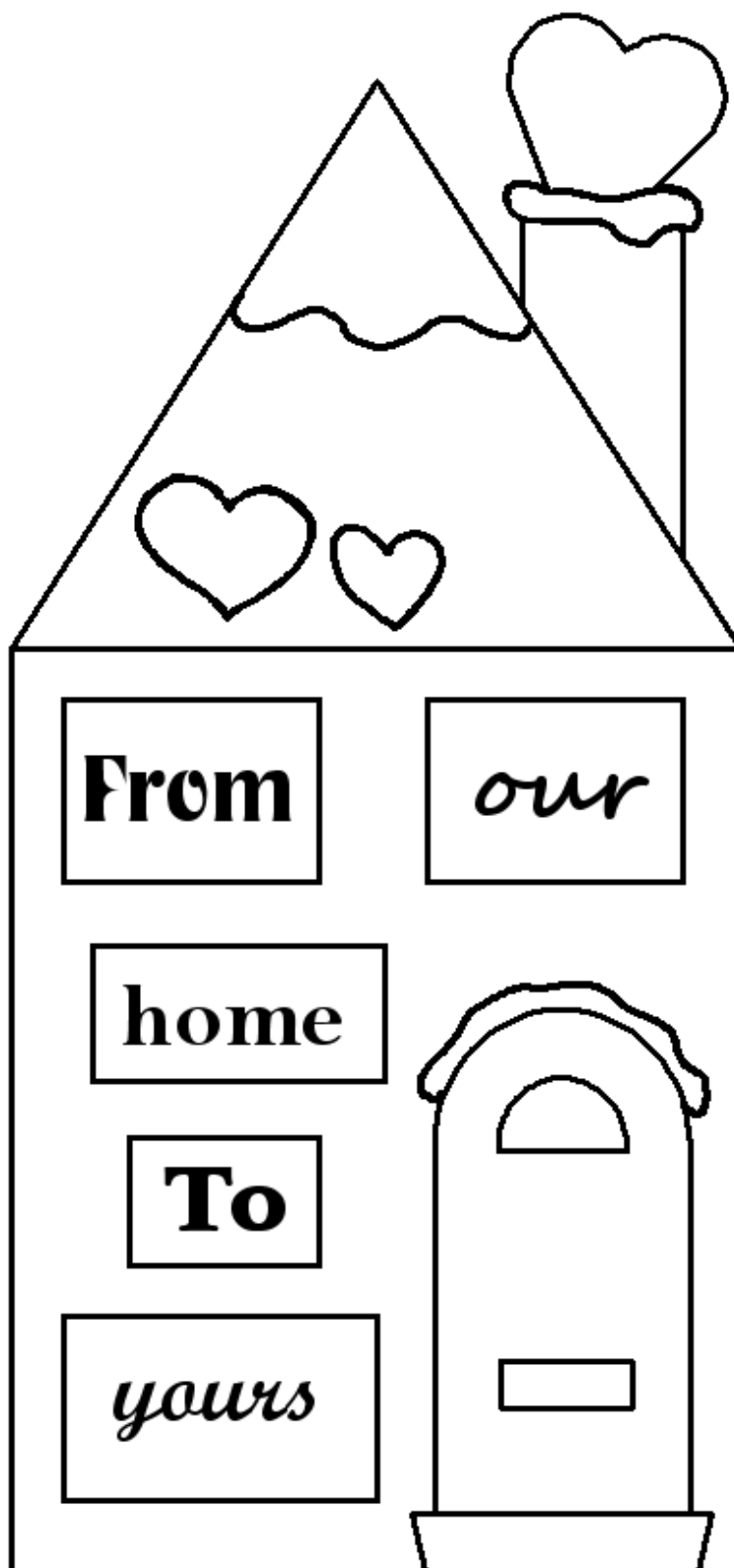


**Tall Snowy House**

Match this side of the template up to the fold on your card



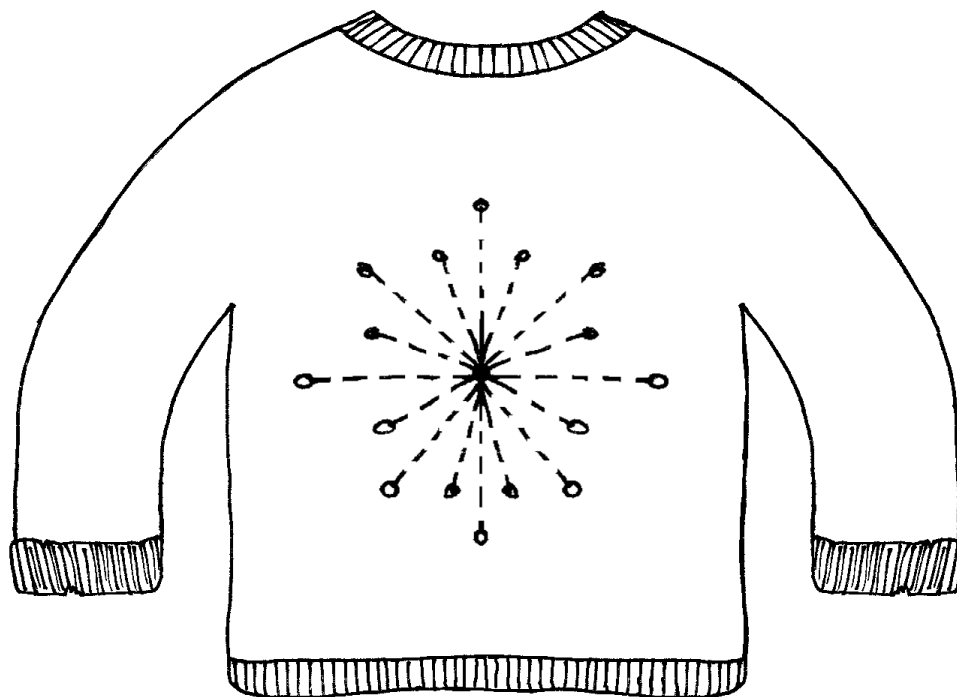
## Tall Snowy House Card

Print off the template. Fold a piece of A4 card in half or use a ready made DL size card (the large tall ones). Cut out the house shape from the template sheet and place it on your card so the left edge matches up to the fold, draw around the shape. Take the template away and keeping the card folded cut out the shape. You've now made your shaped base card. Next to decorate it pick out some papers and/or coloured card you want to use. Take the template piece and cut off the roof then cut off the chimney. Draw around the roof shape on to one of the patterned papers and cut it out. Draw around the remaining house shaped template on to a patterned paper then cut this out and stick it to the front of your card. Draw around the chimney template in the same paper and cut this out then stick it to your card front, cut out the heart shape in pink or red card and stick that over the top. Finish off by sticking on the roof and make the two other heart shapes to decorate it and if you like you can cut out the snowy bit from the roof template and draw around that on to white card then stick it on your roof - try adding a bit of glitter to make it look more like snow. Next you need to make the door. Cut it out from the template and place it on a piece of card, draw around it and cut it out. Decorate it with patterned paper then stick it to front of your card. To finish off your card add the message to the front. You can use the message on the template (printing it out on to card) or you can use leftover alphabet stickers or stamps. You can also trace around the edges of your card with black or other coloured pen.

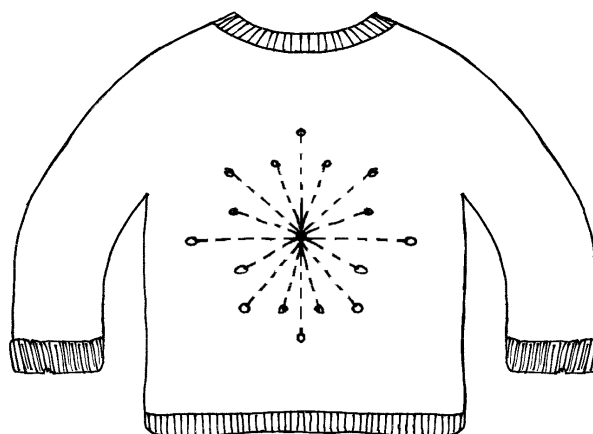

**Christmas Jumper**

## Christmas Jumper Card

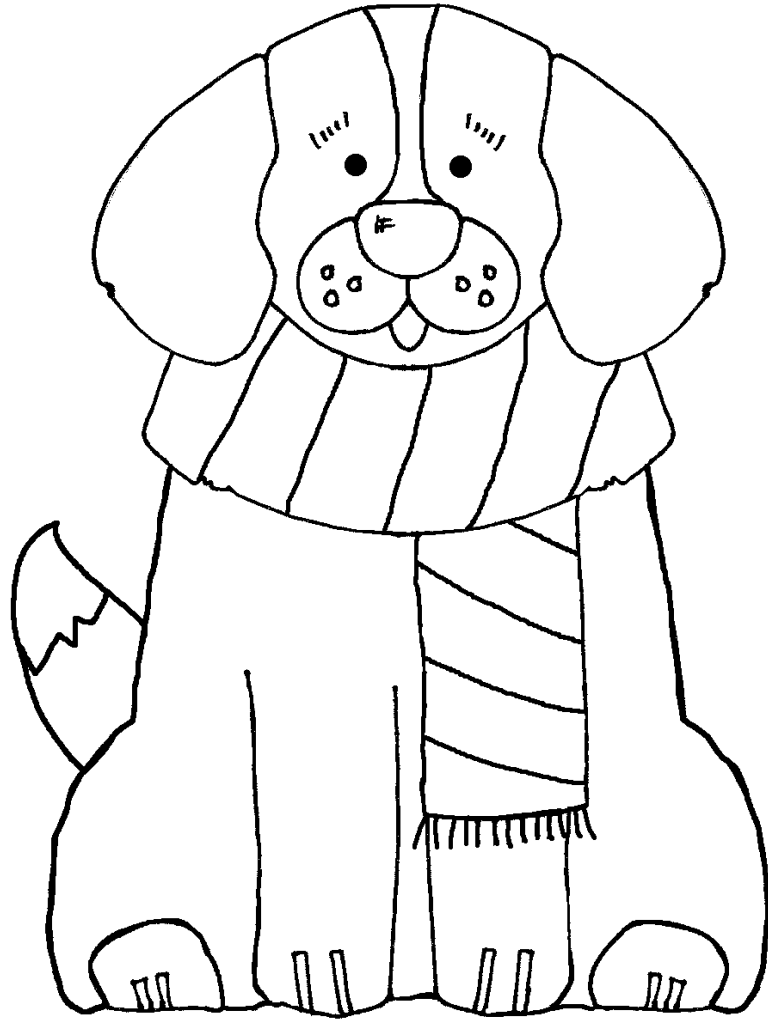
Print off the template sheet. Decide which size jumper you would like to use and cut it out from the template sheet. Take a piece of patterned paper and draw around the jumper template on to it then cut it out. Create a card blank or use a ready made one and decorate the front of your card with a piece of patterned paper. Decorate your jumper with a pattern on the front. You can use a shape cut out from patterned paper, a stamped image or use the snowflake image from the template sheet - it's been designed to stitch on so if you have embroidery thread or fibres you can stitch it on following the pattern. It's supposed to be a fun Christmas jumper so bolder the decoration on the front the better! You can also add on the jumper details copying them from the template with a black pen. When you've finished your jumper stick it to the front of your card and add a message to finish.

**Winter Doggy**

## Winter Doggy Card

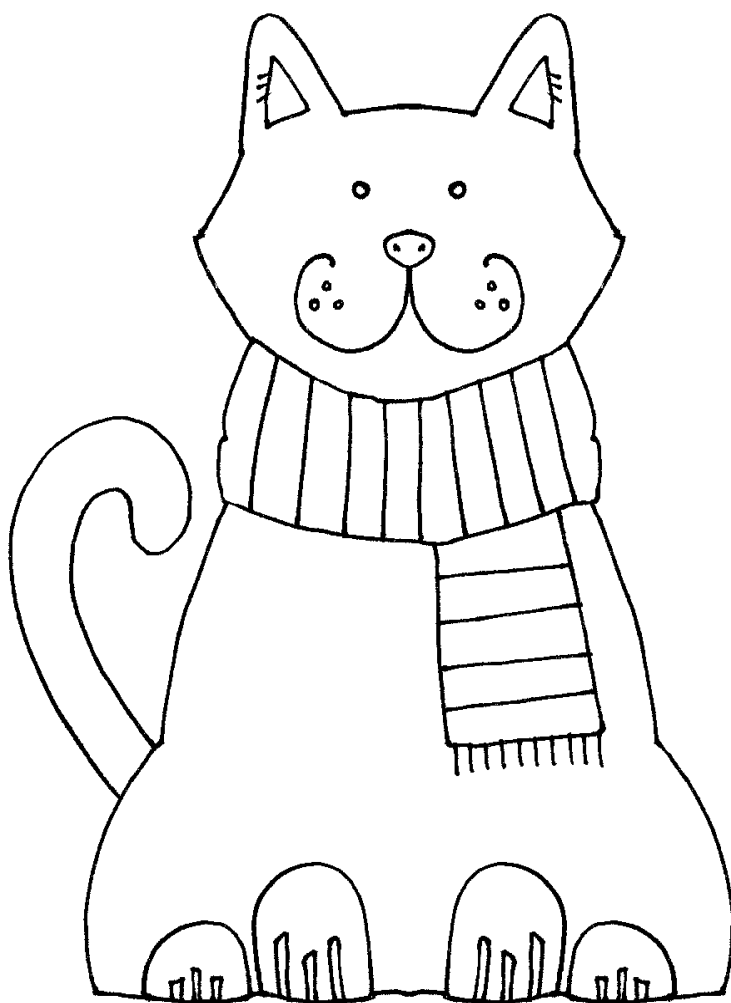
This template sheet has been designed so you can print it out directly on a piece of card and then cut it out and decorate it or you can print it out on paper and use it as a template drawing on the detail. Decide which size you would like to use and which method and cut out your basic doggy shape from card. Add the detail to him, you can colour in parts like his face, tail and nose. To make the scarf embellishment in patterned papers first cut out the scarf shape from the template. Pick out two different patterned papers. Draw around the scarf shape on to one of the patterned papers and cut it out. Stick it over the top of the scarf on your doggy. Next using the scarf template piece cut the bottom half of the scarf shape off and draw around both pieces onto the second patterned paper. Cut out both pieces then take each in turn and place the template pieces over the top of your shape and use it as a guide to make the stripes. Discard every other stripe as you go - it's best to stick them down as you go so you cut out one stripe, stick it on, cut out then discard the next stripe, cut out then stick down the next stripe then discard the next and so on. Do this till all your scarf is stripy. Add in extra detail with black pen. When you're happy with your doggy embellishment stick it to your card blank. The card blank in the example below has been decorated with alphabet stickers that are spelling out various festive words. A bow has then been added and the doggy embellishment on top.

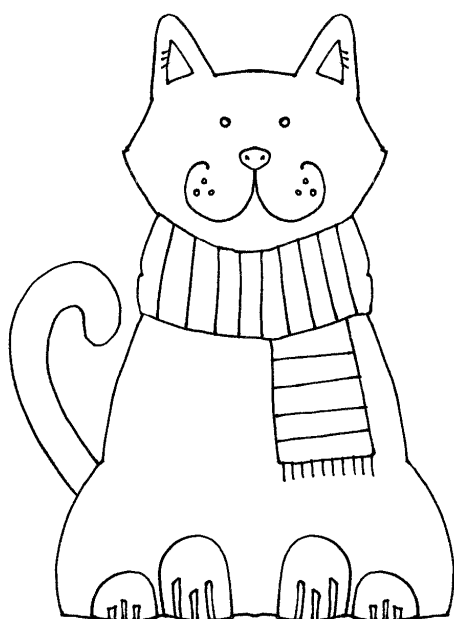

**Winter Cat**

## Winter Cat Card

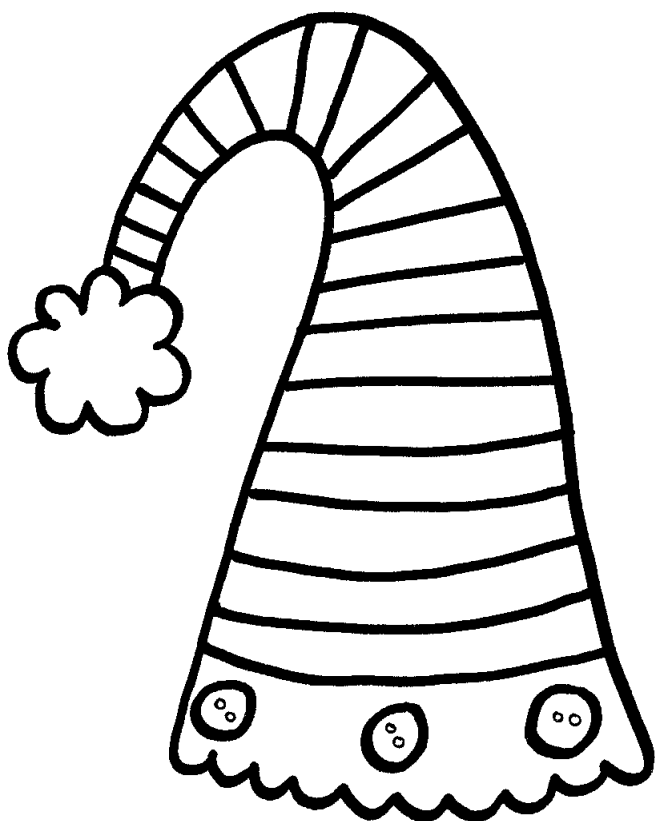
This template sheet has been designed so you can print it out directly on a piece of card and then cut it out and decorate it or you can print it out on paper and use it as a template drawing on the detail. Decide which size you would like to use and which method and cut out your basic cat shape from card. Add the detail to him, you can colour in parts like his paws and nose. To make the scarf embellishment in patterned papers first cut out the scarf shape from the template. Pick out two different patterned papers. Draw around the scarf shape on to one of the patterned papers and cut it out. Stick it over the top of the scarf on your doggy. Next using the scarf template piece cut the bottom half of the scarf shape off and draw around both pieces onto the second patterned paper. Cut out both pieces then take each in turn and place the template pieces over the top of your shape and use it as a guide to cut out the stripes. Discard every other stripe as you go - it's best to stick them down as you go, so you cut out one stripe, stick it on, cut out then discard the next stripe, cut out then stick down the next stripe then discard the next and so on. Do this till all your scarf is stripy. Add in extra detail with black pen. Decorate the front of a card blank with patterned paper. When you're happy with your cat embellishment stick it to your card front.

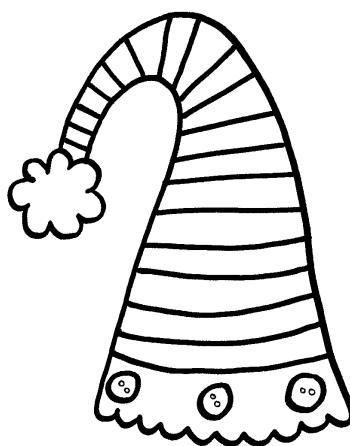

**Quirky Winter Hat**

## Quirky Winter Hat Card

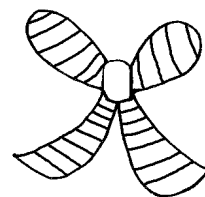
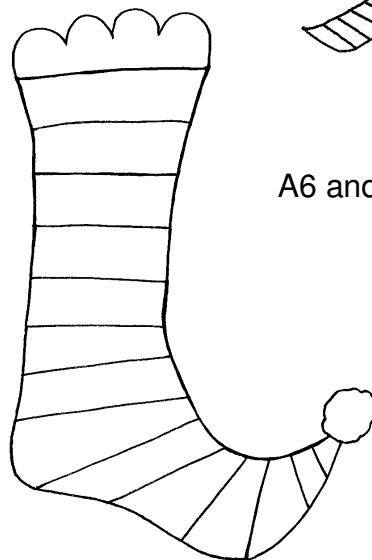
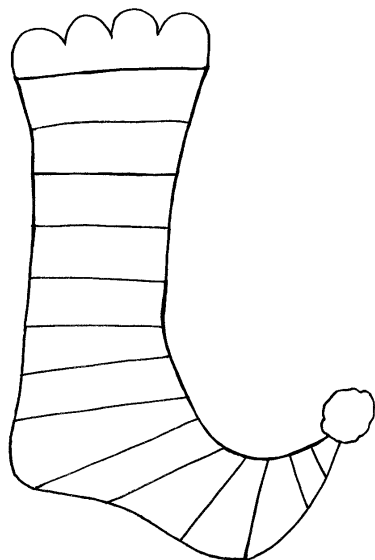
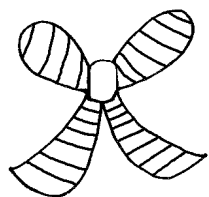
Print off the template sheet. Decide which size embellishment you would like to make (this depends on the size of card you want to make). When you've decided cut out the corresponding template from the sheet. Place it on a piece of plain card, draw around and cut it out. Next cut off the bobble and the bottom of the hat on your template piece and draw around each shape on to coloured card then cut them out.

Take the remaining hat template piece and draw around that onto two different colours of card. Cut each of these pieces in to the stripes of the hat using the template as a guide then glue onto the whole hat shape in an alternating pattern. Glue on the bobble and the bottom edge of the hat to finish your embellishment. If you want you can add further interest by adding some glitter and some buttons. Alternatively try using felt or fabric to make different kinds of Quirky Winter Hat embellishments.

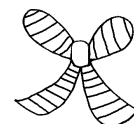
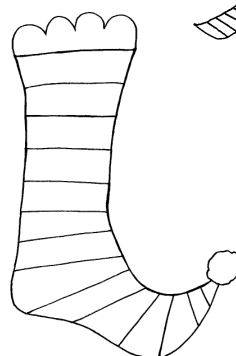
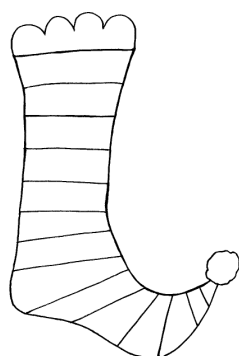
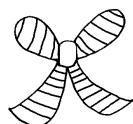

**Quirky Christmas Stockings**

## Quirky Christmas Stockings Card

This template has been created to enable you to print it out and use it directly. This makes it much easier to make small embellishments. To print directly on to patterned paper first print out the template sheet on plain printer paper. Choose which size you would like to work with - pick the size that best fits your card blank. Take squares of patterned paper that fit over the stocking templates and stick the card over them using masking tape on the edges or a temporary adhesive on the back. Put the sheet back inside your printer and print on the same sheet again so it prints on the pieces of patterned paper. Leave them to dry for a minute or two to make sure they don't smudge then cut the stocking shapes out. You can add in the stripes with coloured marker pens or glitter glue.

Decorate your card blank as you want it and make a garland with ribbon to hang each stocking onto. Stick your hanging embellishment down on your card to finish.

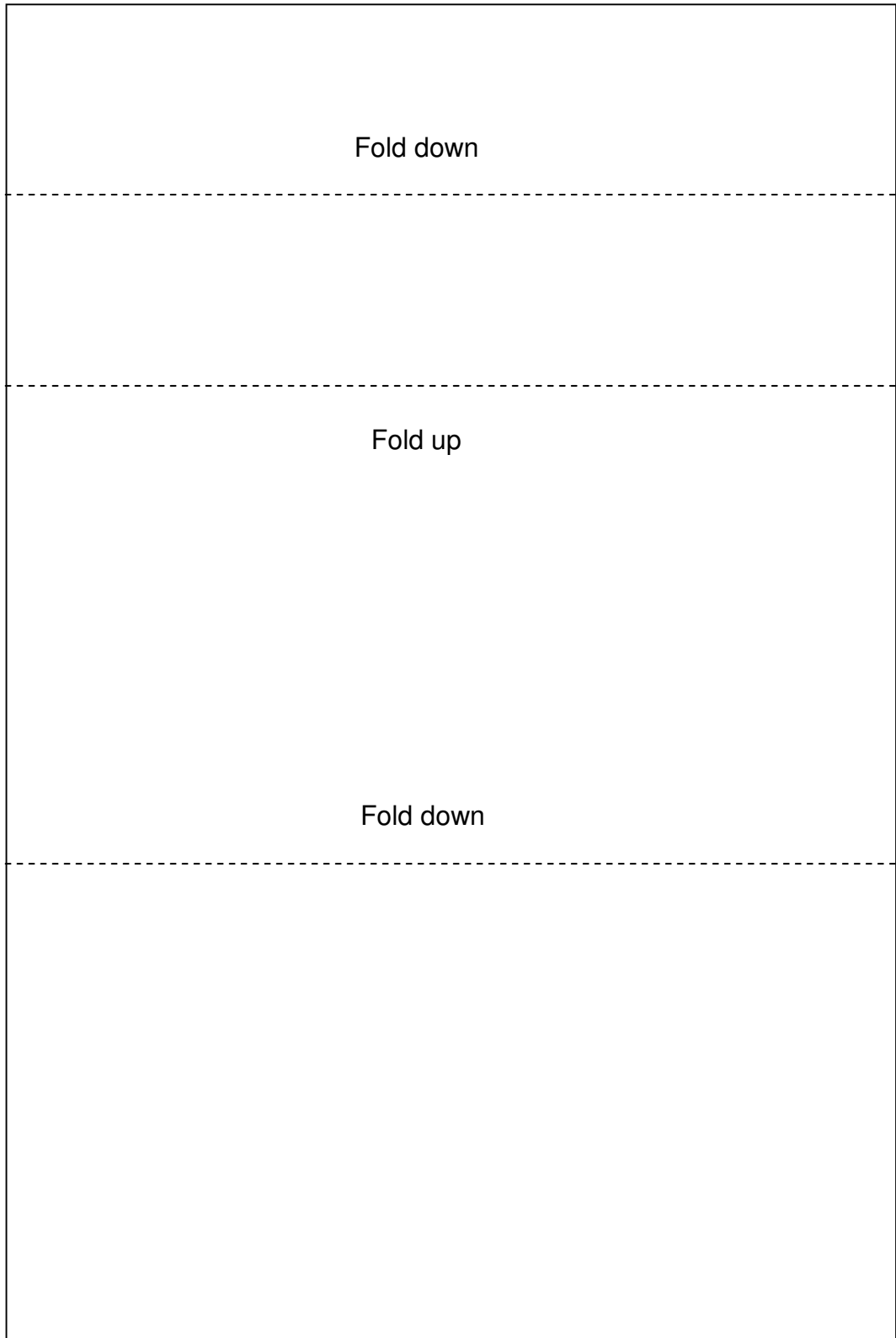

## Snowy Layers Card

Print out both the template sheets (page 13 and page 14) and use the base card template to create your base card. You can use a sheet of A5 card for this. Fold along the dashed lines as indicated on the template. Your card when turned to the side should look like a lopsided M shape.

When you have your base card cut out the layer templates. Draw around each one on to patterned paper and cut them out. Stick layer 3 over the top of layer 2 and attach this to the back panel on your card. Attach layer 1 to the small front panel on your card. You can distress the edges of the layers to give them a 3D effect. How you decorate your snowy layers is up to you. You can use stamped images or cut out shapes from patterned paper as in the sample below which depicts a Christmas candy wonderland!

**Star Tree Template**

## Star Tree Card

A simple tree shape is a great way to make quick and easy Christmas cards. If you want to add more detail you can also decorate the tree.

Print off the template sheet and cut out the size of tree that fits the card you want to make. Draw around the tree template on to green card and cut out the shape. Next cut the star from the tree template and draw around that on to silver or gold card and cut it out. Stick it over the whole tree shape you cut out earlier. Do the same with the tree stalk to complete your tree embellishment.

Add some layers of patterned paper on your card blank and then finish your card by adding your tree embellishment.

**Cute Snowman**

## Cute Snowman Card

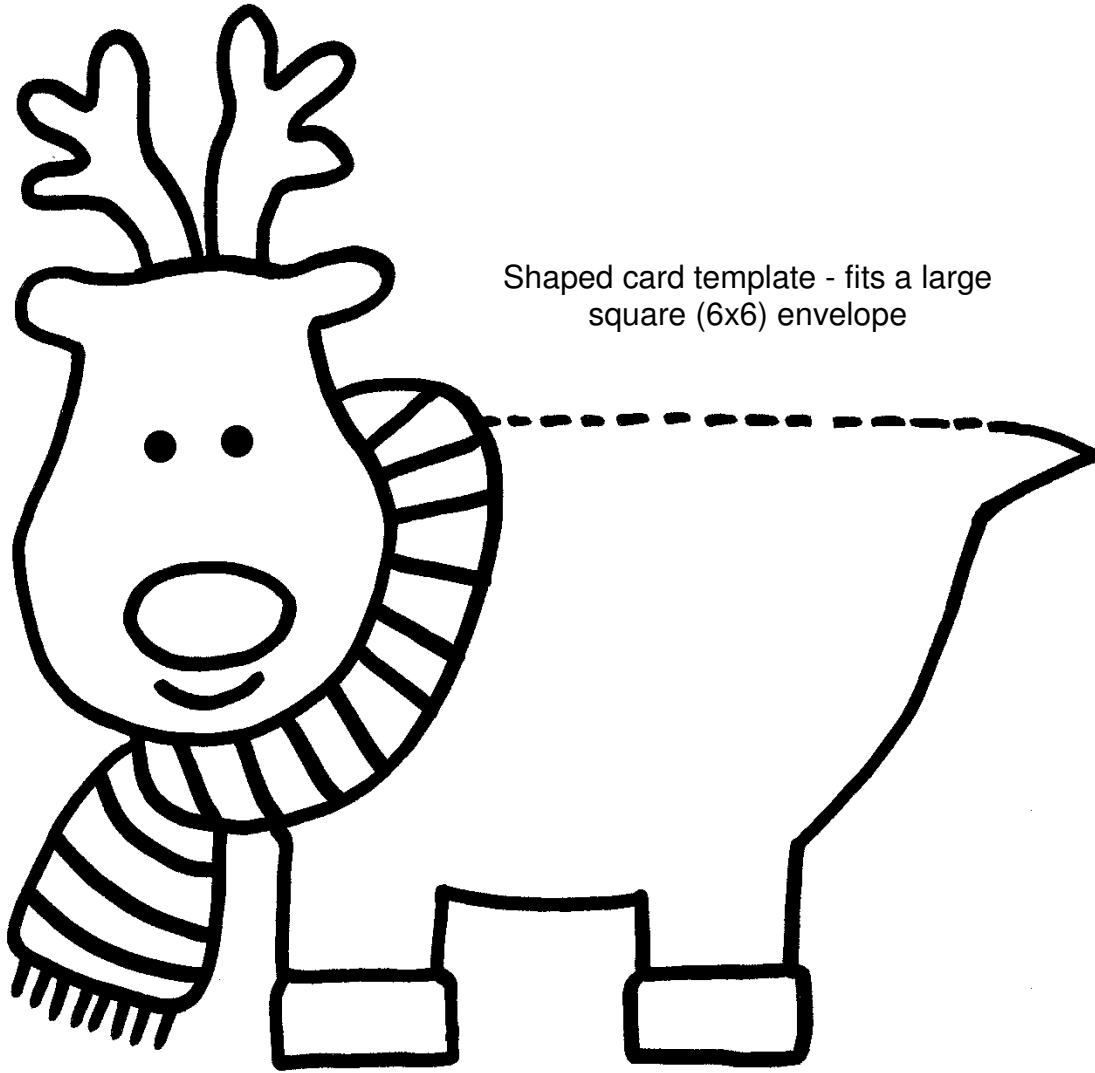
Print off the snowman template, decide which size you would like to use and cut out around the outside of the shape. Place it on a piece of white card, draw around the shape and cut it out. Draw the detail around the edges of the snowman shape you've cut out and add on the face details copying them from the template. Next cut the hat and the scarf from the template and draw around them onto two different patterned papers. Cut them out and stick them on your snowman shape. Draw the details and outline on the scarf and hat in black pen. Add more details by colouring in the arms, bobble and carrot nose. You can add some more embellishment like glitter if you like.

Add some patterned paper to your card blank and stick down your snowman embellishment. You can add extra embellishments if you like to finish off your card.

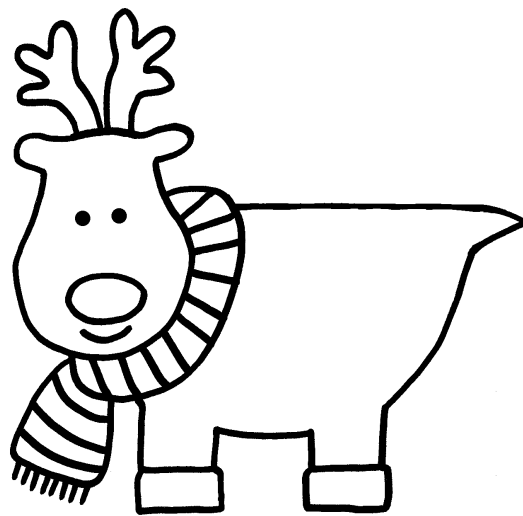

**Cute Reindeer**

## Cute Reindeer Card

There are two different templates you can use on this sheet. The larger template makes a shaped card that has been sized to fit into a large square envelope (the 6x6 kind) or there's a mini template you can add to a card blank.

To make the shaped cut the shaped card template out from the template sheet. Fold a piece of A4 card in half and place the template on it matching the dashed line up to the fold on your card. Draw around the shape and cut it out keeping the card folded to create your shaped base card. Next take a piece of the same coloured card you've used for your base card and draw around the whole reindeer template shape on to it. Cut out the shape and stick it over the front of you base card matching up the edges. Now you should have a reindeer shaped card. From here you can use the template so decorate him. Draw around the edges with black pen and draw on his face detail. Colour his hooves black and his nose red. To make the scarf cut out the scarf shape from the template piece and draw around it on to one patterned paper then cut it out. Stick it on to your card in the scarf shape space. Draw around the scarf shape onto another patterned paper and this time cut it into the stripes. Stick the striped sections on to the scarf on your card leaving the other pattern to show through for every other stripe. Draw around the edges of the scarf and the stripes with black pen to finish.
