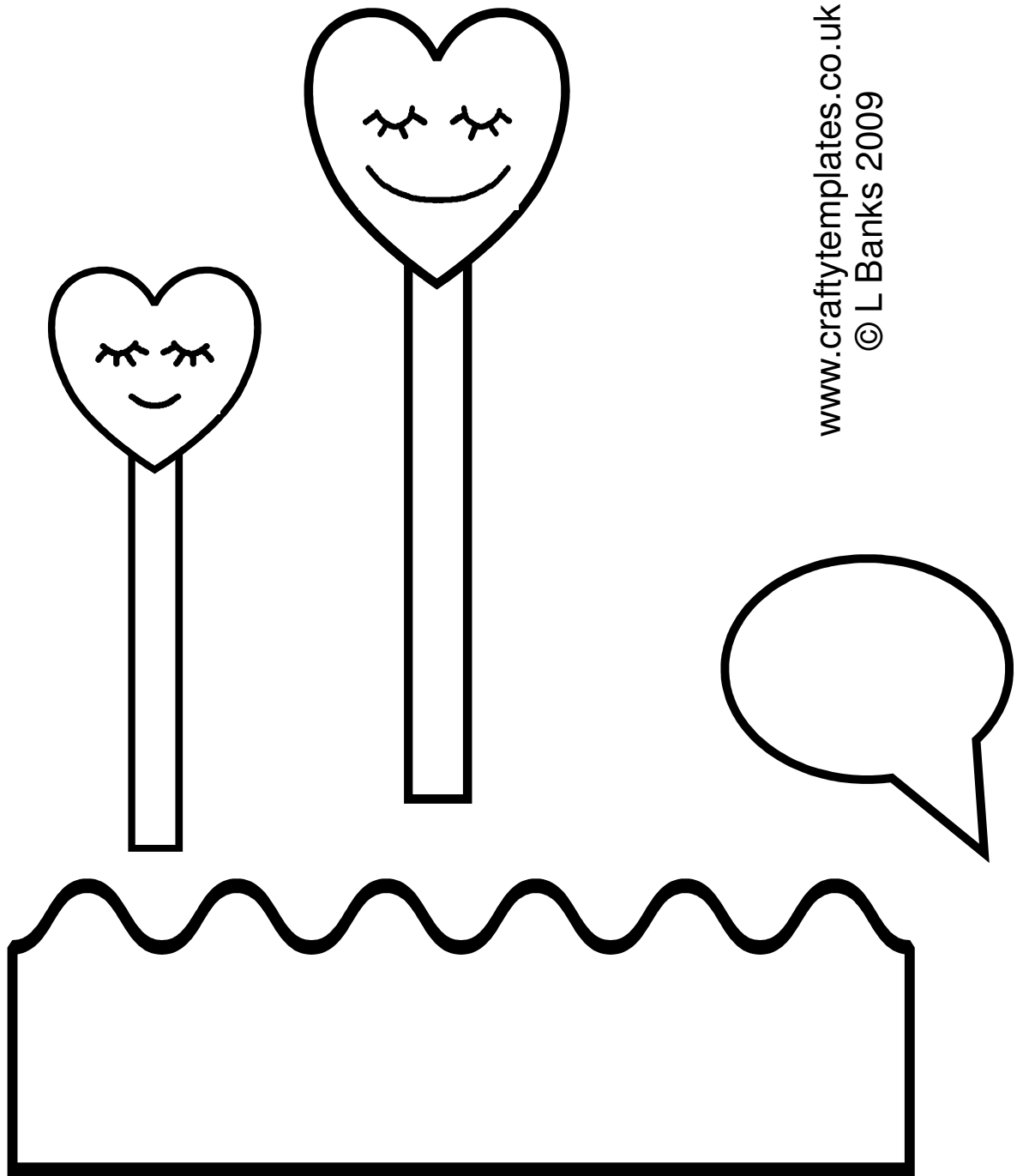
To use the tabbed shaped card template print out the template sheet on page 1 and cut out the shape. Fold a sheet of A4 (or 6"x12" card from your Crafty Goodies kit) in half and place the template on it so one of the dashed lines matches up to the fold (there are two on the template you can use either to make a side folding card or a top folding card). Draw around the shape and cut it out, keeping the card folded to create your shaped base card.

To make the embellishment for the front print the quirky flowers template sheet (page 2) and cut out the grass section then draw around that on to coloured card and doodle around the edge with black or coloured pen. Put it to one side. Next cut out the flowers and stalks from the template and draw around these on to more coloured card and again doodle around the edges and draw on the smiley faces if you want to. Decorate the front of your base card a little bit if you would like then stick on each of the flowers, the taller one fits on the tallest tab and the smaller one on the middle tab of the card. Stick the grass over the top with 3D foam pads if you have them to give it dimension. Then finish off the card by adding your message to the smallest tab section.

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**Smiley Love Card**

**DT notes**

The tabbed shaped card template ( on page 1) has been designed to work with these topper shapes, the shapes fit each of the sections and there's a piece to fit over the bottom of the card.

Can also use the shapes to create your own card idea, make them into embellishments with paper/felt etc.

## Smiley Love Card

This card template has been designed to fit the tabbed shaped card template (on page1) so you can use it in conjunction with that or you can use it on its own to decorate the front of a card blank.

To use the tabbed shaped card template print out the template sheet on page 1 and cut out the shape. Fold a sheet of A4 (or 6"x12" card from your Crafty Goodies kit) in half and place the template on it so one of the dashed lines matches up to the fold (there are two on the template you can use either to make a side folding card or a top folding card). Draw around the shape and cut it out, keeping the card folded to create your shaped base card.

To make the embellishment for the front print the Smiley Love template sheet (page 4) and cut out the wavy template piece then draw around that on to coloured or patterned card and doodle around the edge with black pen. Put it to one side. Next cut out the hearts on sticks from the template and draw around these on to more coloured card (you can use separate colours for the sticks and hearts) and again doodle around the edges and draw on the smiley faces if you want to. Decorate the front of your base card a little bit if you would like then stick on each of the hearts, the taller one fits on the tallest tab and the smaller one on the middle tab of the card. Stick the wavy bit over the top with 3D foam pads if you have them to give it dimension. Then finish off the card by adding your message (use the speech bubble template for this if you like) to the smallest tab section.

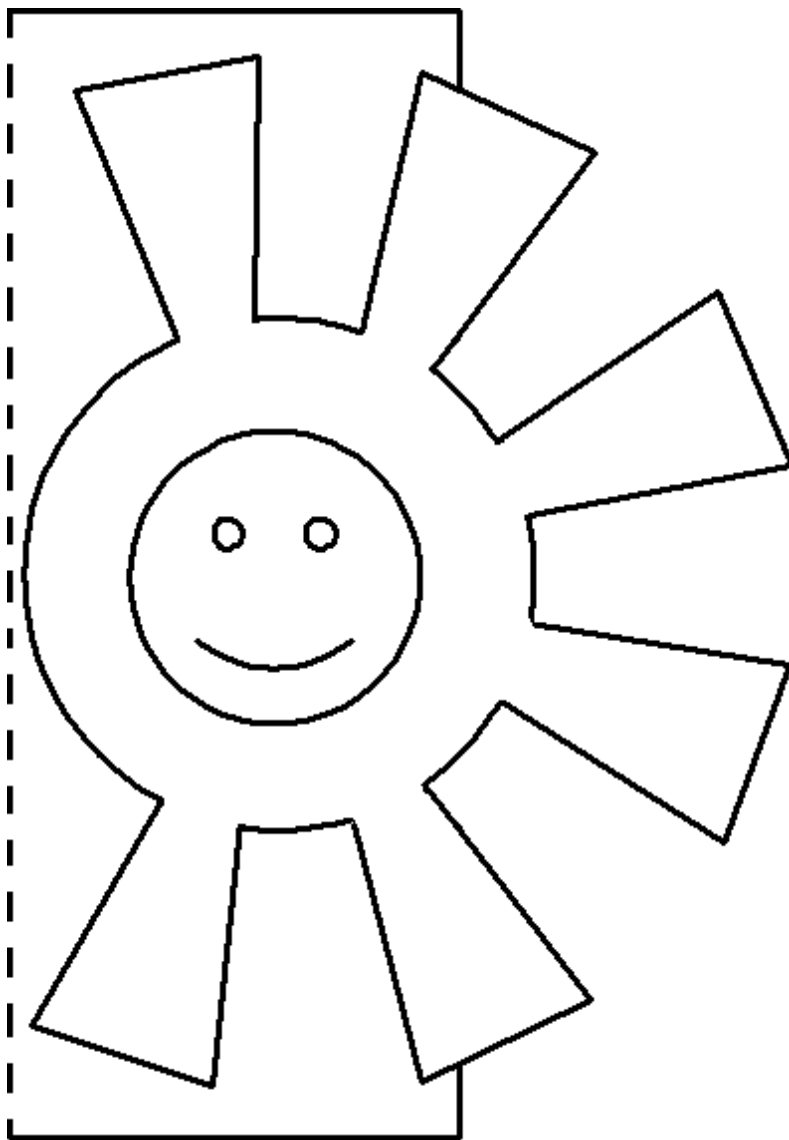

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## Smiley Sunshine Card

Fold line, match this line up with the fold on your card.



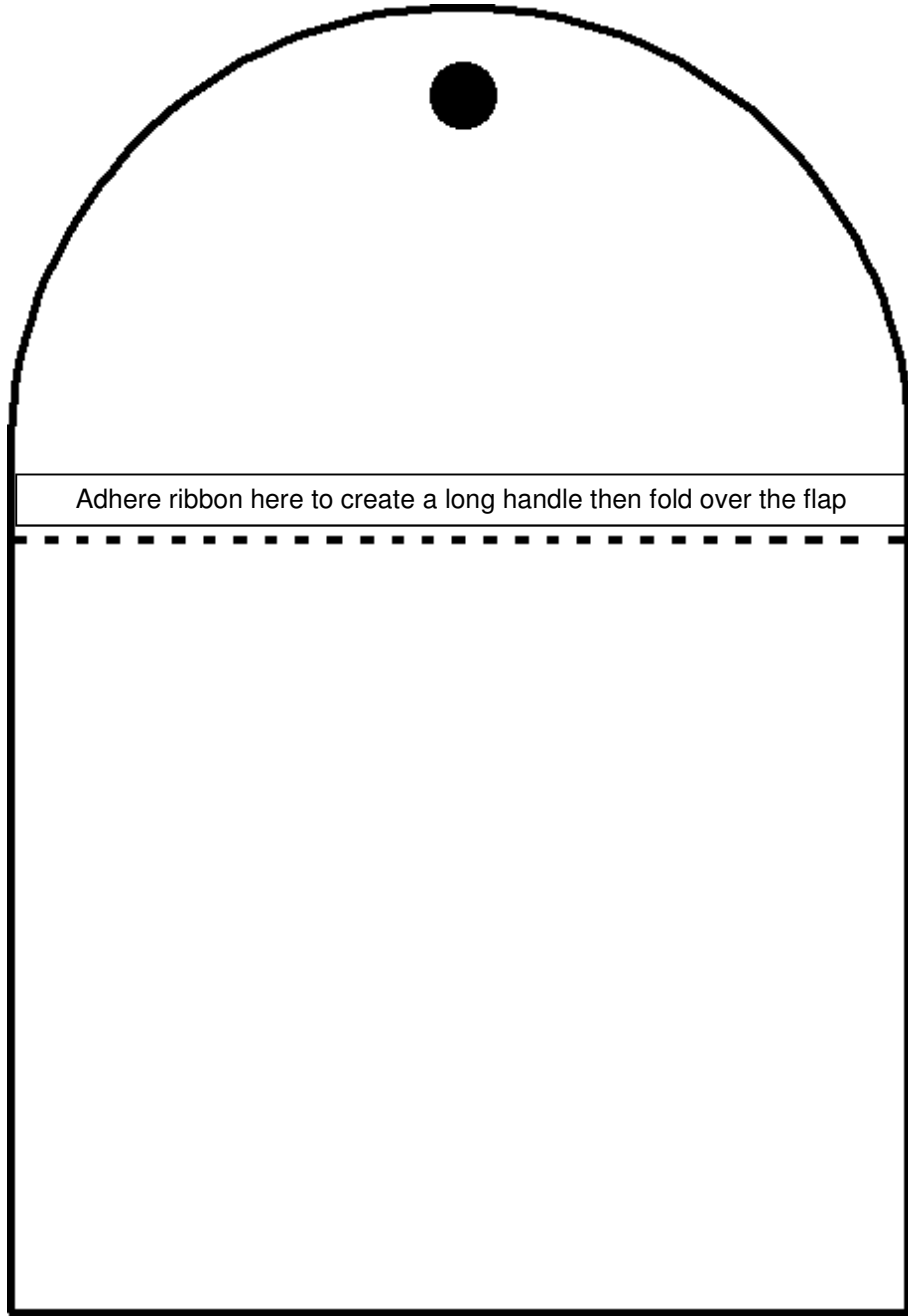
## Smiley Sunshine Card

Print out the template sheet and cut out the template, cutting around the outermost edge to start with. Take an A6 size card blank (or make one from card, A4 folded in half then cut in half again) and place the template on the front matching the dashed line on the template up to the fold on the card. Draw around the template. Unfold the card and cut the shaped edge out so you're cutting it from just the front panel of the card. Next take the template again and now cut out the sun shape from it. Draw around this on to orange or yellow coloured card (something that looks sunny!) and cut it out. Doodle around the edge and cut out the circle in the middle of the sun and draw on the smiley face (you can leave this off if you don't want a smiley sun). Stick the smiley bit in the middle of the sunshine. Cover the front of your base card with patterned paper (or decorate another way if you like) then stick the sunshine on to the front of your card so it fits on the shaped edge. Cover the inside of your card with patterned paper that co-ordinated with the front and finish off your card with a message.

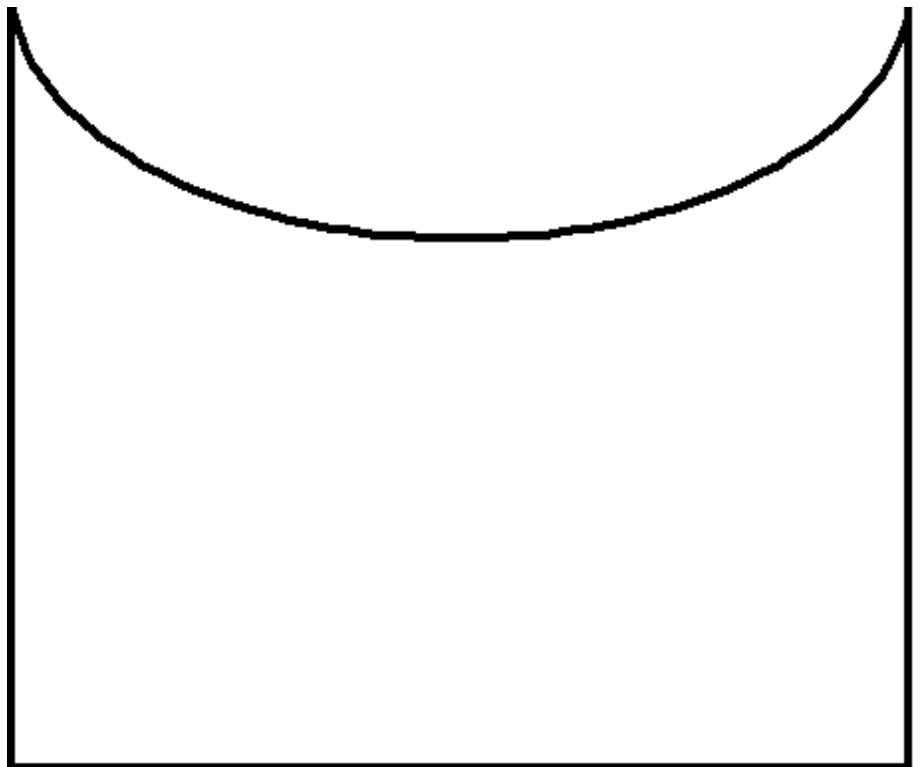


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**Cute Paper Purse**

## Cute Paper Purse

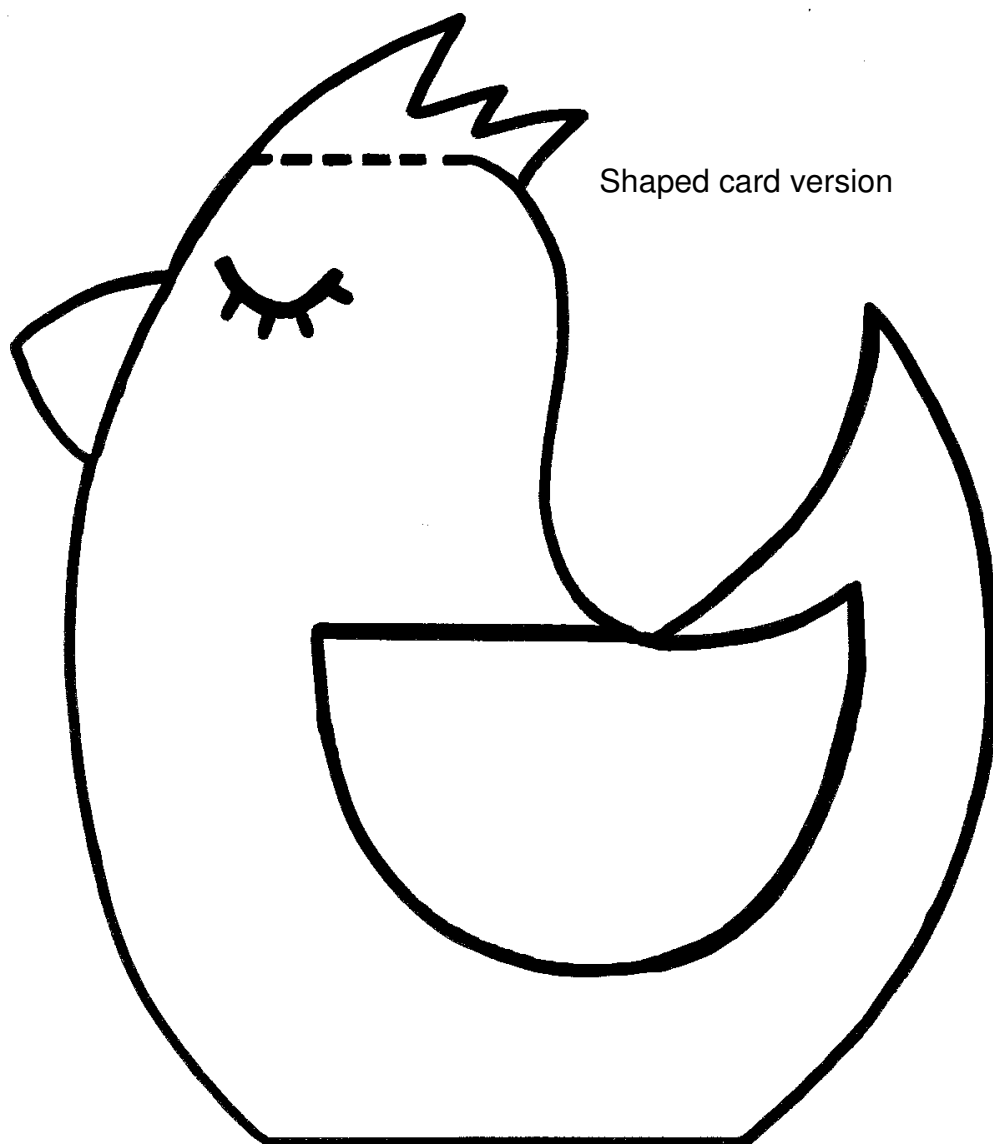
This template makes a cut little paper purse, you can pop something inside like a money gift or a mini card.

Print out the template sheet and cut out both template pieces. Place them on to a sheet of card and draw around then cut out both pieces. Score then fold along the area of the dashed line shown on the large template piece, this folds over to form the flap of the purse. It's easier to decorate the pieces before you stick the pocket on top so do this now, you can cover them with patterned paper or decorate them with stamps, whatever you would like to do. When you've finished apply a thin piece of double sided tape or glue around the bottom edge and sides of the back of the pocket piece then stick it down on to the bottom half of the purse shape. Apply more glue or tape in the area shown on the template then stick down a long length of ribbon to form a loop and make the handle. Finally fold down the purse flap and use a small removable sticky dot to keep in place and keep the secret contents hidden ready to be opened by the recipient.

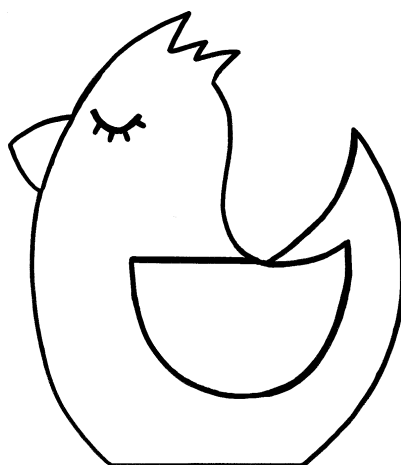


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Shaped card version

## Tweet Card

This template has two choices for making cards, you can make a shaped card or you can use the mini template to make an embellishment for a card. To make the shaped card cut out the shaped card template from the template sheet. Fold a piece of card in half and place the template on it matching the dashed line up to the fold on the card. Draw around the shape and then cut it out keeping the card folded so make your shaped base card. Take the template again and choose a card or patterned paper you would like your birdie to be then draw around the template on to it and cut it out. Place this over the top of your base card, matching up the bottom edge to make sure it fits and stick it down. From here you can decorate your birdie how you like (see this months inspiration for some fab examples by the design team)

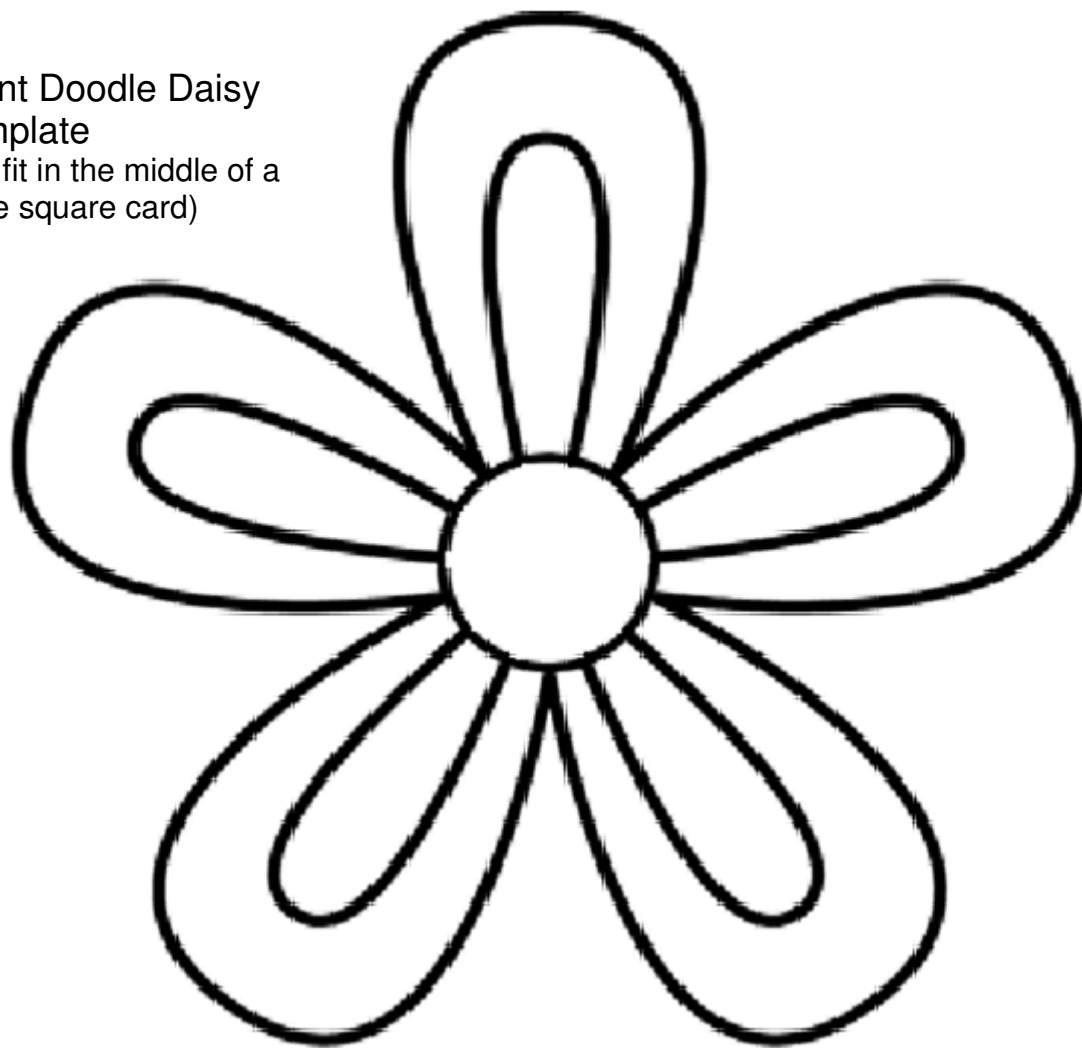
To make an embellishment for a card simply cut out the mini topper template from the template sheet and draw around it on to plain or patterned paper. Cut out the shape. Take the mini template again and cut out the wing and the beak. Draw around each on to other coloured card and cut them out. Stick them down on your birdie shape. Matt the embellishment on a piece of card and then apply it to your base card.

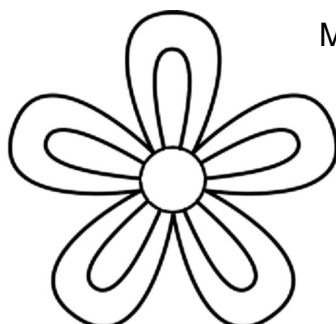
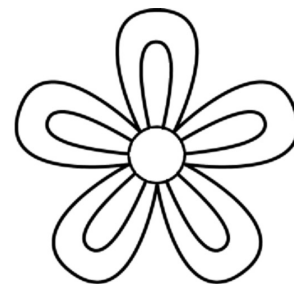
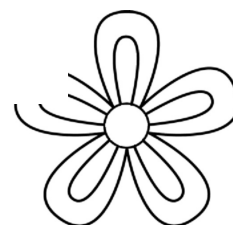
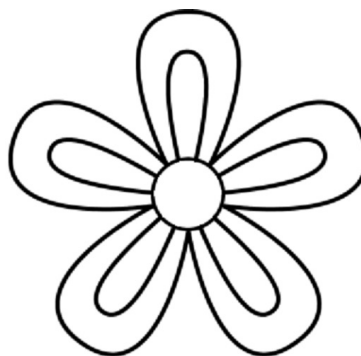
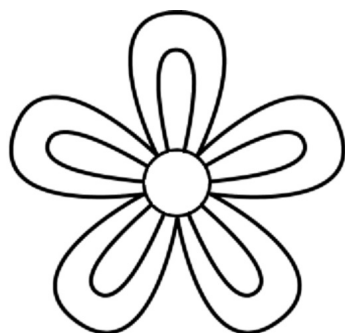


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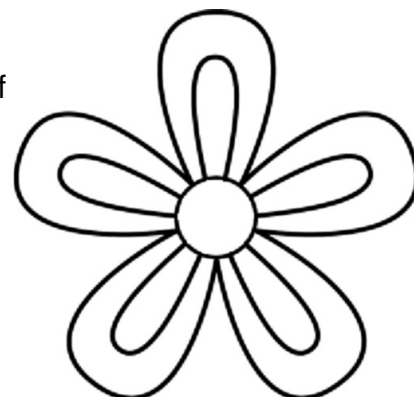
Giant Doodle Daisy

## Doodle Daisies

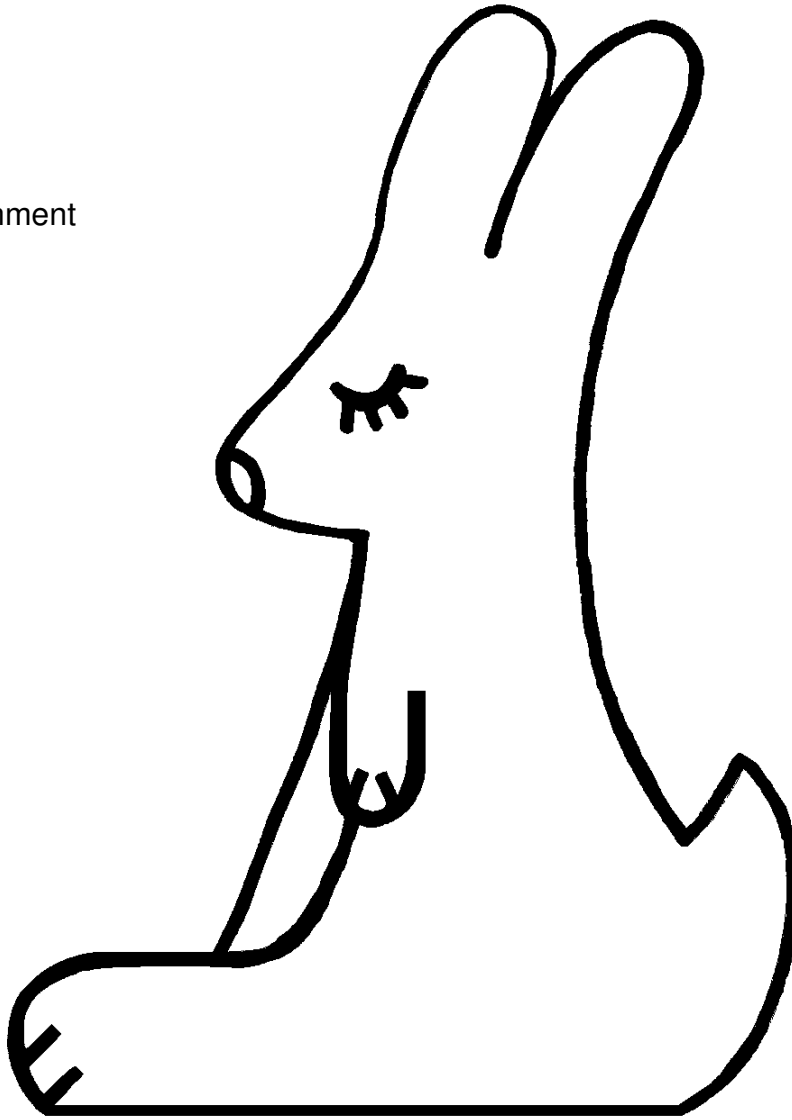
These cute daisies can be used to embellish lots of items or to use on your cards however you'd like to. The easiest way to use them is to print the template sheet straight on to the back of some patterned paper or card and then cut them out directly. The flowers have three different ways to cut them out, you can cut out just around the outside edge, you can cut out around the inside lines or you can cut out the inside bits and then cut out around the outside. Mix up how you cut out each shape to create different flowers on one card or layer up the cut outs to give different effects (the flowers in the sample card below are cut out and layered up). As well as small flowers to decorate your card there is also a large flower that will cover the whole of a large square card. You could make layers and build up a large flower or you can leave it as one single layer.

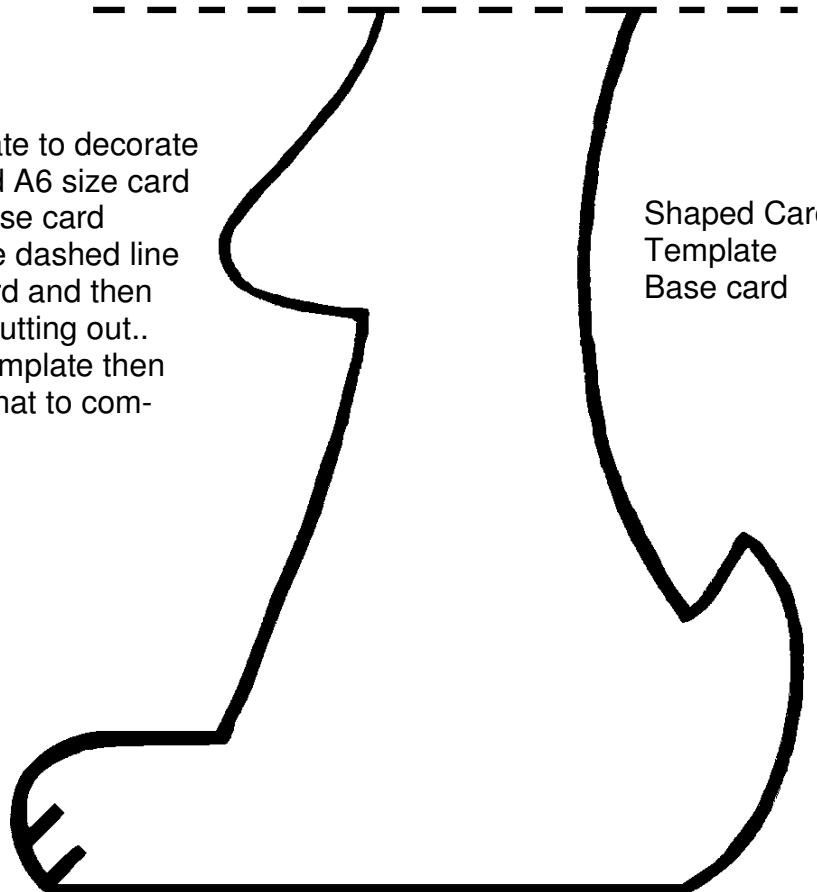


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You can use the main

**Hoppy Birthday Card**

## Hoppy Birthday Card

There are two choices with this card template, you can make an embellishment to apply to the front of a card or you can make a shaped card. To make the shaped card cut out the base card template from the template sheet. Fold a piece of card in half and place the template on it matching the dashed line up to the fold on the card.

Draw around the shape and then cut it out keeping the card folded so make your shaped base card. Now cut out the embellishment template from the template sheet and choose a coloured or patterned paper for your bunny then draw around the template on to it. Cut out the shape and stick it on to your base card matching the bottom edges up so it fits neatly. Define the edges of bunny by doodling around the edge with a black pen or coloured pen (or both as I've done in the sample bellow).

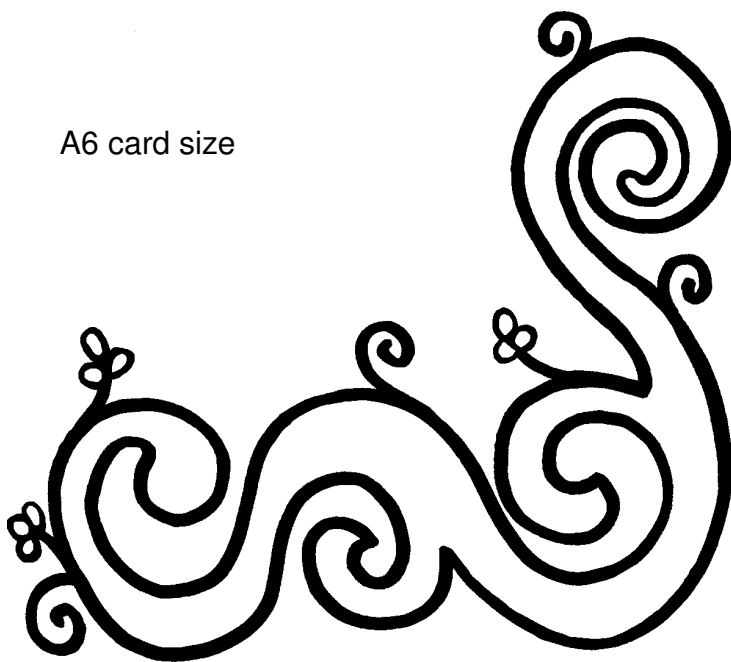
To make an embellishment just cut out the embellishment template as above but stick it to a blank A6 size card and add your choice of message to finish.

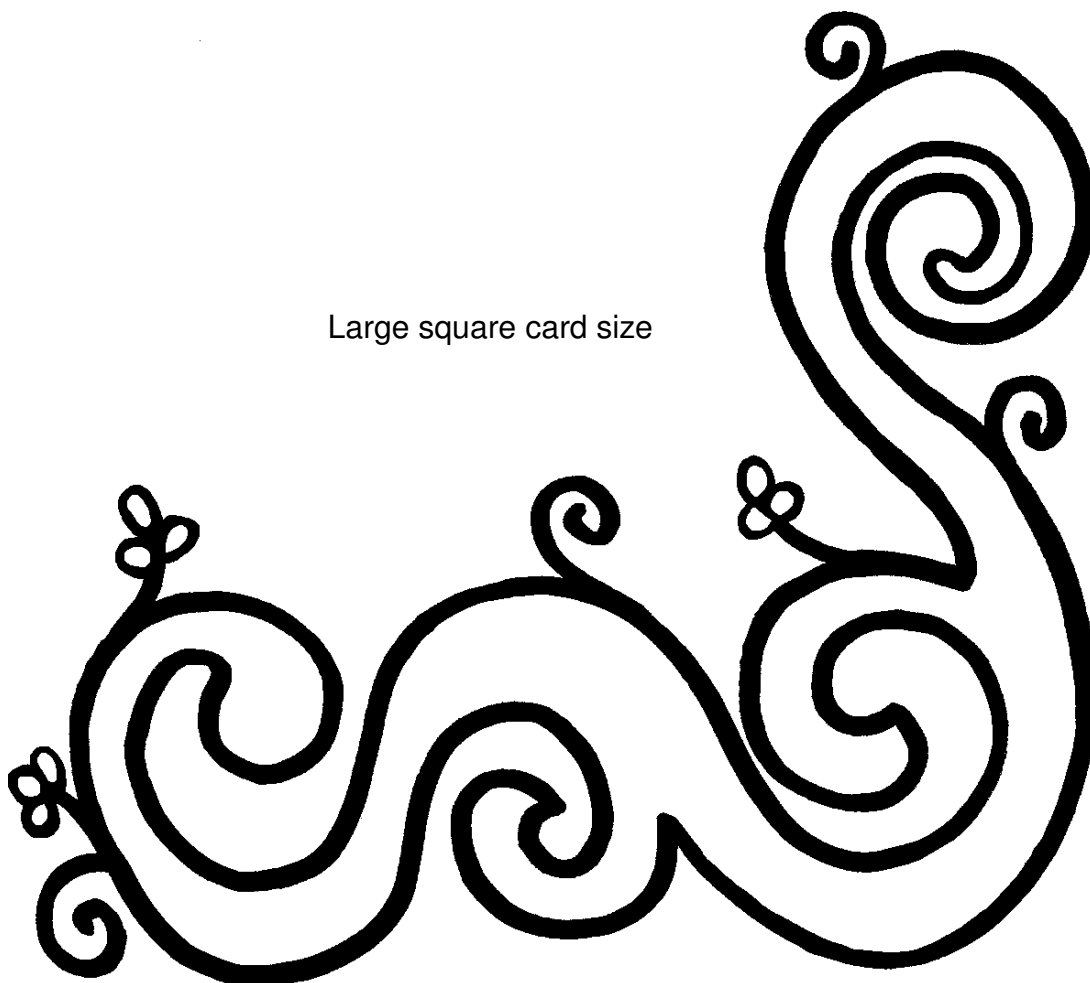
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A6 card size

**Corner Swirl**

## Corner Swirl Card

Print out the template sheet then decide which size you would like to use. Cut out the swirl and then place it on some patterned paper or coloured card and draw around it then cut it out. At this stage you can be creative about how you use it, use it along with a stamped image you may have or match it to some patterned paper and cover your base card with it then apply the swirl over the top.

There are options to give the edge of the swirl definition too you could sand the edges back, doodle on the edges (that's what I did on the sample card bellow) or you could ink or paint the edges.

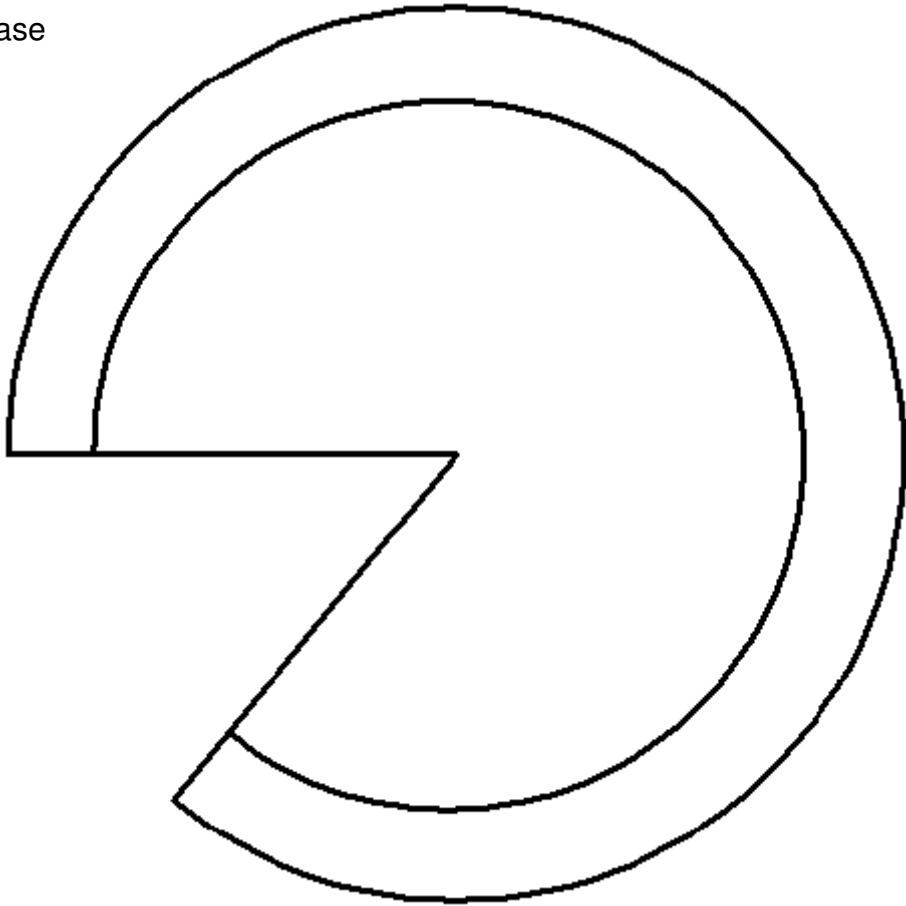
Both sizes of swirl fit in the corner of a card blank so you could put it at the top or at the bottom it's up to you. Finish off your card with a message or other items maybe cut out shapes from paper or stamped images or blossoms applied on to or around the swirl.

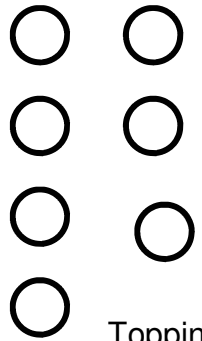
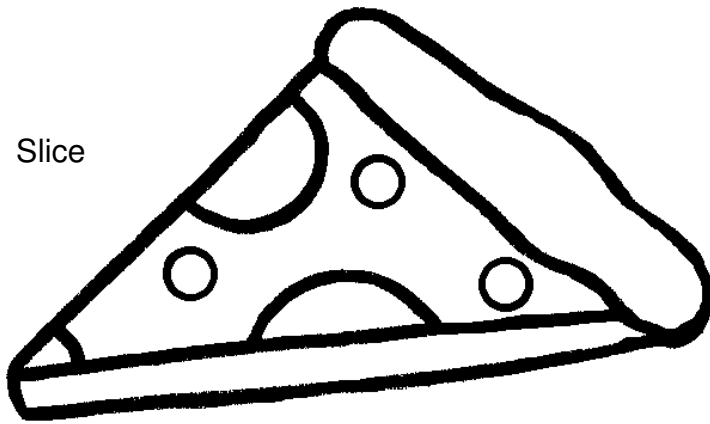

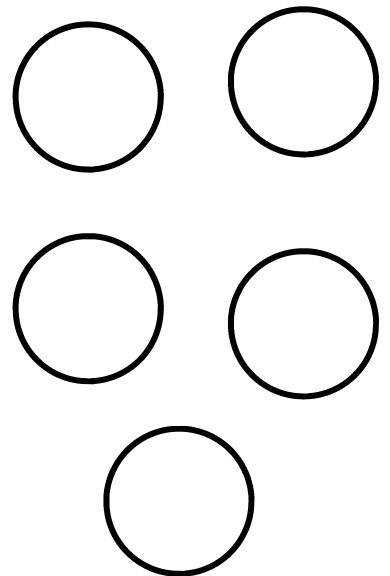

**Pizza Card**

## Pizza Card

Print out the template sheet and cut out the pizza base shape, draw around it on to a piece of yellow card and cut it out. You can cut out the 'crust' on the pizza base shape and draw around that separately to attach over the top of the pizza shape to give it a 3D look at this stage or you can leave it flat and just decorate it to look like a pizza crust. Next roughly cut around the pizza toppings, keep them together as a rectangle and add a little temporary glue like Pritt stick on the back then stick on to some scraps of coloured orange (for the big pepperoni pieces) and black (for the olives) you can change these colours if you like. Cut out the circle shapes while they're stuck on the card and then when you're done peel off the paper template so you're left with the shapes. If the edges aren't very round use a nail file or sanding block to smooth the edges. Apply the 'toppings' to your pizza. Next cut out the pizza slice from the template sheet and do exactly the same, cutting out the whole shape first from yellow card, then cut out the crust to draw around again and the pieces of topping. Stick down all the pieces to recreate the pizza and draw around the edge with black pen to give it definition.

To assemble your card, stick down the pizza slice over the gap in the pizza base and matt it on to a piece of coloured card, then matt it on to your base card, square cards work particularly well although you could also use an A5 size card.
